

## **Designed for structural integrity**

The roof structure is designed to support more than 1½ times Tracer's total curb weight. And each door is designed to withstand a test load of more than 4,000 pounds.

Added security for children

For added peace of mind, the rear doors are equipped with child-proof locks. By simply moving a lever the rear doors can be set so that they can only be opened from the outside. This effectively prevents the rear doors from inadvertently being opened by children while the car is moving.

The fully equipped wagon

The four-door Tracer wagon shown here shares in the lengthy list of standard features that comes on all Tracers, with a couple of minor differences. Where the two- and four-door hatchback models have a remote hatch release, the wagon features a convenient lock system similar to that in a car door which when unlocked, allows the liftgate to be opened from the outside without a key. The wagon also features a standard rear wiper/washer. To appreciate the thoroughness of thought and planning that went into Tracer's design you really have to get in it and have a good look around. # Comfort takes a back seat

And in the rear, Tracer offers the comfort of a split seatback with a manual adjustment feature. Fixed rear seat headrests are also standard. Access to or from the rear seat is made easier on the two-door Tracer with its front passenger seat that tilts and slides forward out of the way.

# the way. Pockets, bins and versatility

Just about everywhere you look inside Tracer designers have put available space to good use. There are map pockets on the backs of both front seats and on the lower panels of both front doors. A storage bin under the front passenger seat offers a convenient hiding place.


Clear, concise information

The instrument cluster features large dials for speedometer and tachometer. Positioned clearly between them are the fuel and engine temperature coolant gauges. And at night, the panel is backlit to reduce glare.

To keep the driver well informed, Tracer is equipped with a separate trip odom-eter, a digital clock and a diagnostic warning display which alerts the driver to brake lamp failure, low washer fluid level, low oil level and low fuel level. There is also a signal that sounds when the headlights have been left on.




