The term "Hemi" means "hemispherical combustion chamber". That shape lets us use bigger intake and exhaust valves. So we get free-breathing cylinders. At the same time, the air/fuel mixture swirls smoothly in the domed chamber. And the power impulse from the spark plug travels a shorter distance. So the petrol burns evenly and completely.



Transmission.

Manual: 3-speed, all synchromesh gearbox. Shift lever column mounted. Ratios, 1st 2.95:1; 2nd 1.69:1; 3rd 1.00:1; Reverse. 3.67:1.

Automatic Torqueflite: Torque convertor fully automatic transmission with manual override on 1st and 2nd gears. 3 performance rated Torqueflite transmissions matched to engine power. Gear selector lever and quadrant on steering column.

Rear Axle.

Hypoid, semi-floating type. Gear ratio, 3.23:1 (225 c.i.d. 6-cylinder), 2.92:1 (245 c.i.d. 6 cylinder and 318 V-8). Sure Grip differential available with rear axle ratios of 3.23:1 (6-cylinder only), 2.92:1 (6-cylinder and V-8).

Brakes.

Dual master cylinders with separate front and rear brake circuits. Duo-servo drum, 9" diameter front and rear. Drum lining area 157.9 sq. ins. Shoe clearance automatically adjusted during reverse stopps. Front disc brakes, (optional equipment), 11" diameter ventilated disc with floating head caliper, Power assisted front disc brakes (standard equipment on 2-barrel Regal Safari and Regal Safari v-8). Swept disc/drum area 481.8 sq. ins.

Wheels and Tyres.

Pressed steel 5" wide double-sided safety rims. 6.95 x 14" x 4 ply standard on all 6-cylinder engines. 7.35 x 14" x 4 ply standard with V-8 engine. White wall tyres standard on Regal Safaris.

Independent front suspension with chromium alloy steel torsion bars. 5-leaf longitudinal rear springs with telescopic shock absorbers.
