The Regal has traditionally been a car to separate its passengers from the clutter and noise of outside traffic.

But this year, with more cars on Australian roads than in any other time in history, it carries that tradition still further.

Its full-size makes for effortless cruising leaving you and your passengers enjoying the drive undisturbed by overcrowding, or outside noise.

New standard items such as 185SR14 radials add to the ease

and safety this year.
An anti-sway bar is fitted to ensure minimum body roll even on the most winding scenic roads.

Anti-lift windscreen wipers give you a clear advantage.

Bodyside mouldings and rear overriders protect your investment.

And to protect you, hazard warning lights, and door reflectors are now standard.

To add further to your peace of mind, Regal now offers a new braking system.

Up front, powerassisted disc brakes activate gently, but powerfully, at a touch. The rear brakes now feature large area drums coupled to a special Pressure Proportioning Valve.

It controls the distribution of brake pedal pressure to the rear drums to give strong, straight line braking—by minimising the hazard of rear wheels locking.

The Regal interior.

This year the Regal's interior is more refined than ever.

It has a new finely detailed woodgrain dashboard.

Woodgrain you will see again on both front and rear doors to add a finishing touch.

Generous front bucket seats are fully reclining as standard.

Pull down armrests are standard comfort items, for both front and rear seat passengers.

Seating fabrics range from soft, supple vinyl, to luxurious woven fabric.

In your selection of restful and practical colours.

Of course, a radio, and electric clock are also standard items.

So too is carpet, a vanity mirror and cigar lighter.

Courtesy lights are provided in the ash receiver, lockable glovebox, in the engine compartment and in the boot.

And both ceiling and floor level lights are operable by the opening of either front or rear doors, to welcome passengers aboard.

All these things are comforts shared by passengers.

But there are many others specifically for driver comfort and convenience.

For comfort and safety, the steering wheel is soft-grip.

Vital controls for such things as wipers, washers, headlight flashers and dipper are now grouped on a steering column stalk to be close at hand.

The interior rearvision mirror is prismatic, to cut down on glare when driving at night.

The exterior mirror is adjustable from inside the car, eliminating the need to wind down the window.

And to further aid visibility, heating elements are laminated into the rear window to keep it fog free.

Regal engineering

The engineering innovations of a motor car are as important a measure of style as looks.

Some of Regal's innovations have already been mentioned.

But perhaps the most exciting ideas can be found in the power plant itself.

The 4.0 litre Hemi 6.
Millions of miles have
proved it to be the most

engine in an Australian
built car.

And not without excellent reasons. Although it is 6 cylinders, torque and power are equal to, or better than, an equivalent V8 engine.

The Hemispherical head allows bigger valves, so the engine breathes more freely.

It is now fed by a new 2 barrel carburettor.

To have power in reserve at cruising speeds, and easier towing through hilly country.





In addition, a Hot-Air Intake device pre-heats air before mixing it with fuel.

So that even on the coldest morning the engine reaches an efficient working temperature quickly.



In building Regal, Chrysler go one better.

First, Electronic Ignition. Ignition points and condensors

have always had the problem of eventually wearing out.

But Regal has an exclusive electronic ignition system.

The condensor and points have been eliminated. So they'll never

need to be replaced. Spark plug life is extended. And the tuning won't have to be touched

for 80,000 kilometers. But more importantly, the electronic ignition delivers 35% more starting voltage for sure starts in wet and cold.

And helps to ensure efficient combustion.

Next, torsion bar suspension, and Unibody construction. The two systems complement

each other. Torsion bars capture the energy

of road shock with a twisting action. In the event of a bad pothole causing a violent shock, any

vibration runs up against unitized construction. There are no body bolts to

shake loose or rattle. Thousands of welds form an

incredibly strong unit, like an air-framé. Hot-Air Intake.

This device simply pre-heats air before being mixed with fuel in the carburettor.

If you combine this Hot Air Intake with Regal's Hemispherical combustion chambers, and electronic ignition, it results in more efficient combustion and a minimisation of exhaust emissions. Painting with electricity.

The Electrophoretic dip is the process used to prime Regal bodies.

The body is placed in a tank full of primer which has an electric current running through it.

It greatly improves rust resistance because the primer bonds with the body and penetrates into every little crevice.
