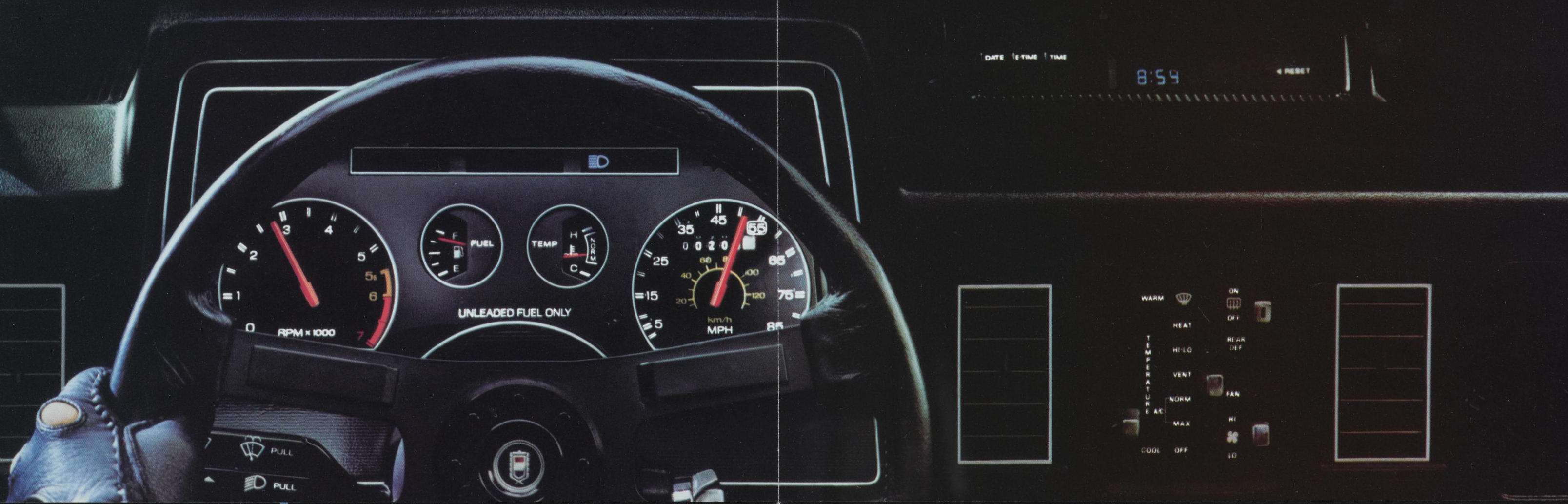
Front-wheel drive provides better all-around traction, especially on slippery surfaces.

Four-wheel independent suspension is a sophisticated system designed for precise handling plus riding comfort.

