



Ranger's standard 2.0L and optional 2.3L overhead-cam 4-cylinder engines offer a choice of economical power. Both feature solid-state DuraSpark ignition and include a new intake manifold, revised camshaft and a one-barrel carburetor to provide improved low-end torque. An energy-saving viscous clutch fan is also standard. Thermostatically controlled, it operates only when needed for engine cooling.
