DEFINING FORD FESTIVA

estiva is dedicated to the proposition that all small cars are not the same. Its smooth, aerodynamic shape and flared fenders carry the unmistakable mark of Ford styling. Its solid, wide stance, besides giving it road stability and balance, contributes to the Festiva hallmark; interior space efficiency.

FESTIVA ADVANTAGES

Front-wheel-drive Festiva is a great choice in a small car because it offers so much transportation for the dollar, as evidenced by its extensive standard equipment list.

And by its spaciousness. Festiva's interior roominess is truly surprising considering its trim exterior dimensions. An EPA interior volume index of 98.4 cubic feet makes Festiva roomier than many cars with larger exterior dimensions. Comfort is very much a part of the formula.

So is fun. Festiva's power front disc brakes, responsive suspension, overhead-cam 4-cylinder engine and manual overdrive transaxle make it a lot of fun to drive (an automatic transaxle is optional with L Plus and LX).




An automatic transaxle is optional with L Plus and LX (LX shown). It includes multi-port electronic fuel injection for its 1.3 liter engine.

Festiva also provides the small-car benefits that are expected. Due to its size and 4-cylinder powerplant, it gets excellent gas mileage (EPA estimates were not available at time of publication, see your Ford Dealer). And Festiva's excellent maneuverability and ease of parking make it a natural for urban and/or suburban use.

ord Festiva's ergonomically designed passenger compartment rates an EPA interior volume index of 98.4 cubic feet. That makes Festiva roomier than many cars with larger exterior dimensions. Front occupants enjoy an elevated, "command" seating position,

while rear passengers experience a surprisingly roomy seating area. And for cargo, Festiva offers unusual versatility and spaciousness.

DRIVER CONVENIENCE

Festiva LX instrumentation, both in terms of visibility and arrangement, is an excellent



example of applied ergonomics. The urethane soft-feel steering wheel is comfortable to grip. The horn is located in the wide spokes and can be easily activated with both hands firmly on the wheel.

Demisters help keep the side windows from fogging in inclement weather. Stalkmounted controls operate the

lights, intermittent windshield wipers, windshield washer, turn signals and flash-to-pass.

Sound from the electronic AM/FM stereo radio can be adjusted side to side and front to back. Controls for the dual remote-control electric mirrors, rear window defroster and heating/ventilation system are close at hand.

FESTIVA L AND L PLUS

estiva L is a pleasing combination of comfort, capability and value. The Ford quality commitment can be seen throughout, especially in the careful attention to fit and finish detail. And, like all Ford cars, Festiva is covered by Ford's 6-year/ 60,000-mile powertrain limited warranty and its 6-year/ 100,000-mile corrosion limited warranty (more information on page 11).

The L series offers a standard equipment list that translates into real value for the money. Outside are semistyled steel wheels and wide bodyside moldings. The security of a locking fuel filler door is coupled with the convenience of a tethered gas cap.

The spacious interior features cloth trim for the reclining high-back front buckets and flip-fold rear seat. The rear quarter windows open for enhanced ventilation. Other interior appointments include an inside hood release, side window demisters, courtesy lamps, colorkeyed carpeting and a handy instrument panel coin bin.

The Festiva L Plus offers increased convenience, appearance and entertainment with an electronic AM/ FM stereo radio with 4 speakers and digital clock, bodyside tape stripes and a rear window defroster.

FESTIVA CAPABILITY

ord Festiva was designed to balance a number of driving characteristics to make it a good allaround performer. It balances engine power, for example, with the practicality of good fuel economy.* Handling response is combined with riding smoothness. The steering system provides firm, precise response and a good feel of the road. And Festiva is engineered with quality componentry from Ford's worldwide resources. The result: performance to match a full range of everyday driving demands.

FRONT-WHEEL-DRIVE TRACTION

The advantages of frontwheel drive are well known. With the weight of the engine and transaxle over the driving wheels, Festiva gets good traction in adverse driving conditions such as snow or

mud. And the lack of a drive shaft tunnel increases passenger space.

FESTIVA POWERTEAMS

The standard 1.3 liter overhead-cam 4-cylinder engine has plenty of pep, yet achieves impressive fuel economy. It's teamed with a 4-speed manual overdrive transaxle with the L and L Plus series, and a 5-speed with the LX. The fifth overdrive gear enhances LX highway fuel economy.

When the optional 3-speed automatic transaxle is ordered (available with L Plus and LX series), it's matched with a 1.3 liter engine which features the advantages of multi-port electronic fuel injection (EFI). These include improved overall operation, smooth running and easier starting, even in temperature extremes.



The 1.3 liter 4-cylinder engine provides a balanced combination of power and fuel efficiency. A 1.3 liter EFI engine is included with the optional automatic

Festiva's excellent driving characteristics can be attributed to several engineering components. The rack-andpinion steering system is firm and precise and provides a good feel of the road. The wide stance (55.1" front and 54.5" rear treads) means stability and good overall vehicle balance.


FESTIVA RESPONSE ON THE ROAD

Festiva's suspension-tobody connections are engineered for high rigidity and strength. The MacPherson strut front suspension is a system well recognized for its smooth riding characteristics. A front stabilizer bar works with the suspension to help reduce vehicle sway.

In the torsion-beam-type rear suspension, the stabilizer bar is built in. The system is engineered to maintain the proper camber angle whether turning or going straight ahead. Another benefit of this simple, space-efficient design is that it allows a low trunk floor for increased luggage capacity.

FESTIVA AT ROAD LEVEL

Festiva is equipped to perform well at those four allimportant contact points. 145/SR12 black sidewall steelbelted radial tires feature a road-gripping tread design (165/70SR12 standard with LX). Power front disc brakes give Festiva surefooted stopping ability. The power rear drum brakes are selfadjusting.



Participating Ford Dealers offer the Lifetime Service Guarantee, which guarantees their customer-paid work on your Ford vehicle for as long as you own it. A covered repair is paid for once. If it ever has to be fixed again, the repairing dealer will fix it free. Ask to see a copy of this limited warranty when you visit your participating Ford Dealer.
