Economy alone sets the 260C apart — even the estate car version is easily capable of 24 m.p.g. on low grade petrol; some owners claim much more and that makes a big difference to your budget in these days of high petrol costs.

There are two versions of the 260C, a luxurious 5 seater saloon, and the new 260C Estate, a really spacious car seating up to 7 people or, with the seats folded, offering a vast loading area for luggage or equipment.

Drive the 260C and you'll quickly appreciate its quality and sound engineering, an appreciation that will grow long after you'd expect the initial pride of ownership to wear off.



















260G SALOON

The 260C saloon is powered by a 2.6 litre overhead camshaft engine with the smooth, willing performance you associate with six cylinders. There's well over 100 m.p.h. available, if you need it . . . 70 is an economical amble, a quiet relaxed cruising speed that takes nothing out of you or the car.

The precision built four-speed allsynchromesh gearbox is light and easy, with the option of a refined three-speed automatic transmission, if you prefer the car to do the thinking.

The suspension, independent at the front, is a simple yet truly effective system, achieving a really comfortable ride with safe, predictable handling. Double acting shock absorbers help smooth out even the worst of roads.

The power-assisted braking system, with large discs at the front, and self-adjusting drums at the rear, provides really effective stopping power with the minimum of effort.

Now take a look at the interior. It's refined, spacious—plenty of room for five adults in deeply padded cloth-upholstered seats. The front seats are fully reclining and have adjustable head restraints. For the driver, there's a separate height adjustment, so you can achieve exactly the right driving position for YOU!

There's comprehensive equipment too, with an electric aerial for the self-seeking radio which you can control from front or rear compartments, tinted glass all round, electric clock with sweep second hand and date display, cigar lighters front and back, reading lights, warning lights in the trailing edges of the rear doors, stop and rear lamp repeaters visible to the driver, remote controlled opening of the boot, and much more.

Safety, too, is a priority Datsun feature. Front and rear sections of the 260C are scientifically constructed to absorb energy on impact and protect the passenger compartment; there's a Datsun safety steering column and all minor controls are recessed for added safety. This car is built to protect *you* in a crash.

For night driving, the 260C is fitted with a long-range 4-headlamp system so you can really see where you're going. There are automatic reversing lights, and hazard flashers in case you ever need them.

The 260C is well-equipped for bad weather too. There are 3-speed wipers, with an intermittent wash/wipe facility, electric screenwashers and a heated rear window.

The 260C saloon is a prestige family car combining impressive looks and luxury with the sound and thoughtful engineering that produces genuine Datsun reliability and economy.











260G ESTATE

The 260C Estate is for the family man who requires the power and luxury of a prestige saloon with the practical advantages of a really spacious load carrier. You get similar performance to the 260C saloon, with over 100 m.p.h. available if the opportunity arises. Stuart Marshall of The Times newspaper wrote in a recent road test "The engine makes so little noise that at 70 m.p.h. on the motorway, it's a pleasure to listen to the magnificent signal seeking radio that's part of the standard package".

And he achieved an average fuel consumption of 23/24 m.p.g.

The 260C Estate has styling which is both attractive and practical. This car is designed by people who know what they're doing!

The roomy, well equipped interior seats up to seven people; five in the deeply upholstered forward facing seats and two on an occasional rear seat that folds away into the floor of the luggage compartment when it's not needed.

As a load carrier, the 260C Estate is a giant in its class. With both rear seats folded, it will take 72 cu.ft. of luggage, or equipment, in a load area over 73 inches long. That's *really* spacious! There's a high lift, counterbalanced tailgate and, for loading smaller items, the rear side window can be electrically operated from the driver's seat or from outside the car. That's the sort of thought and care that goes into the building of a Datsun.
