




Citroën Xantia has achieved new levels of perfection. Elegant good looks are even more streamlined. Specification is even more lavish. Driving dynamics are class-beating and safety measures are at their most comprehensive ever. With the addition of innovative new diesel technology and the availability of a traffic information system, Xantia is at the very forefront of family and executive motoring.



CITROËN XANTIA HDI A NEW GENERATION OF DIESEL ENGINES

Citroën have long been amongst world leaders in diesel technology, setting standards of refinement, economy and power for the motor industry to follow. With the introduction of the new family of direct injection diesels known as HDi, Citroën has once again created the new benchmark. With lower fuel consumption, greater power and economy, less noise and lower emissions, HDi means the diesel engine will never be the same again.



HDi is Citroën's High Pressure Direct Injection Diesel Engine and represents a new landmark in the history of diesel engineering. Created using the most advanced computer aided design technology, HDi wins the battle to deliver lower fuel consumption, greater environmental protection, enhanced driving pleasure and reduced engine noise.

SETTING NEW STANDARDS IN ECONOMY

Diesel has always been the choice for drivers who put fuel economy first on their list of requirements when buying a car. For these drivers, Citroën's new 2.0 litre 110hp HDi engine will come as a revelation, achieving as it does, a substantial reduction in fuel consumption. The figures speak for themselves: HDi consumes 27% less than the equivalent turbo diesel.

The key to this astonishing economy lies in the highly innovative and meticulously engineered common rail injection system.

Using computer-controlled injectors with nozzle openings smaller than 200

microns in diameter, the system can inject fuel at pressures as high as 1350 bar. Even more remarkable, the electronic control is capable of continually varying the pressure between 200 bar and the maximum, depending on engine requirements. So factors like the speed of the car and the load on board dictate the precise quantity of diesel required for combustion. In other words, you use exactly the amount of fuel you need for optimal efficiency and not a drop more.

Result? Considerably reduced fuel costs.

In the past the driver's choice has always been between the reliability, longevity and economy of the diesel engine, or the performance, acceleration and quietness of the petrol engine. Until now, that is.

With the launch of the HDi, Citroën has at a stroke created a completely new choice. This is a diesel engine that can promise spectacular performance, offering as much as 32 per cent more torque than the equivalent turbo diesel. It is a supple, long-legged engine, producing greater torque from lower engine speeds and across a wide rev band. It produces the same torque as a 2.1TD but at a lower rpm, giving more pulling power.

Overtake a long vehicle on the motorway, for example, and feel the massive reserves of power at your disposal. It is the kind of performance that helps keep you and your passengers safe and makes driving a sheer pleasure.

Another remarkable attribute of the new HDi diesel is its smoothness and quietness. Friction of all moving parts has been reduced to a minimum. Applying the latest high-precision methods to the manufacture of the camshaft, con rods and pistons has not only reduced the weight of the moving parts, but the noise and vibration along with it. And the engine is rendered quieter still, by progressive pilot pre-injection. This increases the temperature of the combustion chamber milliseconds before the primary injection, resulting in a smoother, more gradual burn with a significant reduction in vibrations.

In short, no diesel engine has ever been this quiet. Whether it is in low gear or high gear, cold, warm or idling, you will scarcely hear the difference between the sound of the superb new HDi diesel and a petrol engine.

NEW STANDARDS IN THE ENVIRONMENT



The HDI engine is on the side of the environment, reducing emissions of CO2 by as much as 20% and virtually eliminating engine smoke.


In any ecological discussion, diesel makes a great deal of sense. After all, the more thermodynamically efficient an engine is, the less fuel it burns and the less CO2 emissions it produces. The HDi engine is the perfect example of how advanced technology can work towards a cleaner environment.

The more regular the mix of fuel and air when ignited, the fewer the pollutant particles that are given off. The HDi's high pressure pump, along with an extremely innovative combustion chamber allow for a precise fuel mix, enhanced combustion efficiency and minimal noxious emissions. Furthermore, the pilot pre-injection creates

smoother, well-controlled combustion, which in turn leads to enhanced emission control

As final proof that the HDi engine is a true friend to the environment, it produces absolutely no smoke over 95% of the operating range!

Produced with cutting edge technology, this advanced diesel engine has set new standards for refinement, performance, economy and emissions. It is available now on Xantia Saloon and Estate LX, SX and Exclusive models, putting this already outstanding range of cars into a class that is truly unique.

CITROËN XANTIA ACTIVA. THE ULTIMATE IN CONTROL AND BALANCE

Every aspect of Xantia's outstanding chassis and suspension design, from the weighting of the power steering to the tread pattern of the tyres, has been considered with the greatest care. So power is transmitted to the road with maximum safety, ride comfort and driving enjoyment.

