### COMPUTER-MANAGED SUSPENSION

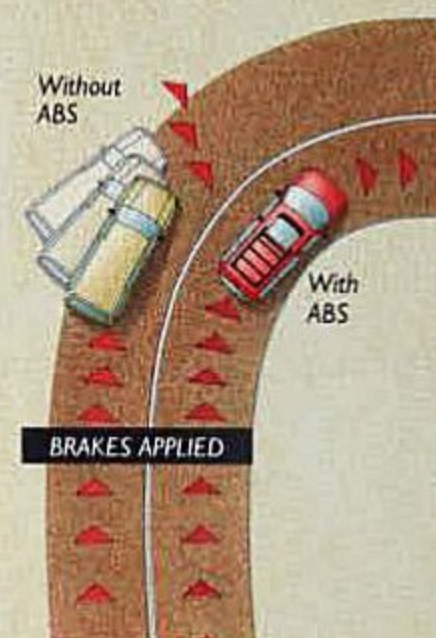
