

PETROL ENGINE: BMW recommends the use of RON 95 super unleaded petrol. Output and fuel consumption figures apply to RON 98 fuel. All engines comply with the EU5 emissions standard. Fuel consumption is determined in accordance with the ECE driving cycle made up of approximately one-third urban traffic and two thirds extra-urban driving (based on the distance covered)
