


Legendary Ride

Contributing to Grand Marquis' smooth, controlled ride are gas-pressurized shocks, stabilizer bars, body-on-frame construction and an improved power steering system—all standard. If you often drive with heavier loads due to extra people and luggage, you might want to consider the optional Handling Package with a rear air-suspension system. It automatically adjusts ride height while maintaining ride comfort.

Generous Trunk


Grand Marquis' generous trunk measures a cavernous 20.6 cubic feet, making it one of the largest trunks in its class. You'll notice that items like luggage, golf clubs and children's toys can be easily stored inside—all at once. Plus, the trunk's low liftover height makes it easy to load and unload.





Controlled Stops and Starts

To help you maintain steering control during hard braking, even when road conditions are less than ideal, Grand Marquis is available with a four-wheel anti-lock brake system. This system also includes electronic Traction Assist, which helps keep the drive wheels from spinning during low-speed acceleration on slippery roads.



Grand Marquis Safety

Grand Marquis offers outstanding standard safety features. For your peace of mind there are child-proof rear door locks and a dual air bag supplemental restraint system. Always wear your safety belt. Front and rear crumple zones and heavy-gauge steel side door beams help protect you and your passengers. There's even a brake-activated transmission lock. It prevents the transmission from shifting out of "Park" unless your foot is on the brake pedal.

Every 1997 Mercury is covered by the Mercury Commitment—an owner benefits program that helps to ensure your driving needs always receive immediate attention.
