





The F-Series offers 4-wheel drive (4x4) on F-150/250HD/350 Regular Cab, F-150/250HD SuperCab and F-350 Crew Cab.

Automatic locking hubs are standard. Electric 4x4 Touch Drive and manual locking hubs are optional.

Electric Touch Drive is a Ford exclusive. The F-150 4x4 is the only full-size pickup on the market offering it.

Locking the automatic hubs is simple. Merely

stop the vehicle and shift into 4-wheel drive high. The hubs are automatically locked as soon as the truck is driven.

An easy quarter turn of each front hub selector knob is all that's required to lock the hubs into 4-wheel drive on the manual system.

Once the hubs are engaged, all three systems allow you to shift "on the fly" from 2-wheel drive to 4-wheel drive high and back again at normal road speeds.
