





And if you want to enjoy your growing collection of CDs on the road, you can add the accessory compact disc player. It's a full-featured unit that perfectly integrates with the stereo system.



A A wraparound control panel lends an aircraft-cockpit ambiance to the interior, enhancing your sense of control. It's easy to settle in, with amenities that include a tilt steering column to help you find just the right driving position. The steering wheel is thickly padded with contour grips and also holds the cruise control buttons for extra convenience. With the LS Equipment Group, the steering wheel and transmission shift knob are leather-wrapped for an even more luxurious feel.

Y A center console provides covered storage for your tapes or other small objects, plus a cup holder. There's also a lockable and illuminated glove box, and a convenient map pocket in the driver's door.

And our thorough attention to ergonomics makes the Mazda MX-6 an intuitively easy car to drive, as a spirited sports coupe should be.

Before you, as you settle in, the instrument panel flows in an unbroken sweep, creating a sense of anticipation. The analog gauges are clear, concise, and instantly readable. Controls are perfectly integrated into the design, yet readily identifiable and accessible for easy operation.

Beneath you, the sport seats, upholstered in cloth or the optional leather trim,* provide just the right balance of luxurious comfort and firm support. And around you, expansive glass, narrow pillars, and a low hood give you excellent visibility in all directions. So that once out on the road, you'll feel secure, confident, and completely in control.

Which is exactly how you want a worldclass sports coupe to make you feel. V The optional power sunroof lets you take full advantage of nice days. We designed it so that it won't cut into your headroom, and it also tilts up for extra ventilation.



A The MX-6 has a practical side in addition to its fun factor. A large and roomy trunk holds plenty of luggage, so it's no problem taking along everything you need for an extended getaway. The low lift-over helps make loading easy.

V The interior design offers comfort and convenience. The driver and front passenger have plenty of legroom and more headroom than you might expect in a sports coupe. And when you need to carry extralong cargo, the 60/40 split fold-down rear seatback makes it a lot easier. Cloth upholstery is standard (LS Equipment Group shown), or you can choose the optional Leather Package that includes sport seats with rich leather seating surfaces* and a power driver's seat.

iving a sports coupe raw acceleration isn't that difficult. But add the requirement that the power be smooth, quiet, and flexible, and the difficulty level increases. Then work towards the simultaneous goals of outstanding fuel economy and lower emissions, and you have a real engineering challenge.

But not an impossible one. With the considerable help of advanced supercomputer techniques like Finite

Element Analysis, Mazda engineers developed two engines for the MX-6, a V6, and a 4-cylinder. Both have special block designs to make them stronger and more rigid than conventional engines, to reduce noise and vibration. Both have electronic fuel injection, dual overhead cams and four valves per cylinder.


And both of them provide emphatic and positive answers to the engineering challenges. You can have a car that's quick and exciting, yet refined and responsible. The Mazda MX-6 sports coupe.

Environmental concerns ranked high in the design of the MX-6. We've eliminated asbestos from the brake pads and gaskets, labeled numerous plastic parts for recycling, and used a CFC-free air conditioner. And our engines are designed for clean and efficient operation.

V The graceful lines of the MX-6 are not just for style—they offer performance benefits too. By helping the car achieve a drag coefficient of just 0.31, considerably lower than found on many exotic sports cars, they contribute to increased fuel efficiency.



A Reduced wind noise is another benefit of the exterior design. And that's just part of an overall emphasis on noise and vibration reduction. Supercomputer analysis helps us pinpoint and eliminate noise sources, and our test drivers and passengers tell us when we've got it right.





A Standard in the MX-6, a 16-valve DOHC 4-cylinder engine delivers 118 hp at 5500 rpm and 127 lb-ft of torque at 4500 rpm. Thanks to computeraided design, this responsive engine offers smooth performance with plenty of pep. (Horsepower and torque slightly lower in CA/NY.)

A The V6 of the LS Equipment Group produces 164 hp at 5600 rpm, and 160 lb-ft of torque at 4800 rpm. It features a unique 2-piece engine block that contributes to unusually smooth operation. A 4-stage Variable Resonance Induction System (VRIS) helps give it smooth, even torque throughout a broad power band. Multi-port fuel injection improves throttle response. And an integrated electronic engine management system carefully coordinates all functions. (Horsepower and torque slightly lower in CA/NY.)







A Kansei Engineering in action: Our unique Global Road Circuit duplicates road surfaces from around the world. We not only monitor every conceivable performance aspect, we record—and act on—the subjective opinions of our drivers.

➤ A 5-speed manual transmission is standard and a 4-speed

automatic is optional. Both have been computer-developed, with gear ratios matched to the performance characteristics of each engine for the smoothest possible operation.



✓ Sporty alloy wheels and P205/55R15 low-profile, allseason radial tires, included in the LS Equipment Group, effectively transfer the power to the road. They provide outstanding traction and contribute to the car's precise handling and superb braking abilities.









A The MX-6, along with the Mazda 626 sedan, is manufactured in the U.S., with over 75 percent domestic content. Both cars are officially certified as domestic models, making Mazda the first foreign-based manufacturer to build a domestic fleet. The modern production facility is located in Flat Rock, Michigan, and uses the latest production techniques plus strict quality control standards. This helps ensure that the Mazda MX-6 is every bit as good a car as its looks promise.



A An optional anti-theft alarm system helps protect your car from intruders. It will flash the lights, sound the horn, and disable the ignition system on any attempt at forced entry.



≺ An Anti-lock Brake System (ABS; optional) can help you keep control in hard stops and on slippery surfaces. A locked tire has less traction than a rolling one; with ABS, a sensor at each wheel can sense a sudden change in wheel speed that could lead to lockup. The system then automatically modulates braking pressure, no matter how hard you're pressing the pedal. So your stops will be straighter, and you can more easily maintain steering control.






So we gave the MX-6 an advanced suspension design that lets you own the twisty sections of your favorite roads. We gave it a structure that's strong and rigid, to supplement the suspension's performance and also reduce interior noise and vibration. And we gave it something else—a strong emphasis on occupant safety.

There's active safety, like the powerful engine and nimble handling that can help you avoid obstacles. And passive safety, like standard dual air bags and "crumple zones" that absorb the force of an impact, to help protect you if something does happen.

Because when you have more confidence, you're sure to have more fun.



✓ In addition to 3-point safety belts for all four occupants, the MX-6
has a standard air bag Supplemental Restraint System (SRS) for both
the driver and front passenger. Sensors detect severe frontal impacts

A Suspension design always presents engineering challenges. Among them: The forces generated by acceleration, cornering, and braking tend to cause the rear tires to lose optimum alignment with the road surface at the very moment it's needed most. The Mazda solution: our patented Twin Trapezoidal Link (TTL) rear suspension. TTL controls the forces so that the rear wheels come to the optimum alignment. So the MX-6 is more agile in the corners, more stable in straight-line acceleration or braking.

Solution A high level of body rigidity helps the suspension perform as intended. The MX-6 structure has been computer-designed and tested over thousands of miles. This increased rigidity also makes the MX-6 more resistant to vibration and further reduces the level of interior noise. The computer also helped us build in the energy-absorbing crumple zones that help protect the occupants.


