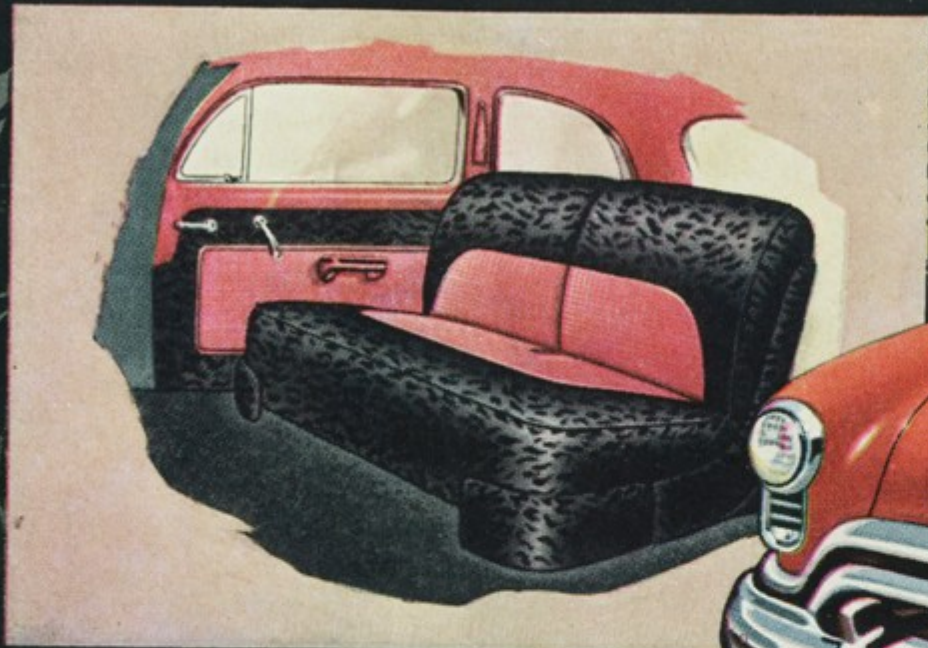




THE PONTIAC

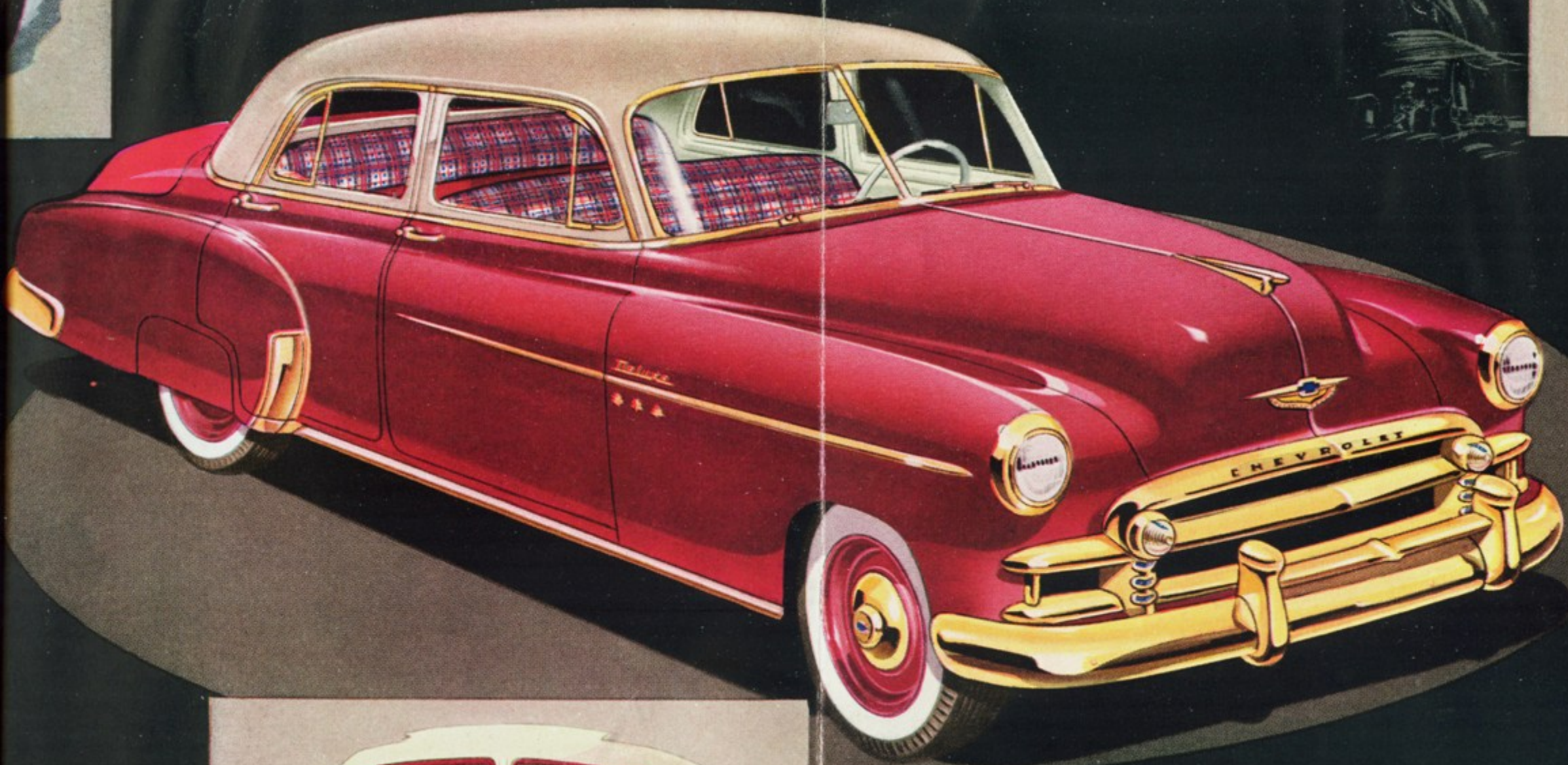

Golden Jubilee

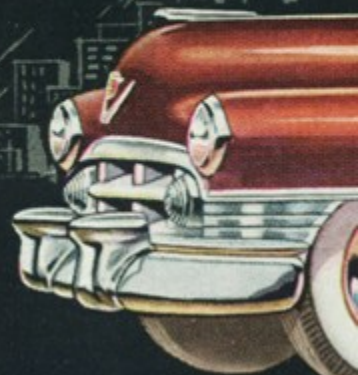
The interior of the Golden Jubilee is finished with unusual opulence in silky black broad-tail and a Salmon nylon waffle weave and details picked out in black leather. . . .
