Inside a Jetta there seems to be something for everyone. For the sun worshipers and amateur astronomers there's the optional multi-position sunroof. With the available programmable seat, people of all sizes can find their own favourite position behind the wheel (and if you can't pick only one perfect position that's ok, your seat can remember your 3 favourite settings). And for those who feel 0.5 cubic meters of trunk capacity is limiting, the split-rear folding seat provides the extra cargo space you need. Fold down 40, 60, or 100% of the backseat to fit the occasional drum kit, hockey stick, stack of lumber, mannequin, or surfboard. And if an adaptive rear seat doesn't convince you the Jetta has something for everyone, maybe the abundance of cup holders will. That's right, cup holders for everybody, even those sitting in the foldable backseat.

The available DSG® gearbox is a feat of engineering that marries the ease of an automatic with the thrill and control of a manual transmission...well, a manual transmission that allows you to shift between gears in a matter of hundredths of a second. 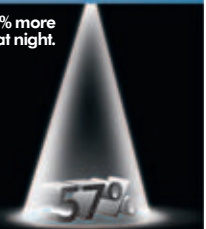

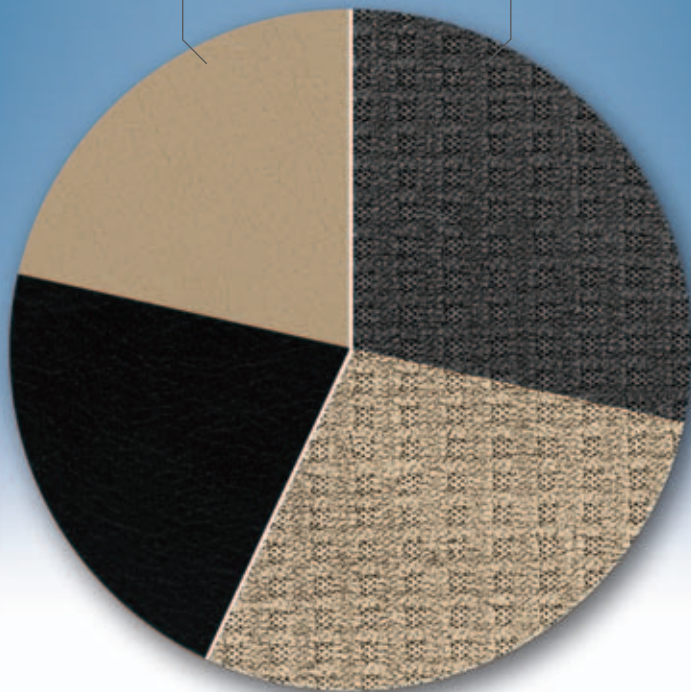

A brief note about the misuse of the Jetta Report.

The purpose of the Jetta Report is to provide insight into both the Jetta owner, and the car driving population at large. We are aware some members of society might view these findings as an opportunity to stereotype Jetta owners as well-educated, athletic people, who appreciate music and safety features. But those generalizations are not 100% accurate. And we strongly urge against using the statistics contained in the Jetta Report to make broad, sweeping judgments about all Jetta owners. Remember, each Jetta owner is an individual, with a unique point of view on matters such as snowboarding or sunscreen. It's important for us to understand that judging a person by the car they drive isn't only wrong. It's stupid.
