

Engineering

Galant's all-weather flow-through ventilation system changes the cabin air every 10 minutes. Keeps the atmosphere (and the driver's head) clear, even on rainy days.

Specifications

Engine (General): 4-cycle, 4-cylinder inline with overhead camshaft, lightweight cross-flow head: Crankshaft and camshaft mounted in 5 bearings; Hemispherical, minimum-surface combustion chamber.

Galant 1600: Bore \times stroke 3.0" \times 3.4" (76.9 mm \times 86 mm). Piston displacement 97.45 cu.in. (1597 cc). Compression ratio 8.5:1.

Maximum output, 100 BHP @ 6300 r.p.m. (S.A.E.).

Maximum torque, 101.2 ft/lb @ 4000 r.p.m. (S.A.E.).

Fuel System: Down-draught, twobarrel carburettor with mechanical diaphragm pump. Fuel tank capacity, 9.9 gals. (45 1).

Lubrication System: Force-feed by trochoid pump. Paper-element oil filter. Crankcase capacity, 6.2 pints (3.5 1).

Cooling System: Pressurized radiator with centrifugal pump and fan. (Circulation controlled by thermostat.) Water capacity 1.36 gals (.77 1).

Ignition System: Coil and distributor with mechanical and vacuum control.

Electrical System: 12-volt, 35-amp., alternator; 40 ampere-hour battery.

Clutch: Single dry-plate clutch with hydraulic actuation.

Transmission: Manual: 4-speed, floor-mounted, synchromesh in all forward gears. 1st, 3.525:1; 2nd, 2.193:1, 3rd, 1.442:1; 4th, 1.000:1; reverse, 3.867:1.

Automatic: 3-speed, floor-mounted with manual over-ride. 1st, 2.393:1; 2nd 1.450:1; 3rd, 1.000:1; reverse, 2.094:1.

Rear Axle: Semi-floating axle. Hypoid bevel final drive. Gear ratio 3.889:1.

Suspension: Front: Independent, strut-type with double-acting shock absorbers. Anti-roll bar. Rear: Semicliptic leaf springs with double-acting shock absorbers.

Brakes: Hydraulic, front disc brakes. Leading-trailing shoe 9" (228 mm) diam., rear drum brakes. Tandem master cylinder. Parking brake operates mechanically on rear wheels.

Steering: Recirculating ball type with variable ratio gear. Gear ratio, 15.58-18.18. Tilt steering wheel. Minimum turning circle, 30.2 feet. (9.2 m).

Wheels and Tyres: Pressed-steel disc wheels: $6.00 \times 13 \times 4$ P.R. tyres.

Dimensions: Overall length 161.27 ins (4095 mm). Overall width 61.4 ins (1560 mm). Overall height, 56.5 ins (1435 mm). Wheelbase 95.3 ins (2421 mm) Weight: 2017 lbs (915 kg) approx.
