The Porsche Driving Experience evolved from the Porsche Sport Driving School, which began in 1974 with the launch of the 930 Turbo. Since then it has developed to provide exciting and informative courses to improve driving enjoyment.

Porsche Driving Experience comprises a series of driving programmes designed to enable drivers to match their performance to that of the car. The experiences provide the opportunity for all drivers to refine their behind-thewheel ability, knowledge and safety.

Porsche vehicle development is relentless. Huge technical and mechanical advances, particularly over the last decade, have produced today's hugely capable cars. Investing time in understanding these features can unlock even an experienced driver's potential to enjoy a Porsche to the full.

Over the course of the past 35 years, much has changed – but much has stayed the same. The passion, for example, with which we work on improving every aspect of our training programme: from your driving skills to your enjoyment behind the wheel.





Porsche Experience Centre



The Porsche Experience Centre is a world-class training facility where drivers receive expert coaching to enhance their driving skills and develop new techniques.



The Porsche Experience Centre opened its doors in July 2008 after six years of development and is situated at Silverstone Circuit, the home of British motorsport, in the heart of England. Located next to Hangar Straight, we are on the site of the WRC Rally of Great Britain special stage used in the late 1990s.

Developed by Porsche, our Test Tracks provide a unique and, above all, enjoyable facility devised to extend a driver's understanding and use of the technical and dynamic capabilities of a Porsche.

The Centre itself houses a Porsche display area, a high quality restaurant with panoramic views of the Porsche Test Track and an innovative Human Performance Centre. Visitors are able to see the entire Porsche facility from a roof top platform which offers spectacular views of both the Porsche Test Tracks and Silverstone's Grand Prix Circuit.

Porsche Test Tracks

The specially designed track incorporates five elements; Handling, Kick Plate, Ice Hill, Low Friction and Off-Road circuits.



■ Handling Circuit

Designed to replicate a challenging country road, with varying cambers and blind corners.



Ice Hill

Simulating sheet ice with computer controlled water jets, this area allows drivers to explore general car control as well as understanding the specific handling characteristics of a car.

With a total length of 3.1km, the track has been designed to allow it to be split into four separate areas that can be used independently of each other or connected together to form a longer handling circuit. This offers a variety of track configurations and surface conditions on which the potential of Porsche cars can be studied and understood.

This environment will allow visitors to be instructed through a variety of different situations in wet and dry conditions, as well as simulating ice and snow driving with the use of specially constructed surfaces.

The majority of advanced handling courses are particularly hard on the car. However, our low friction surfaces allow dynamic manoeuvres with low wear and tear, meaning that tyre wear on the Porsche Test Track is almost negligible.

Kick Plate

A moveable metal plate set flush with the road surface designed to be triggered remotely as a car travels over it, thereby generating the effect of a loss of rear wheel traction.



Low Friction

Specially formulated tarmac creating an ideal environment where oversteer slides can be provoked, corrected and held.



Off-Road

Purpose built to include steep hillclimbs and descents, deep water and rough terrain.

A challenging course to test both driver and car.



You will learn how to skilfully react to load changes with precise corrections to the steering. On the Test Tracks, your Porsche Driving Consultant will demonstrate the optimum way to approach and tackle bends in normal road traffic as well as the ideal cornering technique.

Precision, our one-day course for first-time participants.

Our one-day Precision training is the ideal opportunity to explore the full potential of your vehicle.

This is why, in addition to an individual driving style assessment, the course also includes detailed and thorough coverage of the basics, similar to the Warm-Up training. However, in comparison to the Warm-Up course, the programme includes an unforgettable module where drivers can complete full laps of the Silverstone circuit.

The training focuses on how to handle the vehicle and respond correctly in hazardous situations. Under expert coaching, you will learn how to approach and tackle bends accurately. At the same time, attention is paid to the potential dangers of everyday road traffic.

Other particularly important factors include learning to estimate speed and being able to react quickly. You will practise taking evasive action and experience the effect that slight differences in speed can have on the intensity of load changes. With your Porsche Driving Instructor on hand, you will gradually simulate driving conditions in which the vehicle threatens to oversteer. You will also practise how to maintain control in even the most demanding situations.





