EDDIE BAUER: THE ULTIMATE AEROSTAR

Chances are that the equipment you would choose for your mini-van is already part of the Ford Eddie Bauer Aerostar. This Aerostar stands apart with its unique two-tone paint treatment, its rich interior compartment, and the degree of comfort and convenience it offers.

The dual reclining captain's chairs feature power lumbar supports. The 2- and 3-passenger rear bench seats fold down to form a bed — ideal for overnight stops on long trips (quad captain's chairs are available at no extra charge). Special Eddie Bauer cloth upholstery covers the seats. Even the front door trim panels are cloth covered. The wheel is wrapped in leather for a comfortable grip.

The high-capacity heating/air conditioning system provides a separate fan control for second-row passengers. Electronic instrumentation, a sophisticated stereo system and a trip computer are all part of the package. Power windows and door locks, electric remote-control mirrors, Privacy™ glass, rear defroster/wiper/washer, interval wipers and roof-mounted luggage rack are also standard. A special two-piece luggage set is included — sent directly from Eddie Bauer.

Eddie Bauer includes the "Ford Care" extended maintenance and limited warranty program. The coverage is 24 months or 24,000 miles, whichever comes first. It's in addition to Ford's substantial new-vehicle warranty coverage.

AEROSTAR XLT AND XLT PLUS WAGON



Aerostar XLT and XLT Plus put the emphasis firmly on style and comfort. Their 7-passenger seating configuration includes dual captain's chairs with seat back recliners and power lumbar supports. The 2- and 3-passenger rear bench seats incorporate a quick-release mechanism that allows easy removal when cargo takes precedence (a feature standard with all Aerostars). With the seats out, the load space is a full 139.3 cubic feet. With the extended model, the total rises to 167.7 cubic feet.

XLT premium features include air conditioning and Privacy™ glass. The tilt steering wheel, speed control and rear window defroster/wiper/washer provide on-road convenience. The AM/FM stereo radio with

cassette includes controls and headphone jacks for 2nd-row rear passengers.

When it comes to equipment, XLT Plus approaches the top-of-the-line Eddie Bauer. The electronics group, with its electronic instrument cluster (see pages 14-15) and Tripminder® computer, also includes the super sound system. In it, the electronic AM/FM stereo radio with cassette tape is augmented by premium sound amplification and controlled by a 7-band graphic equalizer.

Power windows and door locks, electric remote-control mirrors and the handy roof-mounted luggage rack are also standard fare for this well-appointed Aerostar.

XLT and XLT Plus are easily recognized on the outside by their premium wheel covers

and bodyside and liftgate pin-striping. Inside, the deluxe door trim panels have carpeted lower sections and map pockets and the steering wheel is wrapped in leather. It all adds up to a lot of driving and riding pleasure in Aerostar XLT and XLT Plus.

The 5-passenger XL is the standard Aerostar series. But here, standard does not mean spartan. Whether you're taking the gang to the baseball game or running a few errands around town, XL is equipped with comfort.

A glance down XL's list of standard features reveals outstanding value in a compact passenger van. Full length color-keyed carpeting and cloth headliner. Front vinyl bucket seats. Tinted glass all around. Electronic AM radio with digital clock (may be deleted for credit). Front dome, rear cargo and sliding side door stepwell lamps with courtesy switches. Sliding glass in the side door

and opposite windows. Three interior bodyside storage bins (one additional bodyside and two floor-mounted bins with Extended Wagon). An inside fuel filler door release.

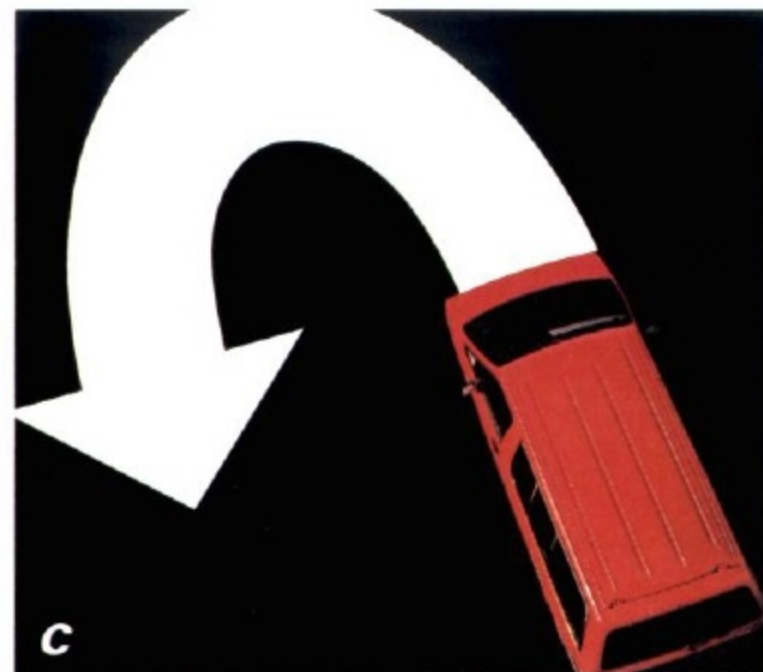
Aerostar's new dark argent and bright grille and restyled front bumper fascia complement its aerodynamic shape. The black foldaway aero mirrors include right-hand convex glass. And the performance side of XL is well represented. Power steering and brakes. P215/70Rx14 all-season steel-belted radials. Super cooling radiator. Gas-pressurized shocks. And a new 21-gallon fuel tank for a greater cruising range. Aerostar XL is a versatile, practical compact wagon. And then some.

