And if you do spy that chest of drawers that's just right for the house, the rear seats disappear flat into the floor. So you can carry whatever you want, whenever you want, easily.





?How can we make driving easier

By designing the dashboard around you, our designers have ensured that everything falls easily to hand. We've located the gear stick in the dashboard, so it's easier to reach when you want it and by creating a flat floor, gives you more space for those times when you don't. The tilt and telescopic steering wheel and fully adjustable driver's seat make driving more comfortable, for everybody.

Whilst the steering wheel mounted radio and cruise controls and illuminated dials make journeys safer. Even the controls for the all-round electric windows have been re-located to the right of the steering wheel so they're just that bit easier to use. The CD player and climate-controlled air conditioning are both integrated into the dashboard. Very cool.

The FR-V is designed to give you options. With i-VTEC technology, your engine becomes just as versatile. You'd think even we'd be happy with a VTEC system that has a 100% reliability record after 13 million units. But then we asked, 'what if we made it more intelligent?'

And so we created i-VTEC. It's an improved system that adapts instantly to minute changes in speed and load to give you better handling and more responsive acceleration. We also made it smoother, quieter, more economical and cut the emissions too. Choose either 1.7 litre fuel injected VTEC, 2.0 litre fuel injected i-VTEC or the soon to be released 2.2 i-CTDi Honda diesel engine and you'll be enjoying running around town as much as you will getting away from it.



?Does anyone care as much about safety as you do

We'd like to think we do. Inside you'll find dual front airbags, side airbags for the front seats and full-length curtain airbags. With three point seatbelts on all six seats everyone travels in safety.

There are big features to protect the smallest people. ISOFix mounting points for child seats are integrated into the FR-V, one each on the front centre seat and on both rear outer seats.

But even before you get inside the FR-V you'll discover that it's not just the occupants we care about, it's pedestrians as well. So the FR-V is designed to reduce the risk of head, leg and knee injuries to those outside the car.

In fact we care so much about safety we've build the largest crash test centre in the world to evaluate the car from all angles, because anything can happen in real life.
