
One tough automobile.



FLEETWOOD BROUGHAM

From the elegant exterior to the spacious interior, the 1979 Fleetwood Brougham is truly one of the world's great sedans. Outside, a new grille accentuates the classic Cadillac front. Inside, a retuned suspension and new body mounts help provide a smooth Cadillac ride. 45/55 dual comfort front seating (seats three people), individual reading lamps, armrests, four-wheel disc brakes and the available electronic-fuel-injected engine all contribute to the pleasure of driving Fleetwood Brougham. Making this a special kind of Cadillac...for special people. (Fleetwood Brougham shown below in Slate Firemist with matching roof.)





Interior comfort and elegance blend together in a peaceful harmony of texture and color. Shown above is new Slate Gray Dante knit cloth with color-coordinated carpet. Other available interiors include genuine leather for the seating areas in a selection of 11 shades. Add a touch of romance and distinction to your Fleetwood Brougham with the available Astroroof (will reduce headroom).

COUPE DE VILLE

For 1979, America's favorite luxury car — Cadillac Coupe deVille — features subtle refinements designed to please the most discerning car owner. Like new seat belt chimes that courteously urge you to buckle up. New digital display AM/FM stereo radio. A new dome light with dual spot map lamps. Even new electrically controlled outside mirrors are available. All this along with automatic climate control...power windows...six-way power seat...and the superb Cadillac ride. You can add to the excitement of your 1979 Coupe deVille with one of seven available two-tone exteriors. (Coupe deVille shown below in Biscayne Aqua Firemist and Atlantis Aqua with matching Elk Grain Cabriolet vinyl roof.)





New patterns and colors highlight the Coupe deVille interior. Comfort never looked so beautiful as in the Antique Dark Aqua leather in seating areas shown above. Ten other shades of leather are also available, while for a more traditional look, there is Durand knit cloth in six color variations.

SEDAN DE VILLE

With standard features that include power door locks, six-way power seat, automatic climate control and new digital display AM/FM stereo radio. Plus new conveniences like seat belt chimes that courteously urge you to buckle up, retuned body and suspension mounts, and a new dome light with dual spot map lamps. 

For added convenience, order Cadillac's Twilight Sentinel, which remembers to turn your lights on at the brink of dusk.

LIMOUSINES

The 1979 Fleetwood Limousine and Fleetwood Formal Limousine. These flagships of the Cadillac fleet combine an incomparable degree of luxury and privacy with an impressive array of standard features. A dual accessory control panel allows rear seat passengers to adjust automatic climate control, power windows. A new rear seat control for radio system is available. Retuned body and suspension mounts combine with electronic level control and Pliacell shock absorbers for a smooth, quiet ride. There's seating for eight in the Fleetwood Limousine. A sliding glass partition separates forward and rear compartments in the Formal Limousine which provides seating for seven. Plus large rear doors in both provide ease of entry and exit. (Fleetwood Formal Limousine shown below in Crater Lake Blue with matching Elk Grain vinyl roof.)





Inside the Cadillac Limousine is a private domain highlighted here by Dark Blue Dante cloth. The front compartment of the Formal Limousine is Black, with Black leather in seating areas, 45/45 divided seating (seats two people), separated from the passenger compartment by sliding glass partition for privacy. Other interior colors available include Slate Gray and Black. All Limousines come equipped with two fold-down auxiliary seats for additional passengers.

SPECIAL EDITIONS

Cadillac Special Editions are a further expression of luxury of choice in action . . . a delightful way to express your individuality.

