

THIS IS NO ORDINARY ENGINE...


Taurus S H O features a new 3.0 liter V-6 powerplant that produces 220 horsepower, 200 foot pounds of torque and red lines at 7000 RPM.

Its advanced technology includes four valves per cylinder—two exhaust and two intake—to breathe life into the engine for high power output and efficiency,* plus double overhead camshafts to improve valvetrain efficiency and maximize power at higher RPM levels.

The engine also utilizes sequential multi-port fuel injection and a leading-edge dual runner intake manifold to give it superb response from idle all the way to the red line. All engine operations are monitored by Ford's advanced EEC-IV computer.

When you put it all together, there can be only one outcome: THIS ENGINE REPRESENTS A NEW BREED IN POWER AND PRECISION. IT'S WHAT SETS SHO APART FROM ANYTHING IN ITS CLASS.

When Ford engineers crafted the riding environment of the Taurus S H O, they had more to accomplish than simply designing a comfortable cockpit. Instead, they divided their design logic into two spheres: to satisfy the driver and the passengers.

From a driver's perspective, Taurus S H O offers a superb blend of comfort and function. Power lumbar and side bolsters firmly hold you in place, while providing a premium blend of lower back and lateral support. The steering wheel and gear shift are ergonomically positioned for easy access and control. And a full complement of analog instruments is positioned clearly in your field of vision.


