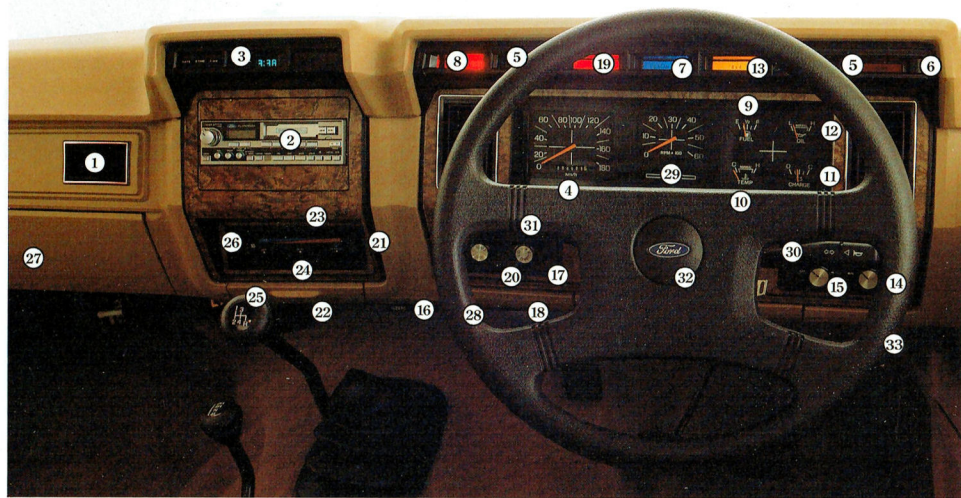
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# Station Wagon Style with Luxury and Space.

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Twin bucket seats up front provide a commanding view. And the wide flip-fold rear seat provides spacious comfort with generous shoulder-room. With the rear seat folded down there is a huge cargo area with the potential to ferry loads of gear to most places you can think of - on or off the road. A rear-mounted swing-away spare wheel carrier is standard equipment and provides for ease of access and

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For your further comfort, factory fitted air-conditioning provides full climate control.

In standard form, fitted with four-speed manual transmission, the gear shift lever is floor mounted, beside the transfer case shift lever (4WD). Where optional automatic transmission is specified at extra cost, the gear selector is column mounted.

Interior storage is another feature of Bronco. In addition to a lockable glovebox, there are roomy stowage bins on the inside of each door, and a jumbo-sized centre console which is also lockable and has a drink tray formed in the top.





## And the country you don't.

Compare the powerful 5.8 litre V8 engine of Bronco with the power ratings offered by other 4WDs. And then, consider Bronco's massive transfer case reduction ratios plus front and rear limited-slip differentials. These are the ingredients which provide exceptional off-road performance.

But it doesn't stop there.

Bronco is manoeuvrable, sitting on a short wheelbase of 2660mm, and with the advantage of short body overhangs, front and rear.

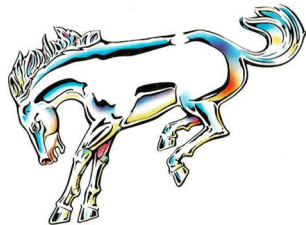
Not only is Bronco able to negotiate steep slopes, but the stability provided by its wide track allows many slopes

to be traversed - when the situation demands.

Excellent ground clearance is maintained over bumps and pot holes with Bronco's twin traction, independent front suspension which permits each wheel to move up and down separately. Pitch and roll are minimised while steering control and traction are enhanced. Bronco is built tough to take the rough in its stride - with a full truck-type chassis for strength and durability.

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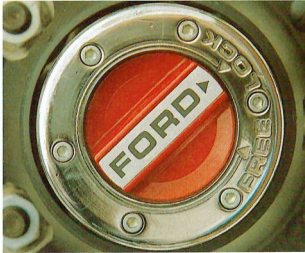

## Free-wheeling front hubs.

As Bronco gives you a choice of 2WD or 4WD, free-wheeling front hubs are standard. In 'free', the front wheels rotate freely on the axles, reducing unnecessary fuel-wasting drag on the engine. When switched to 'lock', the front wheels are locked to the driving axles for 4WD performance.

## Choice of transmissions.

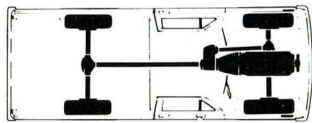
In standard form, Bronco is equipped with a manual four-on-the-floor transmission. Automatic transmission is available at extra cost.



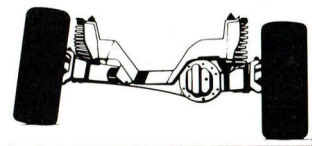
Bronco is equipped with Limited Slip Differentials (LSD) front and rear. They limit the amount of slippage so that in 4WD power is transmitted to all four driving wheels, no matter how difficult the terrain. If four wheel drive is not engaged, the LSD at the rear will provide optimal 2WD traction.

## Power to Spare.

The renowned Ford 5.8 litre V8 engine provides real four-wheel-drive muscle. Not only will Bronco cruise the highways effortlessly, but it will take arduous off-road work or large towing jobs in its stride.

## True 4x4 power.

Because you don't need 4WD all the time, Bronco has a 'by your command' system. When the transfer case is in 2H, normal rear wheel drive operates. Now move the lever to 4H and you've got easy-going four-wheel-driving. But when the going gets tough, drop it down to 4L, select first