CUSTOM PHAETON COUPE With a style and appearance apart, the Cadillac Phaeton Coupe reflects the excitement reminiscent of the classic Cadillac convertibles. Brushed chrome moldings with flush-mounted opera lamps and Cadillac crest . . . reduced quarter windows . . . sporty convertible-like roof treatment . . . and "Phaeton" script designation at each rear quarter panel identify it immediately as a Cadillac Special Edition. Wire wheel discs and accent striping add to its distinctive appearance. Inside, there's the solid luxury of 45/55 dual comfort front seating (seats three people), rich leather in the seating areas and a matching leather-trimmed steering wheel. Phaeton Coupes are available in a choice of three color combinations: Cotillion White with Dark Blue roof and White leather in seating areas, Slate Firemist with Black roof and Antique Slate Gray leather seating areas, or Western Saddle Firemist with Dark Brown roof and Antique Saddle leather seating areas. Also included are three roof-mounted assist straps for passenger convenience. Outside embellishments include your choice of standard wheel discs or turbine-vaned wheel discs, accent striping, and a d'Elegance nameplate directly behind the rearmost side windows. Outside, side moldings and accent stripes enhance the profile, while opera lamps (Coupe only) and a handsome script designation serve notice that this is indeed a unique expression of luxury. DIESEL POWER FOR CADILLAC

Available now for Seville and Eldorado... Later in the model year for Fleetwood Brougham and DeVilles.



A word about diesel engines. Diesel engines have been in use since the turn of the century. Their inherent advantages derive from this simple principle: as air is compressed, it becomes hotter—hot enough to ignite fuel. Thus, the diesel uses hot, highly compressed air instead of an electric spark to ignite its fuel. Specific diesel benefits and noteworthy differences from gasoline-powered engines will be apparent.

Diesel for Cadillac. Diesel power will be available at the beginning of the 1979 model year for Eldorado... it will continue to be available for Seville... and is planned as an available power source for Fleetwood Brougham and DeVilles later in the model year. A diesel-powered Cadillac can change your mind about diesel motoring. Unlike most other diesel engines, the one used for Cadillac is a V8. A 5.7 litre fuel-injected diesel with the balance and smoothness of V8 design.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT WITH A DIESEL-POWERED CADILLAC.

- 1. Less costly fuel.** Compared to unleaded gasoline, diesel fuel is traditionally priced lower. How much you save depends on prices where you drive.
- 2. High compression ratio.** Its high compression ratio of 22.5:1 allows the diesel to achieve ignition by the heat of compression.
- 3. Fuel-injection system.** Mounted between the cylinder heads under the air cleaner is a compact rotary pump. This sophisticated device injects exact amounts of fuel under high pressure into each cylinder, according to engine firing order.
- 4. Combustion pre-chambers.** In each cylinder head there is a pre-chamber where fuel is injected at the precise moment to initiate combustion.
- 5. Glow Plugs for cold starts.** A diesel engine uses its high compression ratio to ignite its fuel. As an aid to cold starting, this diesel uses glow plugs—one to a cylinder—to preheat the pre-chamber area around the fuel injector nozzle. This warming

action makes combustion easier as fuel is being injected when the engine is being cranked during starting. A small electronic device automatically turns off the glow plugs after the engine has achieved ignition and is running normally.

6. Dual Batteries. The diesel Cadillac is equipped with two Delco Freedom® batteries.

They provide added current necessary for activating the glow plugs and cranking the high compression engine.

7. Impressive diesel acceleration. It's a V8... and with its high power-to-weight ratio the diesel Cadillac provides impressive acceleration. The dynamic balance of the V8 design also contributes to smoothness of operation.

8. A difference in starting procedures. When you turn the ignition key to on, an amber light will tell you to "WAIT"... while the high-wattage glow plugs heat the combustion pre-chambers. This time will vary depending on the coolant temperature—approximately 6 seconds at 0°F. Sometimes there will be no wait at all. When the green light tells you to "START," just turn the key to the start position, then drive off.

9. Availability of fuel. In the glove compartment you will find a directory listing nearly 5,000 diesel fuel locations in the U.S. and Canada. Diesel fuel pumps are easily identified by conspicuous green designations.

10. No spark plugs, no carburetor, no distributor—no conventional ignition system to tune up. The diesel Cadillac saves you time and expense of ever servicing or replacing these items. Of course, the diesel engine will require maintenance such as an engine oil and oil filter change at 3,000 mile intervals.

Your choice of power sources. Cadillac offers you a choice of engines: a standard gasoline-powered V8 for Fleetwood Brougham, DeVilles and Limousines... an available electronic-fuel-injected V8 for Fleetwood Brougham and DeVilles... a standard electronic-fuel-injected V8 for Seville and Eldorado... or an available 5.7 litre fuel-injected diesel-powered V8.


