The Rover 45 has a long wheelbase for its class with double wishbone suspension at the front and a multi-link layout for the rear. Add a new lower stance, and you have control, comfort, stability, and a safety underfoot supported by four air bags and side impact bars. So that said, relax. Mould yourself into the precision-made upholstery of the driver's seat with height adjustment and lumbar support. Enjoy the ample space, the optional leather and the state-of-the-art technological options of the GPS navigation system.
