



or a full-size van with the advantages of body-onframe construction, the only choice is Ford Econoline. The parallel ladder-type frame has full-length, heavy-gauge side rails with up to six crossmembers with a minimum yield strength of 36,000 pounds per square inch (psi).

Payload capacities on van models range from 1,350 pounds in the long-wheelbase E-150 to 4,670 pounds in the E-350 model. The range of gross vehicle weight ratings (GVWRs) is 5,500 pounds to 9,500 pounds.

Econoline Regular Van with the 124" wheelbase has a cargo volume of 257 cu. ft. The Regular Van on the 138" wheelbase has 302 cu. ft. And the Super Van, with 20 more inches of inside length, has a 347-cubicfoot cargo volume.*

TWIN-I-BEAM FRONT SUSPENSION

With this well-known Ford suspension system, each wheel has its own forged I-beam axle and separate big coil spring to handle rough road conditions independently. The coil springs are computer-selected to match the gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) and the weight of optional equipment. Twin-I-Beam is designed for ruggedness as well as outstanding ride.

ECONOLINE XL

Econoline XL proves that a rugged cargo van can also be pleasurable to drive and handsome to look at.

XL includes comfortable bucket seats with premium vinyl upholstery, color-keyed front floor carpeting with insulation, padded vinyl door trim panels, woodtone appliques on the instrument panel as well as woodtone inserts in the door panels and steering wheel. Outside, XL has chrome bumpers and a bright grille with bright surround molding.

Extra conveniences are also part of the XL series. In addition to two continuous speeds, the windshield wipers can be set in the interval mode for light rain or misty conditions. Working in the dark is no fun. That's why there are courtesy light switches on all the doors — front, side and rear. XL also provides a handy map pocket on each of the door trim panels. And, of course, the XL series includes the impressive list of features included in the standard Econoline series.

Hinged side cargo doors (42.5inch effective opening width) can be chosen at no extra cost.

ith the addition of extended-length and dual rear doors, Aerostar offers more choice than ever when it comes to matching up your vehicle to your special job requirements. Now the cargo van or window van bodystyle can be ordered with one of two cargo volumes.



erostar Van's standard 3.0 liter multiport fuel-injected V-6 engine delivers 145 horsepower at 4,800 rpm and 165 lbs.-ft. of torque at 3,600 rpm. The fuel injection system, controlled by Ford's sophisticated EEC-IV computer, optimizes power and provides precise fuel distribution for efficiency. Choose the standard 5-speed manual overdrive transmission or the optional 4-speed automatic overdrive.

With V-6 power and with the load weight over the driving wheels, a properly equipped Aerostar Van (including the optional trailer towing package) can tow up to 5,100 pounds — over 2½ tons.* Aerostar's standard payload rating is 1,640 pounds and can be increased to an optional 2,010 pounds (1,630 to 1,920 pounds with the extended-length model).

ECONOLINE POWER

Every Econoline gas-powered engine is equipped with multiple-port electronic fuel injection (EFI), which provides smooth overall operation and easy starting. The 4.9L EFI I-6 is the standard engine in all Econolines. This high-torque powerplant is the biggest 6-cylinder engine in its class.

There is a wide choice of V-8 power for Econoline as well. The 5.0L EFI, optional in E-150 and E-250, is the most powerful small V-8 in a full-size cargo van. For heavy-duty applications such as trailer towing, the 5.8L EFI V-8 allows for a maximum 14,000lb. gross combination weight rating (GCWR).

For the big Class IV trailers, the high-cube 7.5L EFI engine

(E-350) is the biggest and most powerful V-8 in a full-size cargo van. It allows for a GCWR of 18,500 pounds and a gross trailer weight of 10,000 pounds.


The largest and most powerful diesel engine available in a full-size van also belongs to Econoline. The 7.3L diesel delivers plenty of muscle for trailer towing, allowing for a 14,000lb. GCWR and a gross trailer weight rating of 8,400 pounds.

EFFICIENT TRANSMISSIONS

Econoline's standard transmission (E-150) is a fully synchronized 5-speed manual overdrive. Automatic choices include a 3-speed and two 4speed automatic overdrives, including a new electronic version for E-350 V-8s (late availability — see your dealer).




