Safety

In keeping with its role as a passenger vehicle, the new Tourneo and Ford Transit Minibuses reinforced body structure offers plenty of all-round passive protection. Plus a wealth of sophisticated active safety features too. These include four-wheel disc brakes with ABS (anti-lock brakes) and electronic brake-force distribution to help prevent the rear wheels from locking-up, particularly when driving unladen.

ESP (Electronic Stability Programme) comes with Brake Assist – a system that detects emergency braking and applies maximum braking effort to potentially reduce the stopping distance – and BTCS (brake traction control system) to aid traction when pulling away from rest.

In addition, every new Tourneo and Ford Transit Minibus benefits from numerous practical safety features, including a driver and front outer passenger airbag* as standard. Optional side airbags are also now available (standard on leather seats). Visibility is enhanced by large exterior door mirrors with wide angle lenses.

All of the seats are equipped with three-point lap and diagonal seat belts. Second row seats are provided with ISOFIX anchorage points in the centre and offside positions to ensure the secure installation and easy removal of child seats. Ford was also the first manufacturer to test seat belts to M1* passenger car levels, well in advance of any legislative requirements.

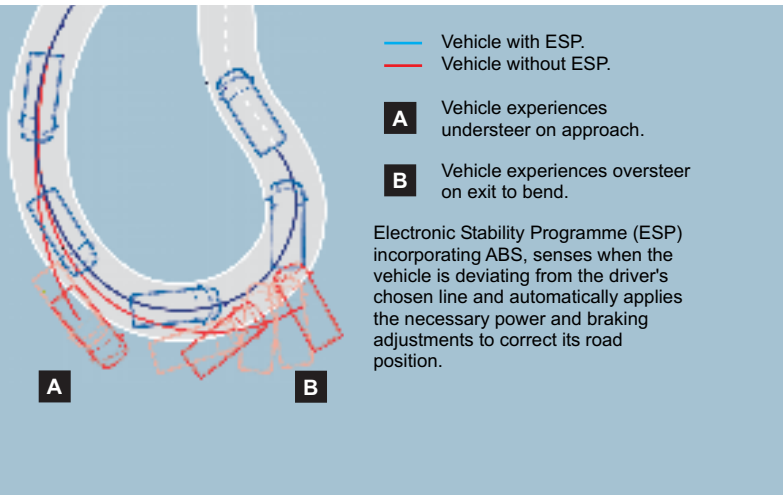

Safety is a key feature of all Ford passenger vehicles and all new Ford Transit models have a driver's airbag, with the option of a front passenger airbag and side airbags (standard on leather seats).

Security

All new Ford Transits come with a Ford Safeguard Passive Anti-Theft System (PATS) engine immobiliser (certified to Thatcham Category 2), high-security shielded locks with strengthened mountings, lockable fuel filler, visible Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) and VIN-protected audio units.

Additional security features include:

- Unique lock-in-latch door lock system eliminates cables and rods between the lock and the latch
- Remote keyless central double locking (Tourneo)
- Remote keyless central locking (9, 12, 15 and 17-seat Minibus)
- Key-locking bonnet helps to protect the engine from tampering
- 'Torque slip' anti-theft steering wheel renders the steering wheel inoperative if excessive force is applied to it

*M1 passenger car crash testing requires that a vehicle's seats, seat belts and mountings withstand a 20 g deceleration from 30 mph. This is twice that required for M2 commercial certification, which is the legal requirement for minibuses.

