The passenger seat reclines to more than 45 degrees. And the driver's seat can be ordered with six-way power adjustment at extra cost. If you like to push your seat back for all the comfort you can get when driving.

Built for added value. Parisienne Brougham and all full-size '75 Pontiacs offer features that present new opportunities.

In a nutshell, what they can do for you is help lower maintenance and operating costs, and help improve overall performance and driveability, while offering better handling and response.

Cleaner air. Exhaust emissions from the engine are treated by a catalytic converter. This device also allows the engine to be retuned for lower idling speeds, quicker warm-up and smoother overall performance.

Fewer tune-ups. Your need for periodic tune-ups is greatly lessened with α solid-state ignition system without points or condensers. High-Energy Ignition delivers up to 35,000 volts for quick, sure starting, especially in cold or wet weather.

fust looking tells you a lot. There's a stamp of front-rank authority to a new Catalina. It shows wherever you look, beginning with the newly-styled Pontiac split front grille and continuing as your eyes sweep over this beautiful car. The Catalina sedan, you may notice, has new roof styling. It not only looks great but also allows for additional glass at the sides, giving rear seat passengers more window.

The interior is front rank, too. Catalina has the touches you may very well want. Like the appearance of dark flame chestnut on the instrument panel and doors. Nylon-blend, cut-pile carpeting which is, as they say, wall to wall.

Seat cushions and seat backs are of thick foam, contour-molded to comfort you over the miles to come. The seat coverings are either luxurious cloth or leather-like, easy-to-care-for vinyl Morrokide that's available at extra cost. Ask your dealer about the choice of colors this year.

You can't tell by looking, but above you is a double-panel steel roof. Double-panels add strength to the structure of the roof and help keep noise out of the passenger compartment. The contoured full inner panel is perforated, similar to acoustical tiles.

A Catalina is built to look after you very well.




