MODEL RANGE

The pure performer.

This is it: the net result of relentless competition in the FIA World Rally Championship. The turbocharged SUBARU BOXER engines powering the WRX and WRX₂₆₅ (4-door and 5-door) are thoroughly proven, incredibly efficient and wildly powerful all at the same time. In the WRX, the 2.5L DOHC turbo engine creates 224 horsepower and 226 lb-ft of torque – more than enough to trigger an emotional response. The WRX comes standard with sport seats, 17-inch alloy wheels and a rear stabilizer bar for crisp handling. The WRX₂₆₅ simply delivers more of a great thing: specifically, 265 horsepower and 244 lb-ft of torque. A premium audio system (with a 3-month free trial SIRIUS® Satellite Radio subscription), power moonroof, larger rear spoiler (5-door models), summer performance tires and performance-tuned suspension complete this powerful package.

THE CABIN

The start of something great.

Care to slip into something a little more comfortable? How about something a lot more sporty? Then consider the 2009 Subaru Impreza and all that it offers the driver (such as numerous performance-oriented touches) and passengers (including plenty of elbow room for a gang of four). The interior is defined by a sweeping twin-cockpit dash, slick titanium-style accents, blue ambient nighttime lighting for the centre console and premium fabric for the seats. Bonus points: With a twist of the key, the bright red tachometer needle sweeps to life, signaling the beginning of an honest-to-goodness, adrenaline-fueled adventure behind the wheel. The WRX adopts an even higher-performing persona with electroluminescent gauges and sport seats tailor-made for serious g-forces. (All of this is heading in a very good direction.)

CONVENIENCE

At home on the road.

You might say the Subaru Impreza is as flexible as a pilates instructor and as entertaining as a great night on the town. Here's why: Both body styles benefit from one of the widest cargo areas in their class, the 5-door offering the convenience of a rear hatch while the 4-door delivers a refreshing amount of trunk space. In terms of diversions, there's an impressive sound system complete with plenty of desirable features – enough to deem every journey road trip worthy.



All-round storage

Check out the interior of the Subaru Impreza and you'll discover a vast array of storage compartments designed to carry all kinds of necessities. Partitioned door pockets with built-in bottle holders. A centre tray for loose items. A centre console designed to hold CDs. And a 12-volt power outlet to recharge your electronic items. Smart.

Cargo area

Despite its sporty nature, the Subaru Impreza is also designed with utility in mind. The 5-door boasts a cargo area large enough to accommodate five pieces of carry-on luggage. For bigger space requirements, the 60/40-split rear seats fold down to create a completely flat surface. What's more, the innovative double wishbone rear suspension system does not encroach into the cargo compartment, so there's no loss of useable space. The squarish rear gate opening and convenient sub-floor storage compartments complete the picture. In the Impreza 4-door, smart design wins out again. The same rear suspension design helps create trunk space for up to three golf bags, while the 60/40-split flat-folding rear seats open up even more cargo capacity.







Audio systems

Here's a sound decision: The Subaru Impreza 2.5i and WRX come standard with an AM/FM/CD/ MP3/WMA audio system with four speakers, auxiliary input and pre-wiring for Satellite Radio. The premium audio system found on the 2.5i Sport Package and WRX265 models includes a 6-CD changer, two additional speakers, steering wheel-integrated audio controls and a standard SIRIUS® Satellite Radio system with a free, 3-month trial subscription. This system also features SRS Circle Surround Automotive™ technology that creates full, rich surround sound with enhanced bass and a genuine stereophonic feel. (That must be music to your ears.)

From the snow-covered roads of Sweden to the crippling heat of Greece, we learned our lessons well and transferred this knowledge into passenger vehicles with superior levels of agility, stability and traction. To this day, we continue to compete with two clear objectives in mind: Winning championships and bringing further advancements to each and every Subaru vehicle. These advancements are what help to make a Subaru, a Subaru – one of the safest, toughest and most enjoyable vehicles on the road.



At Subaru, we have been building all-wheel drive vehicles since 1972. Currently, our entire vehicle lineup enjoys the benefits of this advanced approach to vehicle dynamics. The result of such foresight and commitment? The development and perfection of Subaru symmetrical full-time AWD. In this layout, all drivetrain components – the engine, transmission, driveshaft, and front and rear differentials – are logically aligned close to the centre point of the vehicle. This gives every Subaru vehicle heightened stability and excellent weight distribution, front to rear and side to side. This unique system is a bilaterally balanced, simple design not only providing exceptionally efficient power delivery and a lower centre of gravity, but also better fuel economy and fewer maintenance requirements compared to other 4WD or AWD systems. Engineered to be an AWD vehicle from the start allows for the symmetrical design of the drivetrain and the ability to deliver greater grip and quicker response to changing conditions. In addition, if any wheel senses slippage, the torque distribution between the front and rear is controlled automatically to maintain optimal traction at all four wheels. Conclusion: Permanent reassurance that you are driving a vehicle famed for its inherent balance, stability and control in a variety of driving conditions.