AEROSTAR XL PLUS

Take all the desirable qualities of the XL series and add still more comfort and convenience. That's the Aerostar XL Plus. Air conditioning tops the list of premium equipment. Privacy™ glass not only does what its name indicates, it also helps keep the interior cool. The rear window washer and wiper are features very much appreciated on those days when the weather simply won't cooperate. Speed control provides great open-road convenience, especially on those longer trips. And the tilt steering wheel contributes to the comfort of the driver on the road as well as to ease of entry and exit.



A WAGON DESIGNED WITH FUNCTION IN MIND



The science of aerodynamics concerns itself primarily with reducing air drag to increase fuel economy. Air drag is expressed by a vehicle's coefficient of drag (Cd). Because of its low .38 Cd, Aerostar requires less horsepower to overcome wind resistance at moderate to high speeds (Extended Wagon has a .39 Cd). And because the

engine doesn't have to work as hard, it consumes less fuel.

Aerodynamics is involved, however, with more than just achieving higher fuel economy. It also affects a vehicle's behavior on the road. The shape of Aerostar not only reduces wind resistance, but also directs the air flow in such a way as to help decrease front and rear lift, which contributes to handling.

POWER THAT'S INTELLIGENTLY SUPERVISED

Aerostar's standard engine is the 3.0 liter V-6, one of the most powerful available in a mini-van. Under the aerodynamic

hood are 145 horsepower at 4,800 rpm and 165 lbs.-ft. of torque at 3,600 rpm. When it comes to power, these numbers speak for themselves.

The 3.0L features multi-port electronic fuel injection. This EFI system was engineered to balance the demands of performance and fuel economy. EFI works in conjunction with Ford's EEC-IV engine control computer, which processes thousands of bits of information related to engine performance. Once processed, the computer instantaneously adjusts the fuel-air mixture and ignition timing to optimize power, response and efficiency.

The 3.0L V-6 is teamed with a standard 5-speed manual overdrive transmission. Ford's 4-speed Automatic Overdrive transmission is optional and features an electronically controlled torque converter clutch for efficient operation, especially at highway speeds.

AEROSTAR ON THE ROAD

Passenger comfort begins at road level. Aerostar's suspension is a 4-corner coil spring system equipped with gas-pressurized shock absorbers. A low-pressure charge of inert nitrogen gas suppresses foaming of the shock's hydraulic fluid due to rapid bumps or similar agitation. This means the ride is smooth under normal circumstances, yet firm enough for rough going. The suspension is also equipped with components such as a front stabilizer

bar and variable-rate rear coil springs, which enhance Aerostar's handling capability.

GETTING IN AND OUT OF THE TIGHT SPOTS

Design ingenuity has given the spacious Aerostar an overall length of just under 175 inches (190.3 for the extended model). Regular Aerostar is shorter than some other mini-vans. That's an advantage when maneuvering into a tight parking space or into the garage. And even though the Extended Wagon is over 15" longer, it's still shorter than the Ford Taurus wagon. Also contributing to Aerostar's maneuverability is precise power-assisted rack-and-pinion steering.

ABILITY TO TOW BIG TRAILERS

Having a rear-wheel-driven mini-van with Aerostar's V-6 muscle is a big advantage when hauling a camper-trailer or any other large tow-behind. With the driving wheels in the rear, under the load, a properly equipped Aerostar Wagon is rated to tow up to 4,800 pounds.* That's nearly 2½ tons. Impressive for a compact van like Aerostar.

If you're really enthusiastic about recreational vehicles, you'll be pleased to know that Aerostar is well-suited to a variety of aftermarket conversions.

