attitude.

Dedicated to the proposition that all small cars are not the same, its smooth shape and flared fenders give it distinctive style. A solid stance, besides giving it roadability and balance, contributes to the Festiva hallmark: interior space efficiency with practical people/cargo versatility.

Front-wheel-drive Festiva is a great choice in a small car because it offers so much transportation for the dollar, as evidenced by its extensive standard equipment list.

And by its spaciousness. Festiva's interior roominess is truly surprising considering its trim exterior dimensions. Comfort is very much a part of the formula.

So is fun. Power front disc brakes, MacPherson strut front suspension, torsion-beam-type rear suspension, overhead-cam 4-cylinder EFI engine and 5-speed manual overdrive transaxle make it a lot of fun to drive (an automatic transaxle is optional with L Plus and LX).

The Festiva hallmark: interior space efficiency with practical people/cargo versatility.

Festiva also provides the expected small-car benefits. It gets excellent gas mileage (1990 EPA estimates were not available at time of publication, see your Ford Dealer). Its 10-gallon fuel tank allows an impressive driving

range. Excellent maneuverability and ease of parking make it a natural for urban or suburban use.

### FESTIVA LX

The top-of-the-line Festiva is the well-appointed LX series. In addition to its convenience-oriented interior compartment (detailed on pages 4-5), LX standard equipment includes tinted glass all around, a bright bittersweet accent stripe that runs along the bodyside and bumpers, and a luxury sound insulation package. The rear window wiper/washer is a real foul-weather friend. And the left- and right-hand outside mirrors are electrically remote controlled.

### THE FESTIVA INTERIOR

estiva's ergonomically designed interior rates an EPA passenger volume index of 86.7 cubic feet. Front occupants enjoy an elevated, "command" seating position, while rear passengers experience a surprisingly roomy seating area. And for cargo, Festiva offers unusual versatility and spaciousness. The top-of-theline LX is Festiva interior comfort at its best.

### LX CONVENIENCE

Festiva LX instrumentation, both in terms of visibility and accessibility, is an excellent example of applied ergonomics. The instrument cluster, which includes the tachometer and trip odometer, is

designed to be quickly and easily read. The urethane soft-feel steering wheel is comfortable to grip. The horn is located in the wide spokes and can be easily activated with both hands firmly on the wheel. And the tilt steering column can be adjusted for driver comfort.

Demisters help keep the side windows from fogging in inclement weather. Stalk-mounted controls operate the lights, interval windshield wipers, windshield washer, turn signals and flash-topass, and there's an alert in the

event the headlamps are left on.

Sound from the electronic AM/ FM stereo radio with digital clock can be adjusted side to side and front to back. Controls for the dual remote-control electric mirrors, rear defroster and heating/ventilation system are close at hand.

The LX split/fold rear seat pro-

### **FESTIVA L AND L PLUS**

he Festiva L series offers a standard equipment list that translates into real value for the money with its 1.3 liter EFI engine, 5-speed manual overdrive transaxle, power brakes and steel-belted radial tires. Outside are semi-styled steel wheels and narrow bodyside moldings. The security of a locking fuel filler door is coupled with the convenience of a tethered gas cap.

The spacious interior features cloth and vinyl trim for the reclining high-back front buckets and flipfold rear seat. The rear quarter windows open for enhanced ventilation. Other interior appointments include an inside hood release, side window demisters, courtesy lamps, a release for the front passenger seat that facilitates rear passenger walk in, and color-keyed carpeting. Also standard: a maintenance-free battery and fuel and water temperature gauges.

The Festiva L Plus offers increased convenience, appearance and entertainment with an electronic AM/FM stereo radio with four speakers and integral digital clock, tachometer, trip odometer,

headlamp-on alert, black center pillar and door frame trim, and a rear window defroster.

Also included are P165/70SR12 all-season tires, 4.5" semi-styled steel wheels with trim rings, wide bodyside moldings and full door trim with map pockets. L Plus is attractively outfitted and attractively priced.

AUTOMATIC SHOULDER BELT RESTRAINT SYSTEM

An automatic front shoulder belt restraint system is standard equipment in all Festivas. It automatically secures the front shoulder belts for the driver and passenger.

The motorized shoulder belt moves back and forth on a track located above the door. When a front door is opened, the belt is positioned forward at the front pillar and out of your way for entry.

Once you're seated, have closed the door and turned on the ignition, the belt moves back along the track and across your chest and shoulder. All you have to do manually is fasten your lap safety belt, which should always be worn.

When you're properly parked with the ignition off and it's time to exit, simply open the door and unfasten the lap belt. The shoulder belt automatically moves forward and out of the way. Also, there are emergency release buckles located on the motorized ends of the shoulder belts to release the belts following an accident. Audible and visual signals alert you when one or both belts have been disconnected and retracted from the emergency buckles.

Festiva's automatic shoulder belt restraint system is not intended to function alone. Use the system in conjunction with the manual lap safety belt. For the rear seat, manual shoulder and lap belts are provided.



### **FESTIVA CAPABILITY**

ord Festiva was designed with a balance of driving characteristics to make it a good all-around performer. It balances engine power, for example, with the practicality of good fuel efficiency.\* Handling response is combined with riding smoothness. The steering system provides firm, precise response and a good feel of the road. And Festiva is engineered with quality componentry from Ford's worldwide resources. The result: performance to match a full range of everyday driving demands.

> FRONT-WHEEL-DRIVE TRACTION

The advantages of front-wheel drive are well known. With the weight of the engine and transaxle over the driving wheels, Festiva gets good traction in adverse driving conditions such as snow or mud. And the lack of a drive shaft tunnel increases passenger space.

#### FESTIVA POWER

The standard 1.3 liter overheadcam 4-cylinder engine has plenty of pep, yet achieves impressive fuel economy. It also benefits from the advantages of multi-port electronic fuel injection (EFI). These include improved overall operation, smooth running and easier starting, even in temperature extremes.

This efficient powerplant is teamed with a 5-speed manual transaxle. The overdrive fifth gear enhances highway fuel economy. An optional 3-speed automatic transaxle is available with L Plus and LX.

### FESTIVA AGILITY ON THE ROAD

Festiva's excellent driving characteristics can be attributed to

several engineering components. The rack-and-pinion steering system is firm and precise. The wide stance (55.1" front and 54.5" rear treads) contributes to good overall vehicle balance.


Festiva's suspension-to-body connections are engineered for high rigidity and strength. The MacPherson strut front suspension is a system well recognized for its smooth riding characteristics. A front stabilizer bar works with the suspension to help reduce vehicle sway.

### Performance to match a full range of everyday driving demands.

The torsion-beam-type rear suspension system has the benefit of a simple, space-efficient design that allows a low trunk floor for increased luggage capacity.

Festiva is equipped to perform well at those four all-important contact points, too. All-season P145/SR12 steel-belted radial tires feature a road-gripping tread design (P165/70SR12 standard with L Plus and LX). Power front brakes are the disc type and the power rear drum brakes are selfadjusting.