In the fight to become the best vehicle in your class, it helps to have a boxer in your corner – particularly a SUBARU BOXER. This horizontally-opposed engine layout is renowned for its smoothness: The left bank of pistons counteracts the firing motion of the right bank, thereby balancing each other out and reducing engine vibration overall. This smooth operator

also sits low in the engine compartment, giving each Subaru vehicle a remarkably low centre of gravity. To further enhance durability, handling and directional stability, every SUBARU BOXER is constructed of lightweight, high-strength aluminum. Net result: A powerful and balanced feel at all speeds and a level of performance other vehicles struggle to match.





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Three distinct advantages

Lower centre of gravity

The Subaru Impreza is built from the ground up to have an extremely low centre of gravity, the cornerstone of this design being the SUBARU BOXER engine, placed low in the chassis. This layout, in turn, leads to reduced body roll, along with improved handling and stability, without the need for an overly stiff suspension.



Reduced vibration

With its 180-degree, horizontally-opposed configuration, the SUBARU BOXER engine design cuts vibration dramatically by eliminating the inertia of opposing pistons as found in V-shaped or in-line engine configurations. The result of this innovative engine design is instant responsiveness throughout the rev range, unprecedented smoothness and greatly improved vehicle stability. In addition, less engine vibration also gives rise to a more peaceful and relaxing passenger cabin.

V-type engin

Increased grip

If your vehicle has four wheels, it makes sense that all four should play a role in keeping that vehicle planted on the road. But in front- and rear-wheel drive vehicles, two of the four wheels are essentially just passengers along for the ride. On the other hand, by transmitting power through all four wheels, vehicles equipped with Subaru symmetrical full-time AWD offer increased grip, stability, control and safety – regardless of road or weather conditions.

The Subaru Impreza is available with a range of powerful and efficient engines, from the 2.5L naturally-aspirated version to the super-responsive, high-pressure 2.5L turbo. Each and every engine clearly demonstrates an ongoing commitment to extracting maximum performance at all times.

This system, precisely controlled by the enginemanagement computer, ensures that peak performance, outstanding fuel economy and low emissions are achieved at all times.

Subaru i-Active Valve Lift System

The 2.5-litre SUBARU BOXER engine powering the Subaru Impreza 2.5i and 2.5i Sport Package also features genuine green thinking: two-piece valve lifters that work separately at low rpm and together at high rpm. Incorporating a specially designed camshaft, this system creates better lowend torque, engine efficiency and top-end power, while allowing these models to gain better fuel economy and meet strict emissions standards.

The turbocharged 2.5L DOHC is further enhanced in the high-powered WRX265 through the addition of a larger, high-pressure turbocharger, larger diameter exhaust system and more efficient catalytic converter. The result: a blistering 265 hp and 244 lb-ft of torque with no negative

effect on fuel economy. In addition, despite the muscular levels of performance and low- to midrange torque, the inherent smoothness of this award-winning* SUBARU BOXER engine still shines through.





TRANSMISSION

Your link to driving pleasure.

The Subaru Impreza comes equipped for action with a transmission built to transfer your driving intentions accurately to the road. From the immensely satisfying 5-speed manual to the highly-responsive 4-speed automatic with SPORTSHIFT™, your ability to tackle the everyday and the unexpected is never in question. To complete the picture, Subaru's unique transmission technology has been finetuned to deliver full-time power to every corner of the vehicle, creating greater traction, control and driver confidence.





Manual transmission

The 5-speed Manual Transmission – in combination with Subaru symmetrical full-time AWD and the viscouscoupling limited-slip centre differential – provides certain power delivery and sure-footed grip under all conditions. This design maintains a 50/50 front/rear torque split distribution, giving the Impreza maximum traction and a distinctly sporty edge over the competition. The standard Hill Holder system brings an added measure of reassurance when starting on an incline.

4-speed Electronic Direct Control Automatic Transmission with SPORTSHIFT™(4EAT SS)

Automatic transmission

Available on Impreza 2.5i models, the 4-speed Electronic Direct Control Automatic Transmission with SPORTSHIFT[™] incorporates an advanced multi-plate transfer clutch centre differential for smooth and consistent acceleration, even under lowtraction conditions. Under normal circumstances, this active torque split system maintains a 60/40 front/rear split for more predictable handling and moves towards a 50/50 split when conditions warrant or under hard acceleration. The SPORTSHIFT[™] generates increased fun behind the wheel, allowing drivers to manually shift gears with the flick of a wrist. This feature gives drivers the ability to choose between three different drive modes – Economy mode for optimal fuel efficiency, Sport mode for greater response and SPORTSHIFT[™] for sporty manual control.



Multi-Plate Transfer (MPT) AWD system (4EAT SS models)

The multi-plate transfer system utilizes hightolerance sensors and advanced processing technology to analyze engine output and wheel speed to instantly assess any changes in road conditions. This data is then fed to the transfer clutch, which automatically adjusts the torque distribution to front and rear wheels to create optimum levels of grip.

