The Aerostar Program Team set out to create a new Aerostar Wagon series, one that is both unique and superbly equipped. What they created was the Eddie Bauer Aerostar for 1988. Seating in the Eddie Bauer series is a 7-passenger arrangement combining luxury and versatility. Captain's Chairs with seat back recliners and power lumbar supports for the driver and front seat passenger, plus 2- and 3-passenger rear seat/beds — all upholstered in a unique Eddie Bauer cloth.

The heating/cooling system is Aerostar's best. It provides high-capacity heating/air conditioning throughout the vehicle and also includes a fan control for second-row rear seat passengers. Eddie Bauer features the Electronics Group, too, which includes sophisticated electronic instrumentation, the best AM/FM stereo sound system available from Ford for Aerostar, plus an overhead console with trip computer, electric day/night rearview mirror and map lights (see page 17 for complete details).

Eddie Bauer Aerostar Wagon also comes with power door locks and windows, electric-powered remote-control outside mirrors, rear window defroster and wiper/washer, interval windshield wipers, leather-wrapped steering wheel, and roof-mounted luggage rack. Plus a unique lower two-tone paint treatment.

And that's not all. You get the "Ford Care" extended maintenance and limited warranty program, with coverage for up to 24 months or 24,000 miles, whichever comes first. FORD AEROSTAR WAGON: DESIGNED FOR COMFORT AND VERSATILITY

The compact-size Aerostar is spacious enough to seat up to seven passengers. There's no sense of feeling cramped in any seating position. And you have ample walk-around space to get to your seat.

Even before you're seated, you'll notice how Aerostar was designed for ease of entry. Doors to the front compartment are high and wide, and the side door to the rear compartment is large and slides open easily. What's more, Aerostar has a comfortably low "step-in" height to provide convenient entry and exit.



Aerostar provides room and comfort for up to seven passengers. Remove the rear seating for 139.2 cu. ft. of cargo space. The rear bench seat design has a "quick-release" feature for easy removal.



Aerostar versatility

Aerostar Wagon is designed for great versatility, too. Should you need maximum space for carrying cargo, the rear bench seat design has a "quick-release" feature for easy removal. The seat anchors are recessed, providing a flat, unobstructed load floor. And with the spare tire located outside the vehicle, under the body, you have 139.2 cubic feet of usable space (with the rear seating removed).

Loading or unloading is an easy task, through either the sliding side door or the rear liftgate. The rear liftover height is a low, comfortable 23.3 inches.

Electronic instrument cluster

The electronic instrument cluster, standard in the Eddie Bauer Aerostar and optional in XL and XLT series, is the major component of Aerostar's sophisticated Electronics Group (see page 17).

This driver-command electronic center reports information on multi-color liquid crystal displays (LCDs) which are linked to a computer control system. It consists of the following features:

- ☐ Electronic speedometer module displays speeds up to 85 mph/140 kmph, "signal green" digital graphics, 7-digit odometer, trip odometer, and English/metric mode select.
- ☐ Electronic tachometer module up to 6000 rpm is a curved analog display with a non-linear reference scale.
- ☐ Digital fuel gauge has "signal green" digital graphics plus ISO/English/metric nomenclature.



□ Multi-function gauge includes read-outs for battery, oil pressure, engine temperature, a fuel bar gauge and expanded quarter-tank graphic that can be displayed sequentially.

□ Cluster control switches provide driver controls for five functions: gauge select, trip distance, trip reset, English/metric mode, and expanded fuel display.

□ Alert center displays signals for door ajar (one for each door and the liftgate), fasten seat belt, high beam, low washer fluid, check oil, and brake warning.

Aerostar ergonomics

The science of ergonomics applied to interior design allows you, the driver, to interact more naturally with the vehicle. You are therefore in greater command of driving functions.

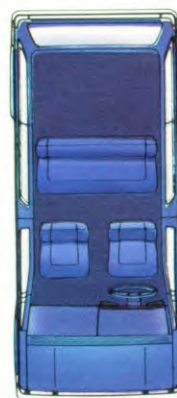
Seating in Aerostar is designed to hold you firmly and comfortably in an upright position. Controls are within easy reach, some right at your fingertips on the

steering column. Dials and gauges on the instrument cluster are easy to read and are backlit for excellent nighttime visibility.



Aerostar Wagon seating arrangements

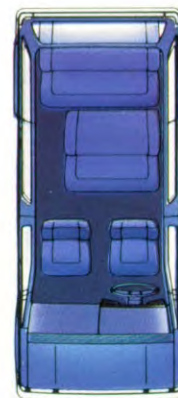

FORD AEROSTAR WAGON: THE SHAPE AND FEEL OF PERFORMANCE

The science of aerodynamics is concerned primarily with reducing air drag to increase fuel economy. Because of Aerostar's low .39 coefficient of drag (Cd), less horsepower is required to overcome wind resistance at moderate to high speeds. And because the engine doesn't work as hard, less fuel is consumed.

Ford designers are concerned, however, with more than just achieving higher fuel economy. The shape of the vehicle not only reduces wind resistance, but also directs the air flow in such a way as to help decrease front and rear lift, which contributes to handling.

Standard V-6 power, fuel-injected and computer-controlled

Aerostar's standard 3.0 liter V-6 is one of the most powerful engines you can find in a mini-van. Under Aerostar's

aerodynamic hood are 145 horsepower at 4,800 rpm and 165 lbs.-ft. of torque at 3,600 rpm.

