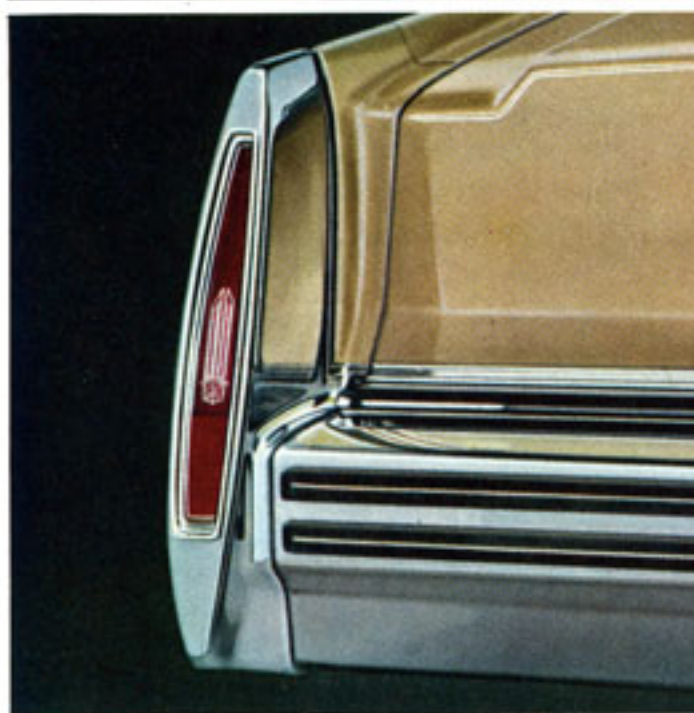

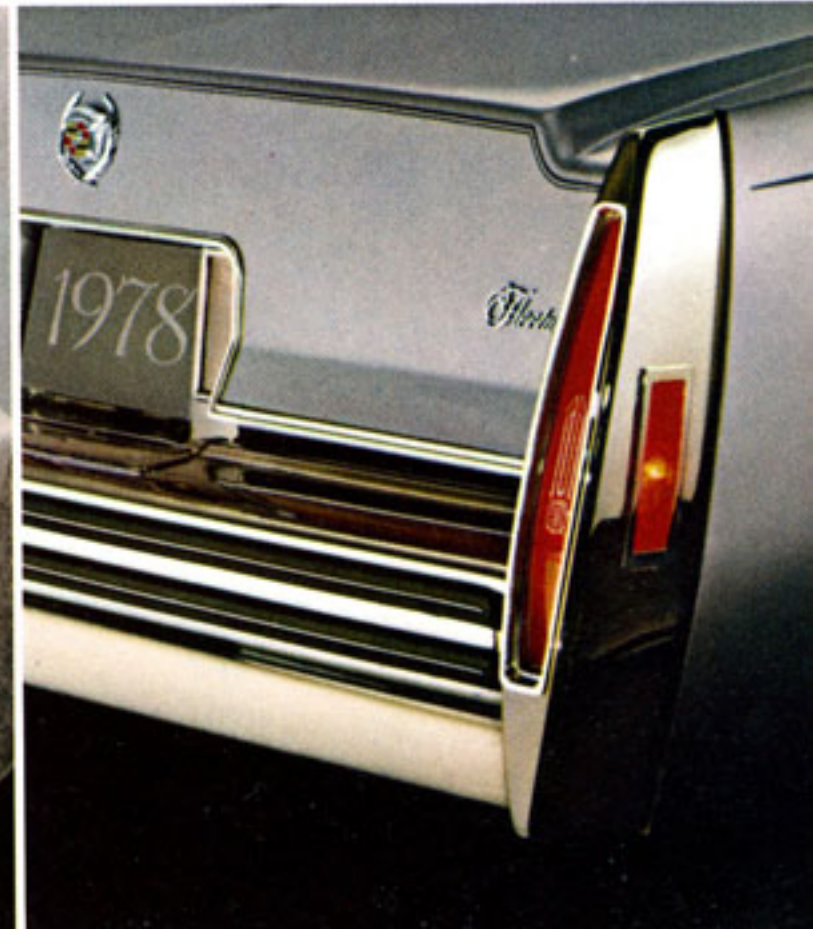

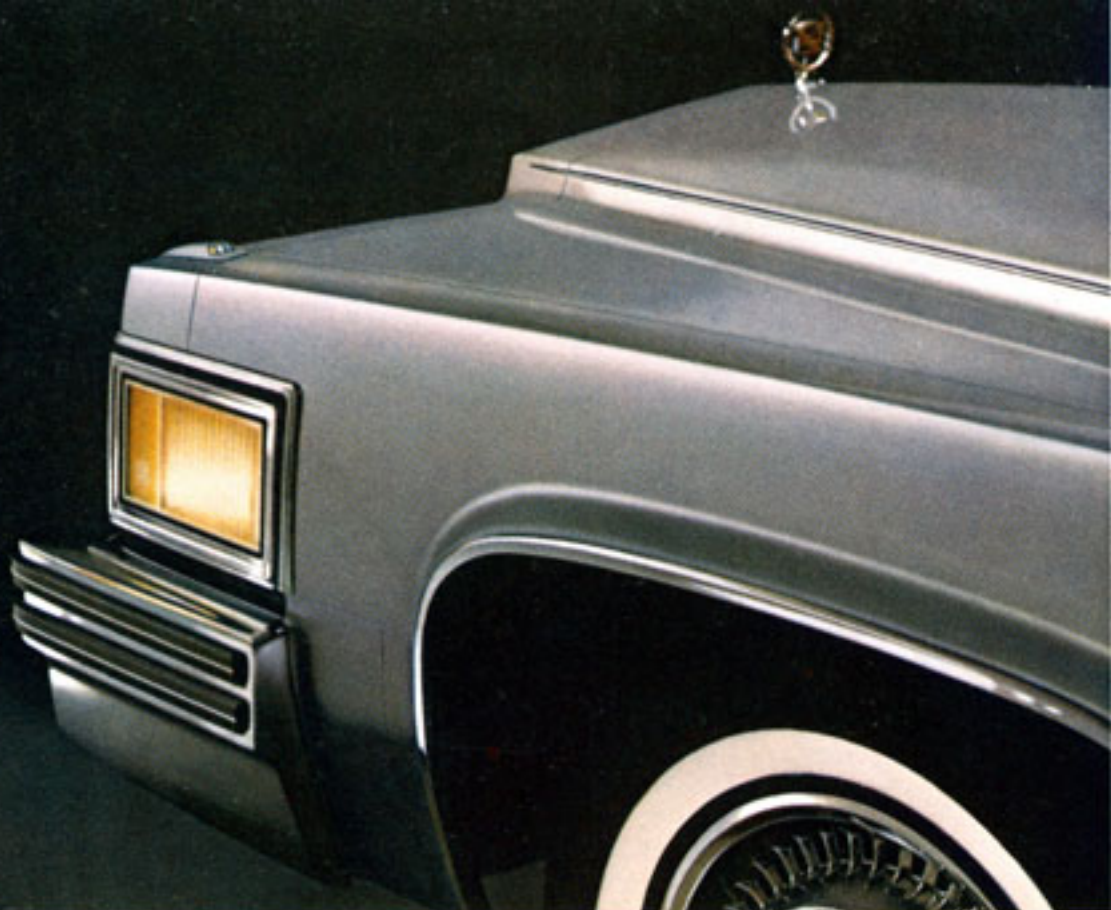

Disc Brakes—Four-wheel disc brakes are standard with Fleetwood Brougham. Self-adjusting front-wheel disc and rear-wheel drum brakes with DeVilles and Limousines.

Steel-Belted, Wide-Whitewall Radial Tires—Built to GM specifications. Oversized H-Series tires are standard on Brougham and Limousines.

Lamp Monitors—Show if major or secondary outside light systems are functioning.

