

But while the GLC's spacious


interior is impressive, its trunk room is positively amazing. With a height of almost two feet from floor to lid, the trunk can hold four or five large suitcases standing on end and

A small lever located below the latch of each rear door can be depressed to deactivate the inner door handle. Even when the inside lock button is raised, the door can only be opened from the outside. Lift up on the lever, and the inner handle operates normally.

Practical, but sporty too.

For all its practicality, the most endearing trait of this GLC is the way it handles, responds, and moves with astonishing poise and sports-car precision. And with its tight 30.2-foot turning radius, it's so nimble

that it almost seems as much sports car as sedan—and the best of both worlds. Better still, the GLC Deluxe Sedan has a modest price that makes it very easy to own both worlds.

Aligned with your spine, the pedals allow body position and driving movements to be natural and unrestricted.

Anatomically contoured seats.



an amazing 27.7 cubic feet of accommodating cargo space.

Automatic option available.

If you prefer the ease of no-shift driving, you can also select a three-speed fully automatic transmission with a convenient on-the-floor console shifter. Combined with its fuel-efficient engine, this transmission produces mileage estimates that are equal or superior to most similarly equipped economy cars: 31 est. hwy mpg, 28 est. city mpg. 


