# INTRODUCING THE 1981 ESCORT — 'BUILT IN AMERICA TO TAKE ON THE WORLD'

Top engineers from the entire worldwide resources of Ford Motor Company have combined their talents to create Escort — a new World Car. Escort is the result of creative efforts of thousands of men and women at facilities in Germany, England, Japan, Spain and the United States.

The 1981 Escort is designed and engineered for the increasingly cost- and energy-conscious world of the 1980's.

All-new powertrains, front-wheel drive, independent four-wheel suspension, and advance use of high-strength steel all were designed specifically for Escort. The latest automobile technology went into the design of the 1981 Escort, and extensive testing in Europe and the U.S. has proven the excellent adaptation of that technology. The result is a combination of fuel economy, ride and handling in a space-efficient car.

Available in three-door hatchback and four-door liftgate models, Escort comes in five series . . . Base, L, GL, top-of-the-line GLX and the SS sporty version. A broad range of standard features and available options are designed for a wide variety of driving preferences and transportation needs.



# **Escort: The Essence of Engineering Expertise**

Engineering expertise from around the world was devoted to make Escort one of the most economical and efficient cars built anywhere.

Advanced technology has produced new powertrains, including an all-new four-cylinder Compound Valve Hemispherical (CVH) overhead-cam engine. The hemispherical head design allows the highest horsepower-to-weight ratio of any Ford engine through optimized combustion efficiency. The CVH engine is available in both 1.3-liter and 1.6-liter configurations.

Mounted transversely, the engine is teamed with front-wheel drive and four-wheel independent suspension to provide a pleasing combination of driveability and riding comfort.

Teamed with the CVH engine is a standard four-speed, fully synchronized manual transaxle which features wide-ratio gearing for responsive performance with fuel efficiency.

An all-new 3-speed automatic transaxle featuring a patented splittorque-path design is optional with the 1.6-liter version of the engine. This design transmits part of the engine torque mechanically to the drive axles in second and third gears, eliminating some of the traditional hydraulic "slip" normally associated with typical automatic transmissions. The result is fuel economy approaching that of a manual transmission.

For strength without unnecessary weight, many Escort parts are made with a high-strength steel that's stronger pound for pound than ordinary steel. This new type of steel, along with other strong, yet weight-efficient materials, helps Escort achieve high mileage without sacrificing solid construction.

Escort also has a highly aerodynamic design. From the slope of the windshield to the rear aerodeck, Escort's lines have been finetuned to reduce air drag and help stretch gas mileage.

When official EPA gas mileage estimates are released, Escort is expected to be among the best of all gasoline-powered cars on the road.



### **Escort for 1981: Fun to Drive**

The 1981 Escort was designed by some of the world's top engineers for today's motorists who are looking for style, convenience, economy and overall efficiency. But engineers gave motorists a bonus — they also made Escort fun to drive.

With its peppy powerplant — 1.3-liter or optional 1.6-liter CVH engine — Escort has the power efficiency to satisfy even the most discriminating motorist. Rack-and-pinion steering, independent four-wheel suspension and front-wheel drive provide excellent ride and maneuverability characteristics.

But ride and handling are just a part of the exciting features of the 1981 Escort. Escort's design provides outstanding interior dimensions. Escort has more headroom, rear legroom and shoulder room than Volkswagen Rabbit or Honda Accord. Escort has more cargo capacity than Rabbit and Accord and at 101.9 cubic feet, as measured by the EPA Volume Index, has more overall interior space than Rabbit or Accord. For Escort dimensions see the specifications chart in the back of this brochure.

Outside, space is a different story. The 3-door Escort's overall length is 163.9 inches on a 94.2-inch wheelbase. The 1981 Escort can get into and out of most places easily. Escort's small, aerodynamically styled body allows for smooth, effortless handling in city driving or at freeway speeds. It's a car that's a joy to drive, easy to handle. ## 1981 Escort: Comfort and Convenience

Escort exteriors are matched with attractive, yet practical, interiors especially designed for comfort and convenience.

Bucket seats are specially bodycontoured to provide greater cushion
and back support for increased
comfort. Standard front high-back
bucket seats feature a command
seating position. A standard folding
rear seat provides versatility. Standard
equipment includes color-keyed cutpile passenger compartment carpeting,
full soft door trim panels, fully padded
instrument panels, integral coin trays,
and inertia seat-back release for
convenience of rear seat passengers.

Escort's instrument panel is functionally designed and carefully positioned for driver visibility. On the left of the steering column are European-styled "stalk controls" with international symbols which include wiper/washer, horn, turn signals, dimmer switch, and flash-to-pass feature.

A full range of optional features allow motorists to upgrade Escort to add even more comfort and convenience. One item is a console with electronic graphic display module that features warning indicators to show low fuel, low washer-fluid level, and failure of low-beam headlamp, taillamp, and brake lamp. Other optional features include fingertip speed control, pivoting front vent

windows, electronic digital clock, intermittent windshield wipers, reclining front seat backs (standard on GL, GLX, & SS) and a full array of sound systems that range from the standard AM radio to a premium sound system with power amplifier and high fidelity rear speakers available with an AM/FM Stereo Radio with cassette tape player.