At the heart of Xantia's comfort and driving dynamics is Citroën's unique self-levelling suspension (controlled by computer on Activa and Exclusive models) which guarantees a constant ride height and expert handling abilities no matter what the

load on board. Citroën's programmed selfsteer rear axle, which turns the rear wheels marginally in line with the front wheels, also makes a considerable contribution to Xantia's sure-footed road manners.

When you combine these advanced suspension systems with the Activa model's revolutionary Active Roll Control System (ARCS), which dramatically reduces body roll, you have levels of balance, control and safety which are virtually unequalled. Even when negotiating a roundabout or braking into a corner.

Enter a bend and within o.o4 of a second, Activa's computer stiffens the suspension. If body movement continues, high pressure hydraulic fluid is directed to corrector cylinders positioned on the front and rear anti-roll bars. These extend or contract together to level the car. The result is one of the most stable, safe and comfortable cars on the road.

If you're going to drive a car that handles as well as this, you should be in a position of perfect control. And that is exactly where Xantia's cockpit puts you. It only takes one move to reach all controls and switches, and one glance to receive all the driver information you require.

system as standard. A fully integrated real time traffic information system, Oracle keeps you on the move by advising you of any traffic problems on the road ahead. The Oracle network covers some 7,500 miles of motorway and trunk roads throughout the UK, helping you avoid traffic hot spots and saving you what could be hours of delay and frustration.

RELAX AND TAKE CONTROL

Behind the wheel of the Citroën Xantia, your overriding impression will be one of complete confidence and effortless control. Every aspect of the cockpit has been designed to ensure the driver stays relaxed and alert, with minimum fatigue, even on the longest journeys.

TAILOR-MADE DRIVING




In a Xantia you can fine-tune your most comfortable – and consequently safer – driving position through the combination of a height-adjustable steering wheel and seat belts. The driver's seat on all models from LX upwards is fitted with height adjustments. And on Exclusive models, both front seats are electrically adjustable and heated.

Visibility is superb, enhanced by a wideangle driver's door mirror on all models and
by electrically operated and heated door
mirrors on SX models and above. In
addition, all models feature an electrically
adjustable passenger door mirror. Rainsensing windscreen wipers are fitted to SX
models and above. While the Exclusive
model's high pressure headlamp washer
jets and heated windscreen washer jets
help guarantee you're cleared and ready for
take-off in all weathers.



All Xantias from the LX model are equipped with TrafficmasterTM Oracle, a real time traffic information service which keeps the driver on the move by informing him of any traffic delays on the road ahead. Oracle is integrated into the car's radio system and provides verbal messages to the driver. Additionally, a green LED display indicates a clear road ahead, while a red display denotes congestion. If the driver prefers not to receive automatic verbal messages, Oracle can be switched to 'manual' mode where the driver receives only visual display.



In addition to high frequency remote control central locking and deadlocks, Xantia's security is ensured by the latest generation transponder immobiliser. The engine will only start after the ignition control unit has verified the unique code on your car key.

Constant improvement and refinement has resulted in a host of clever ideas and thoughtful touches that make driving a Xantia an even safer and more pleasurable experience. An extra power socket on the console can be used for mobile 'phones or

laptops. On Exclusive models, an indexable passenger door mirror gives you a clear view of the kerb when you're parking.



To give a clear view when parking, the indexable passenger door mirror dips to give a clear view of the kerb when reversing, returning to its normal position afterwards (on Exclusive models only).



Automatic front wipers are activated by a rain sensor positioned on the windscreen. They will operate at either intermittent variable speed or at one of two pre-set speeds, leaving the driver free to forget the rain and concentrate on driving (SX models and above).



Xantia's air conditioning gives you complete climate control inside your car, supplying a stream of clean, cool dehumidified air to the cabin, leaving you cool, calm and collected even on the hottest

day. You can set your ideal travelling temperature and the automatic temperature control system will maintain it throughout your journey.

Xantia's designers have also thoughtfully provided you with an abundance of clever and discreet storage space. There are places to hide your valuable items, or tidy away all that necessary paraphernalia of travel, leaving you and your passengers free to enjoy the journey in uncluttered comfort.

Citroën's unique self-levelling suspension guarantees a perfectly level ride height, no matter how heavy the load on board. So when you take your family and all its luggage on holiday, Xantia maintains exactly the same aerodynamic efficiency and handles with just the same sharpness as it would if you were making a solo trip.