The 3.0L features a multi-port electronic fuel injection (EFI) system engineered to balance the demands of performance and fuel economy.* EFI works in conjunction with Ford's EEC-IV engine control computer, which processes thousands of bits of information related to engine performance, then instantaneously adjusts the fuel-air mixture and ignition timing to optimize power, response and efficiency.

The 3.0L V-6 is teamed with a standard 5-speed overdrive transmission. Or choose Ford's 4-speed Automatic Over-

drive transmission which features an electronically controlled torque converter clutch for efficient operation, especially at highway speeds.

Ride quality and handling capability

Aerostar's suspension is a 4-corner coil spring system equipped with gas-pressurized shock absorbers that contribute to excellent ride quality over smooth or rough road conditions. The suspension is also equipped with components such as a front stabilizer bar and variable-rate rear coil springs, which enhance Aerostar's handling capability.



Big towing capability

Having a rear-wheel-driven mini-van is a big advantage when you're hauling a camper-trailer. With the driving wheels in the rear, under the load, a properly equipped Aerostar Wagon is rated to tow a trailer weighing up to 4,900 pounds.** That's nearly 2½ tons. Impressive for a compact van like Aerostar.

If you're really into recreational vehicles, you'll be pleased to know that Aerostar is perfectly suitable for a wide variety of aftermarket RV conversions.



With its compact size and short overall length, it's easy to park Aerostar Wagon in your garage.

Maneuverability in tight spaces

Design ingenuity has given the spacious Aerostar an overall length of just under 175 inches. Aerostar is shorter than other mini-vans — and that's an advantage when you're maneuvering into a tight parking space or into your garage. Also contributing to Aerostar's maneuverability is precise power-assisted rack-and-pinion steering.

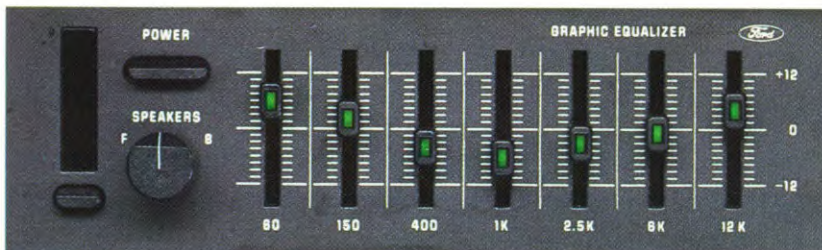

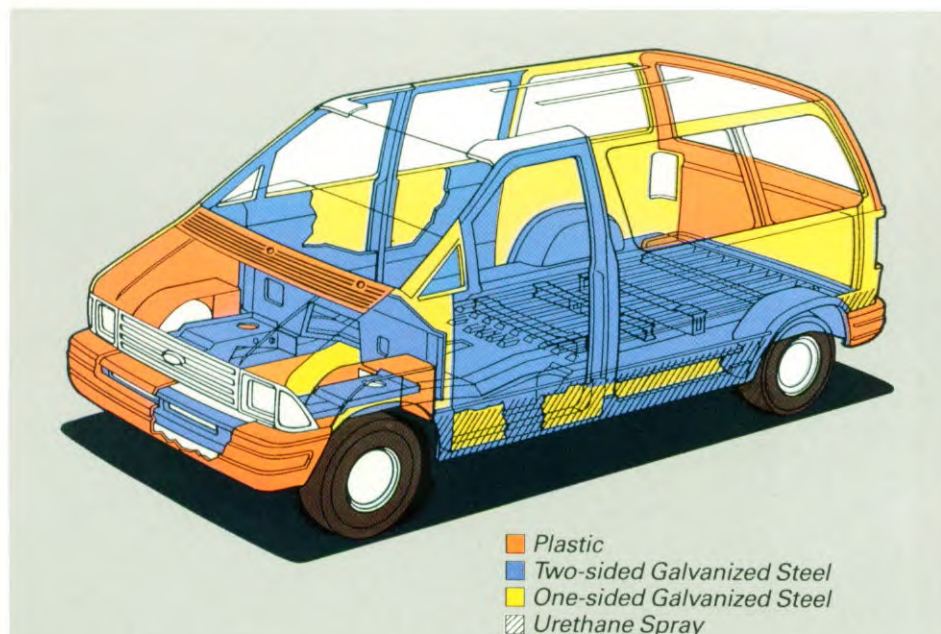

Ford's powertrain warranty covers all 1988 cars and light trucks for 6 years or 60,000 miles, whichever comes first. This limited warranty covers

The "Uniprime" primer system is a high-build cathodic electrocoat body primer material with higher film thickness than similar conventional processes. It offers excellent corrosion protection, good paint adhesion and paint coverage in hard-to-reach areas, and is just one of 15 different operations required to prepare the body for painting.



Participating Ford Dealers offer the Lifetime Service Guarantee, which guarantees their customer-paid work on your Ford vehicle for as long as you own it. This means that the covered repair is paid for once — and never again. If it ever has to be fixed again, the repairing dealer will fix it free. Free parts. Free labor. Even if the vehicle is kept a lifetime. It doesn't matter where it was purchased, or whether it's new or used; the work is still covered by the repairing dealer.