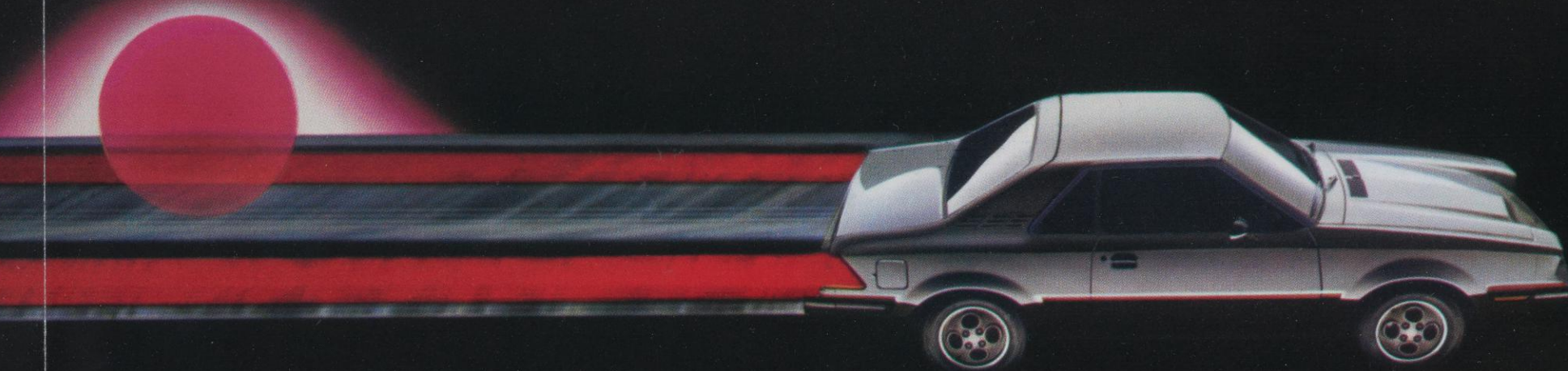

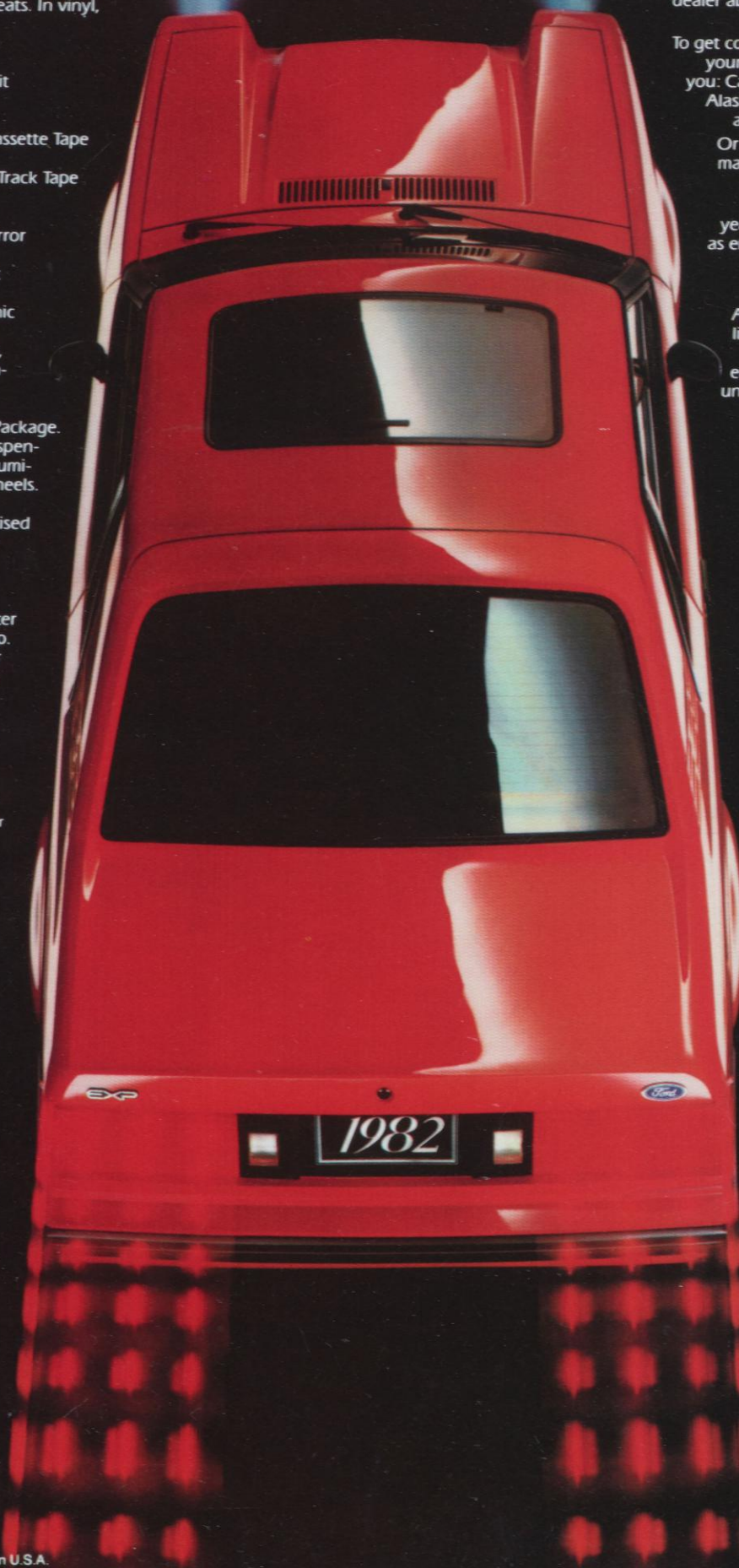

Technical Service Bulletins

All vehicles need repairs during their lifetime.
