Very few conventional wagons on the road today offer the exceptional roominess and riding comfort you'll experience in an LTD Crown Victoria or Country Squire Wagon.

Designed for comfort

The LTD environment is roomy and spacious, because the doors, seats and roof were designed for the best combination of head, shoulder, hip and leg room. The front seating is constructed of strong backs and side rails plus "flex-o-lator" mats which support deep-molded foam cushions.

The level of sound insulation is so extensive that LTD quietness is called "Super Luxury." The suspension system features large coil springs plus nitrogen gas-pressurized shock absorbers for smooth riding comfort. The strong body-on-frame construction design incorporates sixteen large rubber

bushings which prevent direct body-to-frame contact, thereby reducing annoying road noise and vibration.

The standard engine is a 5.0 liter sequential electronic fuel-injected V-8 teamed with a 4-speed Automatic Overdrive transmission.

The power of this engine, combined with the strength of body-on-frame construction, gives LTD wagons a trailer towing capability up to 5,000 pounds when equipped with the optional heavy-duty trailer towing package. It's a capability most other cars cannot match.