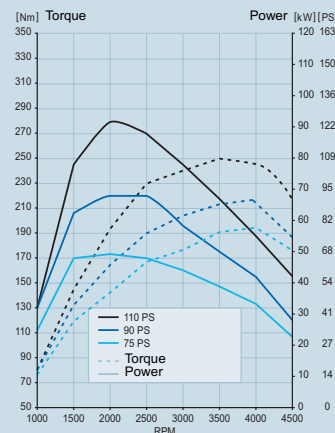

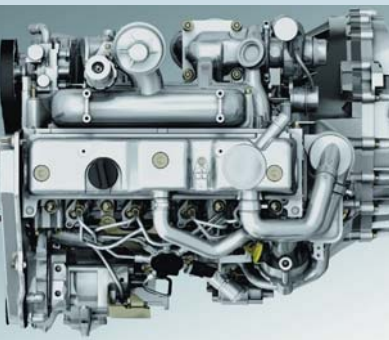

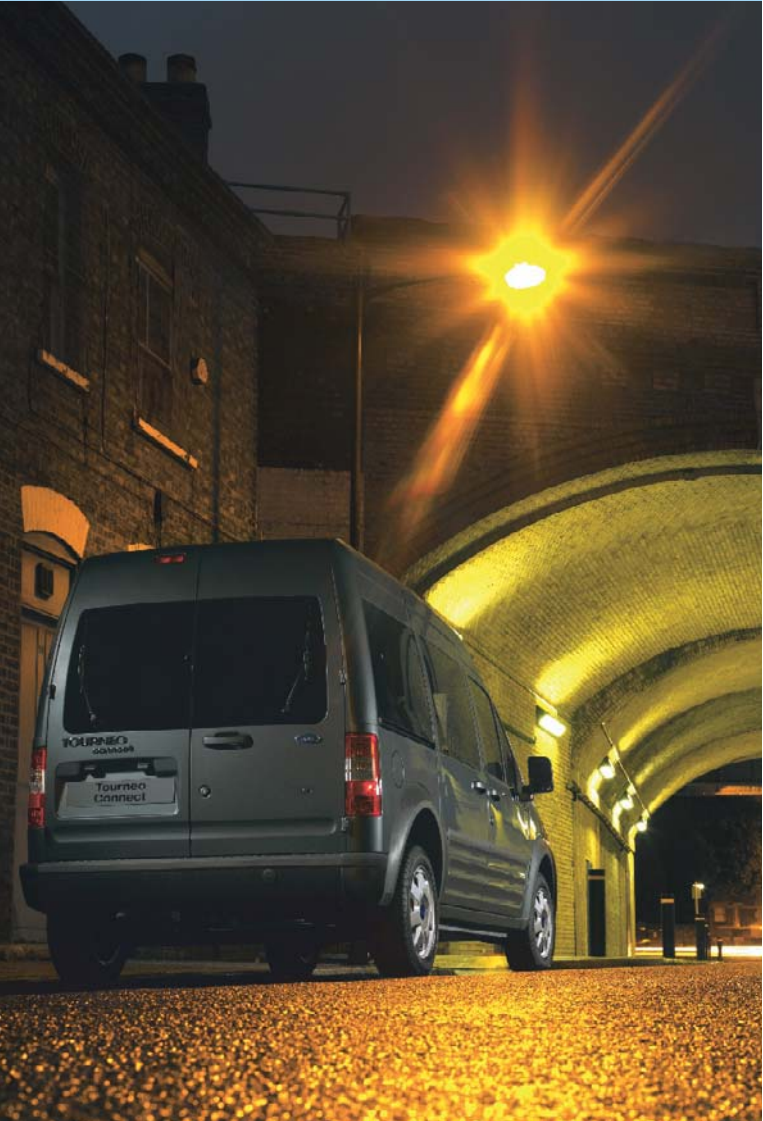

Care for the environment is one of Ford's oldest concerns. Long before it became fashionable or required by law, we were questioning established practices and searching for better, more efficient alternatives. Like so much of our philosophy, the concept of sustainability dates right back to our founder, Henry Ford, a man who could not abide unnecessary waste.

Driving into the future

Lighter, quieter, and using less fuel with lower emissions, today's Ford engines create less impact on the environment than ever before. Our smooth, quiet and economical diesel engines comply with the strict Euro Stage IV emissions regulations while, at the same time, offer greater overall performance. Our latest range of Duratorq TDCi diesel engines, for example, now develop more torque than their predecessors, while producing significantly lower carbon dioxide (CO₂) and particulate emissions.

A natural approach to alternative fuel

A new Duratec 2.3-litre 145 PS/200 Nm four-cylinder petrol engine forms part of the new Ford Transit powertrain line-up. As well as meeting Euro Stage IV emission legislation, the use of hardened valve seat material means it can be converted to run on liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) or compressed natural gas (CNG). Further evidence of our drive to safeguard the environment can be seen in the Focus Flexi-Fuel. The 1.8-litre car can run on petrol, bioethanol, or a mixture of the two, and offers a 70% reduction in carbon dioxide emissions compared to a petrol model, without any loss in performance. Because bioethanol fuel is plant-based, the CO₂ emitted at the tailpipe is broadly equal to the CO₂ absorbed while the plants were growing.

Recycling for good

Legend has it that Henry Ford used timber from old packing cases to build floors for the Model T. Today, the average Ford vehicle includes more recycled material than ever. Across our European vehicle range, more than 300 parts are made from recycled non-metallic materials. This helps to safeguard raw materials and diverts unwanted waste from landfill sites. Combined, our use of parts manufactured from recycled and renewable materials kept almost 35,000 tonnes* of waste out of landfills.

Environmental management

Ford Motor Company was the first automotive manufacturer to certify all of its manufacturing facilities around the world to ISO 14001, the international standard on Environmental Management Systems. Under the standard, the company's air, water, chemical handling and recycling activities are regulated and independently audited.
