


The new Thunderbird with Exterior Decor Group or Exterior Luxury Group offers you a distinctive styling choice. The Exterior Decor Group option is available with the large rear window and includes a smart rear half vinyl roof (eight color choices), vinyl insert bodyside moldings, dual remote control mirrors, bodyside paint stripes, and luxury wheel covers. The Exterior Luxury Group has a padded vinyl roof with wrapover band, opera windows

(far right), plus the other Decor features.

New "space-age" options can add excitement to this or any other 1980 Thunderbird. The electronic instrument cluster (right) features a digital speedometer, "bar chart" fuel gauge, and warning lights (separate option) that monitor seven areas: "low fuel," "low washer fluid," "low beam out," "taillamp out," "brake lamp out," "door ajar," and "headlamps on" with audible warning. Another innovation

is the remarkable keyless entry system. Five small calculator-type push buttons in the upper driver's door, when depressed in the proper coded sequence, unlock the car or release the deck lid latch. For an idea of the generous array of options available to you, see page 9.
