Escort roominess and versatility

Ford designers have taken every step, including the use of computer-assist techniques, to create in Escort a roomy, space-efficient environment. The compact-size Escort is spacious enough to seat you and three other passengers in remarkable comfort.

The Escort interior has a practical dimension as well. With the rear seating folded down, the cargo area can be more than doubled in size to provide additional load space when you need it — from 16.4 to 37.5 cu. ft. in hatchbacks, and from 28 to 58.8 cu. ft. in the wagon model.*

In the Escort GL and Pony series, the entire rear bench seat folds down. And the GT series features the added versatility of split dual fold-down seats, which give you the option of lowering only one seat forward for longer cargo while still providing room for a third passenger.

The science of ergonomics

In recent years, Ford designers have been diligently applying the science of ergonomics to the task of designing interiors around the needs of the driver and passengers.

In Escort, it is evident that they have done this job exceptionally well. Inside an Escort, you are not faced with the problem of having to adjust to the interior environment. Rather, the interior is designed to accommodate you. The seats, instrument panel and controls — all are carefully designed to maximize comfort and convenience.

Ergonomic seating and instrumentation

Bucket seats in Escort are contoured to the natural structure of the human body. As ergonomically designed seats should be, they provide the degree of firmness necessary for proper back and thigh support, so you can ride in comfort over long stretches at a time.

Escort also demonstrates ergonomic details in the instrument panel arrangement and placement of operating controls. The instrument panel is driver-biased — that is, angled toward you so that dials and gauges are within your central viewing area and controls are within easy reach.

Visibility and ventilation

These, too, are essential for your comfort. Escort's windows and roof pillars are designed to provide a wide view of the outside environment in all directions. And Escort has a power ventilation system with four blower speeds to regulate heating and cooling through four vent registers on the instrument panel, which also has demisters to help keep the side windows clear of fog and mist.

GT high performance

The real fun of owning an Escort GT is when you're putting it through its paces, whether on a super highway or a winding country road. Under the hood is a spirited multi-port electronically fuelinjected 1.9 liter HO engine with smooth-shifting 5-speed manual transaxle. The performance suspension is equipped with handling components, including specially valved shocks and struts, larger front and unique rear stabilizer bars, for a tight grip on the road. The tires are larger 15-in. P195/60HR15 performance radials mounted on wide 8-spoke aluminum wheels for excellent handling and steering response. The precise rack-and-pinion steering system is power-assisted.



The look of performance

Escort GT is quick, and its looks leave no doubt about it. Fog lamps, front air dam and rear spoiler, special blackout paint treatment, dual electric remote-control mirrors, uniquely styled wheel spats, bodyside and rocker panel moldings distinguish GT as the performancetuned member of the 4-passenger Escort lineup.

An exceptionally well-equipped interior

The GT performance bucket seats are specially designed to hold you firmly in place. They are trimmed completely in cloth, include individual seat back recliners and a center fold-down armrest. Between the seats is a full console with graphic systems monitor. GT's sound system is AM/FM stereo with four speakers.* The sporty door trim panels, styled specially for GT, have carpeted lower sections and handy map pockets. The floor car-peting and the Sound Insulation Package are luxury-level.

GT's 4-spoke steering wheel is wrapped in leather. The instrument cluster features a tachometer, engine temperature gauge and a trip odometer. The rear liftgate opens at the touch of a remote-control button, and the fuel filler door is opened with a lever at the driver's seat. There's an overhead console with electronic digital clock, map/courtesy lights. And GT also includes the convenience of split dual fold-down rear seats.



Luxury Coupe

Escort EXP Luxury Coupe for 1987 offers the combination of luxury, comfort and economy that many drivers look for in a sporty 2-seater.

Power is delivered by an electronically fuel-injected 1.9 liter engine with 5-speed manual transaxle, a highly efficient powerteam. The suspension is independent at all four wheels for a smooth ride and confident handling. Brakes are power-assisted. And complementing the front-wheel-drive system are 14-in. P185/70R14 steel-belted radial tires with all-season tread design.