HANDLING

Precision, control and performance.

In this latest incarnation of the Subaru Impreza, total driving pleasure is taken up a gear, enabling you to feel completely at ease behind the wheel, while still enjoying the exhilaration of knowing you're driving a true performance car. The fully-independent long-travel suspension system has been honed in world rally competition to deliver superb capability over the rough stuff and dynamite handling around the corners. The combination of this sport-tuned suspension – together with a superior drivetrain system and an extremely well-balanced and rigid unibody structure – deliver advanced dynamic performance in the form of exceptional handling, superior driving comfort and high levels of safety in equal measure.



Lightweight components

To maximize the overall driveability provided by Subaru symmetrical full-time AWD, the body of the Subaru Impreza has been kept light, utilizing many aluminum parts and a structure that eliminates the need for extra weight without compromising on strength or safety. Combined with a low centre of gravity drivetrain, this design gives the Impreza unique advantages over other performance-oriented vehicles including superb cornering, remarkable agility and enhanced fuel efficiency.



Front suspension

The super-strong, rally-inspired front strut design has been honed to perfection on the 2009 Subaru Impreza. Increased rigidity and a wide tread provide greater stability when steering or cornering. Lightweight materials reduce unsprung weight for sharper handling, while the long-travel capability soaks up imperfections in the road like a sponge. Lastly, the anti-dive suspension geometry and stabilizer bar help deliver unparalleled performance overall. Whether the objective is to carve through a corner at speed or negotiate a muddy cottage road, this suspension system can handle both with ease and grace.

Rear suspension

At the back, the Impreza is fitted with an advanced double wishbone rear suspension system, the result of countless miles run in world rally competition. The large subframe absorbs impact energy from the tires, preventing it from passing through to the vehicle body; this creates a more stable ride on bumpy roads and reduces body roll when cornering. The long-travel suspension in combination with the double wishbone design ensures the tires remain perpendicular to the road surface at all times, thereby creating maximum traction at all times. In the Impreza WRX and WRX₂₆₅, a rear stabilizer bar also helps to deliver even sportier driving dynamics.





SAFETY

Your safety is our priority.

Some things should never be left to chance – especially the safety of you and your passengers – so every Subaru vehicle is designed to meet the very highest standards for crash worthiness. Active safety systems – such as Subaru symmetrical full-time AWD and the Vehicle Dynamics Control system – give the driver the tools needed to avoid an accident at all costs. In the event that an accident is unavoidable, passive safety features like Subaru's advanced ring-shaped reinforcement frame provide much-needed layers of protection. Net results: top notch crash-test ratings* across the board for the Subaru Impreza and a more comforting driving experience for you.



Vehicle Dynamics Control system

Even when driving a vehicle with Subaru symmetrical full-time AWD, the laws of physics still apply and the level of grip can be exceeded. In these rare times, it's comforting to know that the Vehicle Dynamics Control system[†] and Traction Control System are standing guard – and are standard on every Subaru Impreza. These systems employ a network of sensors to detect when a loss of control is imminent, then make precise adjustments – altering AWD torque split (4EAT SS models), applying brake pressure to individual wheels and controlling engine power output – to restore vehicle stability. t The Subaru Vehicle Dynamics Control system may also be known as Electronic Stability Control.

Brakes

An effective braking system is central to an effective active safety strategy – and the 2009 Subaru Impreza puts this strategy into motion. Standard disc brakes on all four corners for increased stopping power. Standard 4-wheel/4-sensor/ 4-channel ABS to precisely control brake pressure. Standard Electronic Brake-force Distribution to shorten braking distances when carrying a heavy load. Standard Brake Assist to create more braking force in panic situations. And the standard Hill Holder system for 5-speed manual models to prevent roll back when starting on an incline. (When it comes to active safety, nothing should be optional.)

All-around visibility

Active safety begins with visibility. In other words, you can't miss what you can't see. With its carefully designed side pillars and generous glass area, the Subaru Impreza provides excellent visibility to the front, the sides and the rear of the vehicle.





Seatbelts, airbags, head restraints and seat anchors

The Subaru Impreza comes standard with a wealth of safety features designed to protect you and all your passengers in the event of an accident. Front seatbelts with pre-tensioners to hold you in place and load limiters to ease impact and guard against injury. Front, front-seat side and first- and second-row side-curtain airbags. Front-seat head restraints that automatically move forward in a rear-end collision to reduce shock to the head and neck. And the ISO-FIX/LATCH child seat anchor system with three-point seatbelts and head restraints for all rear seats.



Advanced ring-shaped reinforcement frame

Subaru's advanced ring-shaped reinforcement frame found in the Subaru Impreza has generated superior crash-test ratings* and widespread praise. The essentials: a uniform, interconnected energyabsorbing safety cell comprised of the roof, door beams, side pillars and floor. This envelops the entire passenger cabin, thereby helping to dissipate impact energy from all directions. In the event of a frontal impact, this advanced design also sees the main frame compress gradually and the engine slide under the passenger compartment.