In the afternoon, you will have the opportunity to experience the thrills of Silverstone Circuit first hand, with plenty of time for practising the basic requirements for safely negotiating a bend – accurate steering, skilful braking and careful acceleration.

Performance, our two-day course for advanced participants.

If Precision has given you renewed driving ambitions, it's time to discover the next stage in Performance. This course is for advanced participants who have already completed the Precision level.

Lasting for two days, this driving safety course mainly concentrates on further improving your vehicle control.

Participants should possess certain basic knowledge, such as how to find the most suitable seat position, develop optimum vision control and respond correctly when the vehicle threatens to oversteer. In addition to an in-depth theory session, the first day includes a chance to familiarise yourself with the respective sequence of bends. The choice of sections that focus on specific driving skills, in particular following the racing line and the resulting load-changing reactions, is aimed at further improving your command of the vehicle.

Effective braking when entering a corner and avoiding unnecessary steering inputs are primarily a question of practice. This is why you spend as much time as possible behind the wheel. One of the main on-road training modules is lapping, which is given further attention during this course.







Here, you have an opportunity to put your knowledge and skills to the test over the entire Silverstone Circuit, while the Porsche Driving Consultant monitors your driving before assessing your progress. However, the emphasis is on improving your driving skills, rather than driving at high speed.

You must have completed a Performance training course before you can take part in the Master course.

Master

Master, our two-day course for advanced participants.

At Porsche, we are constantly redefining the limits of what's possible.

Now it's your turn: after you have completed the Performance training, the challenges of the Master course await you.

The course builds on what has already been learned in the Performance course. But it is primarily devoted to motorsport-oriented aspects. The driving programme includes identifying the racing line on Silverstone Circuit, precision braking and controlled acceleration out of a bend. When driving laps, you should be able to find the optimum racing line over the entire course. Special attention is also given to safe overtaking manoeuvres and general trackcraft. Your Porsche Driving Consultant will be next to you at all times and at the end to discuss your performance on the track.

The theory lessons cover aspects such as circuit etiquette, flags and correct clothing in high performance driving. It's not only your vehicle that has to last the full distance, and with this in mind you too will receive expert advice on balanced nutrition and fitness training.





As a further highlight, a guest instructor from the world of motorsport is on hand, not only to reveal some of the tricks of the trade, but also to take participants for a demonstration lap. All this will give you an introduction to the high art of skilled motoring and an opportunity to exchange experiences with the professionals. To maximise learning, your performance on the Test Track will be recorded on video and analysed afterwards with your Porsche Driving Consultant.

After successfully completing the Master training, you are then ready to turn your sights towards motorsport.

The training courses offered by the Porsche Experience Centre teach you how to use these environmentally friendly technologies properly, without detracting from the overall driving experience.

Vision and knowledge of the available options play as important a role in this respect as they do in terms of driving safety. Drive with foresight and avoid unnecessary acceleration phases and subsequent braking manoeuvres. Also avoid short spurts of acceleration, maintaining a consistent speed throughout your journey to reduce fuel consumption.





Learn how to use the technological innovations on your vehicle such as Porsche VarioCam Plus or direct fuel injection properly for the benefit of the environment – while still enjoying the performance of your Porsche to the full.

Discover how to achieve the best engine efficiency by selecting the correct engine speed and pedal position. The optimum flexibility of Porsche engines enables you to accelerate in high gear and to use high gears even when you are driving at constant or low speeds. This significantly reduces the revs per minute and fuel consumption. We therefore advise you to take advantage of the engine's braking power by downshifting when braking. The deceleration fuel cut-off on your Porsche engine will then reduce the fuel supply to zero. This enables you to drive in a more foresighted and efficient way.

You'll learn these and many more tips at the Porsche Experience Centre, and our courses will also show you how to put these into practice for a safer, more exhilarating and eco-friendly driving experience.

The Ultimate Learning Curve