THE BENEFITS OF AEROSTAR INTERIOR DESIGN

With all its maneuverability and trim exterior, Aerostar is spacious enough to seat up to seven passengers. There's no feeling of being cramped. And there's ample walk-around space to get to your seat.

Even before you're seated, you'll notice how Aerostar was designed for ease of entry. Doors to the front compartment are tall and wide. The side door to the rear compartment is large and slides open easily. What's more, Aerostar has a comfortably low "step-in" height to provide convenient entry and exit.

COMFORT BASED ON ERGONOMICS

The science of ergonomics applied to interior design allows you, the driver, to interact more naturally with the vehicle. You are therefore in greater command of driving functions. It also allows comfort and freedom of movement for your passengers.

Seating in Aerostar is designed to help hold you firmly and comfortably in an upright position. Controls are within easy reach, some right at your fingertips on the steering column. Dials and gauges on the instrument cluster are easy to read and are backlit for excellent nighttime visibility.

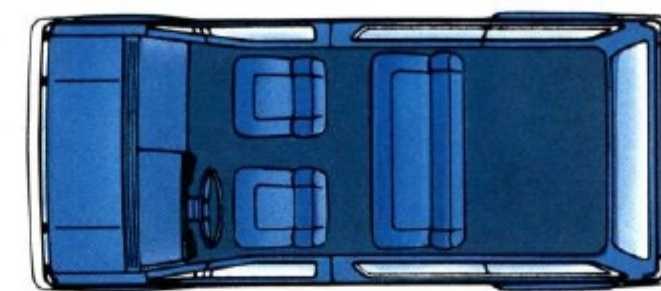

SOPHISTICATED INSTRUMENTATION

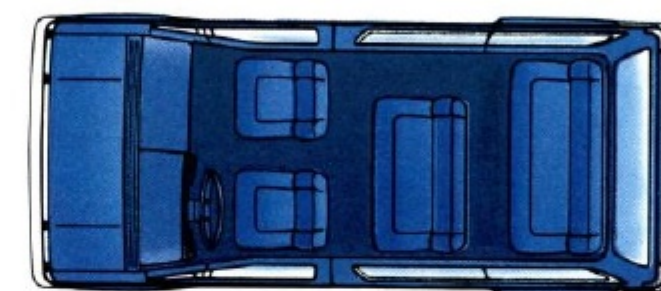
The electronic instrument cluster is the major component of Aerostar's sophisticated electronics group, standard in the Eddie Bauer and XLT Plus and optional in XL, XL Plus and XLT series. An overhead console with Tripminder® computer and the super sound system are also part of the group.

This driver-command electronic center reports information on multi-color liquid crystal displays (LCDs) which are linked to a computer control system. The electronic instrument cluster consists of the following:

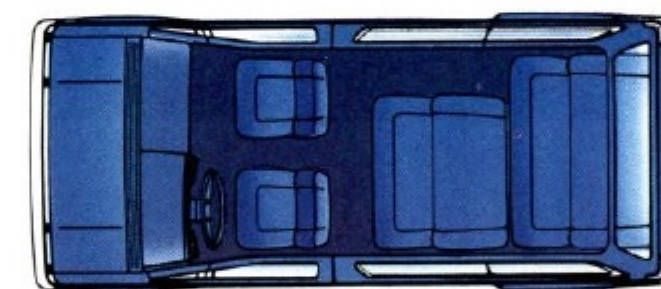
- ☐ Electronic speedometer module displays speeds up to 85 mph/137 km/h, "signal green" digital graphics, 7-digit odometer, trip odometer, and English/metric mode select.
- ☐ Electronic tachometer module up to 6000 RPM is a curved analog display.

SEATING CHOICES

Aerostar comes with 5- or 7-passenger seating arrangements, depending on which series you choose (XL, XL Plus, XLT, XLT Plus or Eddie Bauer). See page 17 for optional seating choices.



AEROSTAR VERSATILITY

Aerostar Wagon is designed for great versatility as well as outstanding comfort. When the maximum space is needed for carrying cargo, the rear bench seat(s) are designed with a "quick-release" feature for easy removal. The seat anchors are recessed, providing a flat, unobstructed load floor. Rear bench seat backs also fold forward against the cushions to provide a flat cargo-carrying area without seat removal (except with seat/bed).

With the spare tire located outside the vehicle, under the body, there are 139.3 cubic feet of usable space in the standard model, 167.7 cubic feet in the extended-length model (with the rear seat(s) removed). And loading or unloading is an easy task, through either the sliding side door or the rear liftgate.



Aerostar provides room and comfort for up to seven passengers. Remove the "quick release" rear seating for 139.3 cu. ft. of cargo space. There's an extra 28.4 cu. ft. in the extended-length model for a total of 167.7.
