

This year, Tempo offers special equipment packages and some outstanding new features, such as the precise metering control of electronic fuel injection.


Tempo GLX

with cassette tape player ** and graphic equalizer system.





Ford LTD for 1985

Ford LTD sedan and wagon models are roomy and comfortable. And capable on the road, with an aerodynamic shape for stability along with a suspension that features gas-filled shocks and struts for excellent ride and handling. LTD offers a range of powerplants: the economical 2.3 liter OHC engine,* 3.8 liter EFI V-6 standard in wagons, and the 5.0 liter HO engine in the exciting LX Touring Sedan.

LTD

The standard LTD has reclining split bench front seats, or a full-width flight bench seat (non-reclining) that makes LTD a 6-passenger car. Conveniences include trip odometer, front door storage bins, left-hand remote-control mirror, and more. Plus power brakes and P195/75R 14 all-season steel-belted radial tires. The 2.3 liter 4-cylinder engine with SelectShift automatic transmission is standard.

LTD Brougham

In Brougham, the split bench seats have a knit velour seating surface, plus seatback map pockets (except when vinyl trim or flight bench seat is ordered). Door panels have cloth inserts, convenient pull straps and carpeted lower panels. Deep 16-oz. carpeting covers the floor; even the luggage compartment is carpeted. And

Brougham comes with electronic digital clock, automatic parking brake release, RH illuminated visor mirror, and Light Group features including a dual beam map light.

LTD LX

LTD LX is an outstanding performance car with its High Output fuel-injected 5.0 liter engine, specially modified handling suspension, Goodyear Eagle GT P205/70HR 14 performance tires, rack and pinion steering with quick-response 15:1 ratio. The exterior features special charcoal and red-orange accents. And on the inside, the reclining individual front seats have inflatable lumbar supports plus 6-way power adjustment for the driver. There's also a console with floor shift, tachometer, and electronic digital clock.

LTD Wagon

LTD Wagon is powered by a standard 3.8 liter V-6 engine with SelectShift automatic transmission. This engine is electronically fuel-injected; its functions are constantly monitored and adjusted by the advanced EEC-IV computer. LTD Wagon comes with a lockable rear storage compartment, carpeted cargo floor and cargo area light — in addition to all the features standard in the LTD Sedan.



Ford Mustang for 1985

All Mustang series are sporty and well-equipped, from the deluxe LX to the high-performance GT and SVO series. Powerteams range from the economical 2.3 liter engine* on up to the powerful 5.0 liter HO V-8. There is also a variety of suspension packages. Whatever kind of road you like to drive, there's a Mustang engineered to travel it.

Also standard are articulated seats, console, tilt steering wheel, AM/FM stereo,** spoilers front and rear.


Mustang Convertibles

There are two convertible models: The 5.0 liter Mustang GT. And the LX series with 3.8 liter EFI V-6 engine. Both provide room for four passengers, have a power retractable top, roll-down quarter windows, and a dual-function rear glass window that folds with the top or can be zipped out when the top is up.

The 1985¹/2 SVO is powered by a computer-controlled 2.3 liter electronically fuel-injected, turbocharged and intercooled engine with increased performance ratings: 200 horsepower @ 5000 rpm; 240 ft.-lb. of torque @ 3000 rpm.†† This engine has a dual exhaust system, is teamed with a 5-speed manual transmission and Hurst® shifter. SVO also features new aero headlamps, four-wheel power disc brakes, adjustable Koni® gas-filled shocks, special 16-in. tires and wheels. Plus a complete list of other standard features including articulated performance bucket seats.

Ford Escort for 1985½

A redesigned Escort takes the road in mid-year 1985. The exterior features front end styling with new contours to the grille, hood, fenders, plus aero-designed headlamps. Under the hood are greater performance and excellent economy* from the new larger displacement 1.9 liter fast-burn engine. And the four-wheel

independent suspension has been refined to provide excellent handling and a smooth ride.

Escort GL

The GL series adds a lot of comfort and convenience to Escort's roomy interior designed for four. Standard are a fold-down center armrest between the reclining bucket seats, visor mirrors with covers, remote locking fuel filler door, and the added versatility of split-back dual/fold rear seats — these and other conveniences along with attractive exterior trim all around. GL also features luxury sound insulation for riding comfort. The new 1.9 liter fast-burn engine is standard, or choose the 2.0 liter diesel available in both the GL and L series.

Escort and Escort L

The standard Escort and Escort L have a long list of standard features that includes a driver-biased instrument panel with side window demisters, P-metric all-season steel-belted radial tires, aero-designed halogen headlamps, reclining low-back bucket seats, deluxe belts with comfort regulator feature, removable package tray/tonneau cover, power ventilation system and more. All these features plus Escort's advanced design and engineering.

Escort Wagon

Escort L and GL wagons provide a 57.7-cu. ft. cargo volume index when the rear seats are folded down. Both series are equipped with a carpeted load floor and shade-type cargo cover. There's also a handy storage bin and a tailgate "ajar" warning light on the instrument panel. Like the hatchback models, Escort wagons come with reclining front bucket seats trimmed in cloth seating surfaces. The L series has a dual fold rear bench seat, and GL features the versatility of split dual/fold rear seats. For a compact wagon that's big in comfort, convenience and style, look into the new Escort wagon series from Ford.


EXP Turbo Coupe