Luxury Coupe's sleek exterior is highlighted by a Midnight Grey lower paint/tape treatment, special blackout treatment front air dam and rear spoiler, distinctive "bubble-back" rear hatch design, wheel spats, bodyside and rocker panel moldings. A left-hand remotecontrol mirror is also standard.

There are no shortcuts to designing and engineering a quality-built car. Ford engineers have gone to great lengths, applying their automotive expertise and utilizing the latest advancements in automated design and testing techniques, to make Ford Escort a car of outstanding precision and balance.

Fuel-injected 1.9 liter engine

The 1.9 liter engine that powers Escort Pony, GL and Escort EXP Luxury Coupe features significant improvements for 1987.

Electronic central fuel-injection replaces the conventional carburetor. The fast-burn fuel intake port design produces a higher "swirl" effect for a faster burn rate and greater power-efficiency. Components such as the roller tappets and connecting rod bearings have been redesigned to reduce friction. The results are improved low-end torque, higher fuel economy, plus easier starting and smoother running in hot and cold weather.

Fuel-injected 1.9 liter HO

Escort GT and Escort EXP Sport Coupe feature a performance-tuned 1.9 liter HO engine. This is a hemi engine equipped with multi-port electronic fuel injection (EFI). Each cylinder has its own injector for precise control of fuel distribution.

The 1.9 liter HO is designed with freer-breathing hemispherical-shaped cylinder heads, high-lift cam, tuned intake manifold, and an exhaust header that expels gases more efficiently than could a conventional exhaust manifold. These are among the special features that give the 1.9 liter HO engine its higher performance.

EEC-IV computer controls

Escort's 1.9 liter electronically fuel-injected engines are controlled by the EEC-IV computer, a sophisticated microprocessor-based engine control system designed by Ford.

EEC-IV processes thousands of sensor-fed bits of information per second related to conditions affecting engine performance, then balances the fuel-air mixture and ignition timing to optimize power, response and efficiency.

Diesel power and economy

The 2.0 liter diesel is available in Escort GL 4-door. This true diesel features an advanced glow plug system that requires only a 3-sec. wait-to-start time at 0-degrees F.

The common diesel condition of water mixing with the fuel is handled by a fine filtration water separation system with flashing alert light on the instrument panel. Yet another feature of this advanced diesel is an automatic fuel heater to prevent cold weather fuel waxing.

The 2.0L diesel also features a 5-speed manual transaxle, tachometer, engine temperature gauge, trip odometer, plus added sound insulation.

Front-wheel drive traction

Ford Escort is engineered to deliver excellent traction as well as ride smoothness and capable handling. It's all part of Escort's emphasis on total performance.

Cars of compact size typically do not have a lot of rear end weight. And if the rear wheels have to provide the traction, considerable slippage on snow or loose surfaces is usually the result. Front-wheel drive solves most of this problem by placing the weight of the engine over the driving wheels up front.

4-wheel independent suspension system

Escort's 4-wheel independent suspension is the type used in some of the world's finest automobiles.

The front suspension is the MacPherson strut system. Its twintube struts and unique upper mount design help isolate noise and vibration, and the coil springs are slightly

offset at the lower ends to enhance the action of the struts.

The independent rear suspension (IRS) design came out of Ford's worldwide design experience. It was chosen for Escort by engineers who are very familiar with sophisticated suspensions in small European cars and with the narrow, tightly curved roads on which they are driven.

IRS allows each rear wheel to function independently from the other. Thus road shocks and vibration transmitted between the wheels are greatly minimized. It's a primary reason why Escort rides as smoothly as it does on a wheelbase that is only 94.2 inches.

A highly dynamic design

Escort's shape is the creation of Ford's extensive experience in designing cars that slice easily through the air.

Escort's dynamic, low air drag design requires less horsepower to resist the wind. So less fuel is consumed. Handling is also improved. Through careful fine-tuning of selected design areas, airflow is directed in such a way as to reduce front and rear end lift, thereby enhancing directional stability and cornering agility.

Gas mileage