Power Windows—Can be operated individually or with master control on driver's door armrest.

AM/FM Stereo Radio with Signal-Seeker and Scanner—This four-speaker system offers rich stereo reception and tuning convenience. (Please see Radio Selection page for descriptions of all radios available.)

Automatic Power Antenna—If desired, power antenna can be left at a preselected height without retracting.

Six-Way Power Seat Adjuster on Driver Side—Adjusts front seat forward, back, up, down and tilts forward or back. Standard on Fleetwood Brougham, DeVilles and Fleetwood Limousine. Control on door armrest.

Dual Comfort Seats—50/50 standard on Fleetwood Brougham, available on DeVilles. They allow separate adjustment for driver and front passenger. Available for the passenger's side is a power reclining seat with a six-way power adjuster. Power Recliner is also available for driver side.

Accent Striping—Choice of 13 colors. Standard on Limousines, available on DeVilles and Fleetwood Brougham.

Electronic-Fuel-Injected Engine—Designed to offer quick response, fast starting, smooth engine idle and few scheduled maintenance operations. Not available on Limousines.

Astrorooft—Laminated and tinted Safety-glass panel (six complementary tints) lets the sunshine in even when closed. Adjustable sunshade. (This feature will reduce headroom.) Not available on Limousines.

Sunroof—Similar to Astrorooft, except electrically powered panel is not transparent. (This feature will reduce headroom.) Not available on Limousines.

Vinyl Roof—Sixteen available colors in Padded Elk Grain.

Automatic Door Lock System—Locks all doors automatically when the shift lever is moved to a forward drive position.

New Electronic Level Control—Automatically and electronically adjusts car to changing loads. "Level Air" light on instrument panel indicates when leveling function is occurring. Standard on Brougham and Limousines, available on DeVilles.

Illuminated Entry System—Pushing front door handle button illuminates door lock keyholes and turns on inside courtesy lights.

Illuminated Vanity Mirror—Sunshade vanity mirror on the passenger side illuminates when cover is raised.

Fuel Monitor System—Color-coded lights on instrument panel indicate when fuel consumption is relatively efficient or inefficient—and another light when fuel supply is low.

Dual Comfort 50/50 Front Seats—Standard on Brougham, available on DeVilles.

Power Recliner Passenger Seat—Including Six-Way Power Seat Adjuster, available on all 50/50 Dual Comfort front seats.

Power Recliner Driver Seat—Available on all Dual Comfort 50/50 front seats.

Power Recliner—For passenger seatback on notchback type seats on Coupe deVille and on Sedan deVille with available leather for the seating areas.

Cruise Control—Electronic Cruise Control includes both "Resume" and "Advance" features, offering desirable flexibility for speed selection and alteration.

Rear Window Defogger—Electric grid type.

Twilight Sentinel—Automatically turns lights on and off in response to outside lighting conditions. (Also turns lights off after an adjustable time delay.)

Guide-Matic Headlamp Control—Automatically dims lights at night with approach of oncoming cars, then returns lights to bright.

Controlled Cycle Wiper System—Delay feature adjusts wiping action for light rain or other special conditions. Includes momentary "mist" position.

Heavy-Duty Ride and Handling Package—Provides added firmness. (Special order.)

Limited-Slip Differential—Directs power to the rear wheel having better traction.

Power Trunk Lock—With ignition on, a light touch of trunk lock button located inside glove box causes the trunk to open. Also includes quiet pulldown closing feature.

Tilt and Telescope Steering Wheel—Swings up for easy entry/exit. Also slides and adjusts in or out for individual driver comfort. Standard on Fleetwood Formal Limousine.

Interiors with Leather in Seating Areas—Twelve trim combinations available. (Except Limousines.)

Remote Control Right-Side Mirror—Standard on Limousines.

Illuminated Outside Thermometer—On base of left-side mirror. Responds to ambient temperatures.

Firemist Paints—These paints offer rich color, deep luster and high gloss. Six colors.

Carpeted Rubber Floor Mats—Available for front and rear passenger compartments.
