## Safety and security

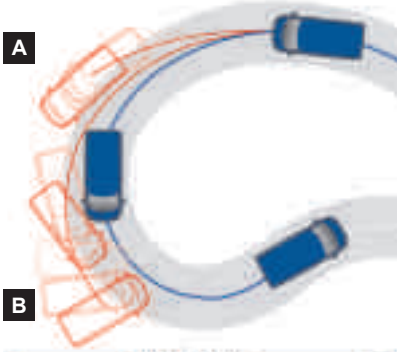
As a business user, you need to have complete confidence in the safety and security of your vehicle. Not just in its performance, but also in the way it looks after you and your passengers. So the Ford Transit has been built to provide reassuring levels of protection, because you only feel comfortable when you feel safe.

It's tough on the streets. So the Ford Transit is endowed with end-to-end strength to command respect when tangling with city traffic. Plus, one of the most comprehensive safety and security packages in the business.

Ford Transit is equipped with four-wheel anti-lock disc brakes and ESP (Electronic Stability Programme).

### Electronic Stability Programme

ESP incorporating ABS, senses when the vehicle is deviating from the driver's chosen line and automatically applies the necessary power and braking adjustments to correct its road position. Brake Assist – a system that detects emergency braking and applies maximum braking effort to potentially reduce the stopping distance. Brake Traction Control System (BTCS) to aid traction when pulling away from rest. Hill Launch Assist (HLA) prevents the vehicle from rolling back when pulling away on a slope.

\*M1 passenger car crash testing requires that a vehicle's seats, seat belts and mountings withstand a 20 g deceleration from 30mph. This is twice that required for M2 commercial certification, which is the legal requirement for minibuses.

The Ford Tourneo and Minibus reinforced body structure offers plenty of all-round passive protection. Plus a wealth of sophisticated active safety features too. These include four-wheel disc brakes with ABS (anti-lock brakes) and electronic brake-force distribution to help prevent the rear wheels from locking-up.

Every Tourneo and Ford Transit Minibus benefits from numerous practical safety features, including a driver and front outer passenger airbag as standard. Optional side airbags are also now available (standard on leather seats).

All of the seats are equipped with three-point lap and diagonal seat belts. Second row seats are provided with ISOFIX anchorage points to ensure the secure installation and easy removal of child seats. Ford was also the first manufacturer to test seat belts to M1\* passenger car levels, well in advance of any legislative requirements.

With a host of awards to its name, the Ford Transit is consistently recognised by the industry as a class-leader for security. The latest model builds on this reputation to offer a comprehensive portfolio of affordable and proven security technology.

All Ford Transits come with a Ford Safeguard Passive Anti-Theft System (PATS) engine immobiliser (certified to Thatcham Category 2), high-security shielded locks with strengthened mountings, lockable fuel filler, visible Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) and VIN-protected audio units.

A newly-developed range of 2.2 Duratorq TDCi diesel engines forms the backbone of the Ford Transit powertrain line-up. Engineered to meet stringent Euro Stage V emissions standards, the engines offer an impressive choice of power and torque outputs, ranging from 125 PS/330 Nm to 140 PS/350 Nm on M1 vehicles and a 135 PS/355 Nm on M2.

**ECOPack**