Xantia's height-adjustable suspension system can be lowered to make light work of loading or hitching up a trailer. Or it can be raised to give extra ground clearance, when driving on rough road surfaces, for example.


A NEW DIMENSION TO DRIVING DYNAMICS

Computer-controlled hydractive suspension is available on Exclusive and Activa models and combines the benefits of self-levelling suspension with the intelligence of advanced electronics. Strategically placed sensors continuously monitor vehicle movement and driver input such as acceleration, steering and braking. This information is relayed to the car's central computer which reacts instantaneously (with 1/500th of a second) by selecting the suspension state which best suits the road conditions and your driving style: firmer spring and damper settings when braking or

cornering and more pliant when driving on the motorway, for example.

Also, for those who enjoy a more forceful style of driving, a switch mounted on the centre console allows you to change the suspension from the standard 'Comfort' mode to 'Sport' for the taut control of a sports saloon.

Drivers no longer have to compromise between high levels of comfort or secure handling. With a Citroën Xantia they can have both.






THE ROADHOLDING IS EVEN MORE SURE-FOOTED

For most manufacturers, this degree of roadholding, ride comfort and exhilarating handling would be sufficient. But being Citroën, we have added another vitally important innovation: the programmed selfsteer rear axle. The system turns the rear wheels marginally in line with the front wheels. The result is perfect roadholding. Even on the most sweeping bends or the tightest corners, Xantia holds the road with unshakeable poise.

Even more important than driving enjoyment is driving safety, and Xantia's brilliant chassis and suspension provide the manoeuvrability and grip to keep drivers out of trouble.

So too does its powerful braking system. Citroën now offer the controlled, straight line stopping power of the latest generation four sensor ABS brakes as standard on all models.

THE REASSURANCE OF ALL-ROUND SAFETY

No matter how experienced a driver you are, hazardous situations can never be avoided completely. The Xantia therefore comes with its most comprehensive package of active and passive safety features ever. And while we hope you never need them, it's reassuring to know they are there.

Xantia's passive safety begins with an immensely strong body of high tensile steel. The rigid passenger cell is encircled by a ring of steel to protect occupants in the event of an impact, and steel impact beams are

incorporated into all doors.

Additional security comes from Citroën's Progressive Lateral Safety concept (PLS) with energy-absorbing side impact protection. In the event of a collision, the front door panels are designed to deform progressively. The force of the impact is safely transferred through the car's structure and away from the occupants.



Xantia's wealth of passive safety features are all designed to minimise damage in the event of an accident. With the right measures of course, an accident can often be avoided altogether. And this is where Citroën's invaluable experience in the field of active safety comes into its own.

Generally speaking, safe driving is a matter of how well you are in control of a driving situation: taking a sharp bend on a wet road for example, emergency braking or simply changing lanes.

Every one of Xantia's active safety features - suspension, steering and brakes - has been painstakingly engineered to give you optimum control in such hazardous

You would expect an estate car to be able to carry large and heavy loads. But it is the elegance, style, ease and sheer ingenuity with which it accomplishes all the tasks required of it that mark out the Xantia Estate as something very special.

BEAUTIFULLY ADAPTABLE SPACE

If the first test of an estate car is to carry formidable loads, Xantia Estate passes with flying colours. The enormous cargo area swallows up to 618 litres of luggage without turning a hair. And that's even before you fold the rear seats forward!





With the split-folding rear seats folded forward, Xantia will accommodate loads up to 1.63m in length.




The Xantia Estate offers 618 litres of bootspace with the seats up and 1690 litres of space with the rear seats folded down.

CARRYING HEAVY LOADS WITH PERFECT POISE



A protective boot net on Exclusive and Activa models prevents loose items from rolling around the boot.

When you do fold the split-folding rear seats forward, Xantia rewards you with 1.63m of flat carrying space; enough to hold a massive 1690 litres. A low rear sill (just 526mm off the ground at normal running level) makes light work of loading. And thanks to height-adjustable suspension this can be lowered even further for attaching a trailer or caravan. Once you're loaded and under way, the self-levelling suspension maintains a constant ride height and your Xantia performs and handles with all the agility of an empty car.

Xantia copes with smaller, individual items of luggage with equal equanimity. The rear parcel shelf, for example, is part rigid, part retractable. Loose items can be tucked tidily away into the boot's two covered storage compartments. Standard on Activa and Exclusive models and available as an accessory across the range is a boot net to prevent individual items from rolling around. And to make sure the load in the back stays in the back, lashing points allow baggage to be firmly anchored.



At the top of the petrol engine line-up is the latest generation, light alloy, 3.0 litre unit that lies at the heart of the Xantia Exclusive. 




