

# Rough it in comfort

Get behind the wheel of the Kia Sorento and discover how to manoeuvre through obstacles, steep terrain and slippery roads. With the space to carry sports equipment including mountain bikes, you can explore new heights and quench your thirst for adventure.

No matter what the conditions are outside, inside Sorento you and your passengers will enjoy serene air-conditioned surroundings. There's room to stretch out in the front and rear, and everyone will appreciate the surround-sound experience from the CD/MP3 digital audio system with six powerful speakers. Multiple storage spaces and cup holders throughout mean there'll be plenty of thrills but no spills on your adventure. As well as family and friends, there's room for everything you want to take with you in the 897 litre luggage area. Lower the 60:40 splitfolding rear seats and expand it to an amazing 1,960 litres.

Typically clever Kia thinking is evident in the form of a concealed under-floor compartment in the rear, remote central locking, a two-piece tailgate and multiple 12-volt power outlets - including one in the luggage compartment.

# New equ is is wide and fi

New Sorento offers three levels of equipment specification, and there is a choice of two advanced new engines for each.

3.3 litre V6: The petrol-powered allalloy 3.3 litre V6 uses Continuously Variable Valve Timing (CVVT) and 24 valves to produce an impressive 180kW of power, with improved fuel consumption and reduced emissions compared with previous petrol units. Maximum torque of 309Nm is reached at an accessible 4,500rpm, and the torque curve is wide and flat for relaxed, instant flexibility in all conditions. A smooth 5-speed Tiptronicstyle automatic transmission is standard, coupled with a high & low range transfer case for the right ratio in any situation.

# The driving force

2.5 litre CRDi: The all-new Common Rail Direct injection motor represents the state-of-theart in modern turbo-diesels. Its four cylinders are force-fed directly via a Variable Geometry Turbocharger (VGT) system coupled with an intercooler and 16 valves for supreme performance on the driver's demand. Maximum power of 125kW is complemented by prodigious torque output of 392Nm at just 2,000rpm, all achieved with Euro IV clean emissions compliance and frugal fuel consumption.

Sorento LX CRDi is fitted with a standard 5-speed manual transmission, with the 5-speed Tiptronic-style automatic available as an option. The automatic is standard on CRDi versions of Sorento EX and EX Limited. In all cases, torque is fed through the dual range transfer case as required.

#### ▲ 3.3 V6 gasoline engine

The improved 3.3-litre V6 is an advanced aluminium block engine that features improved fuel efficiency and higher performance at low and mid speeds.

For your offroad excursions the Sorento offers remarkable ground clearance. The 28.4 degree approach angle prevents the front end from hitting the ground on rough or steep terrain, and the 25.8 degree departure angle minimises rear scraping on descent.



Few places are inaccessible to the new Sorento. A simple dial on the dash gives you an array of transmission choices to conquer almost anything you come up against. In normal conditions, you'll select two-wheel drive via the rear wheels to maximise economy. When the going gets rougher or when you simply want the security of drive to all four wheels - turn the dial to either 4WD high-range, or 4WD low-range for the ability to 'crawl' with care. Rocky hillsides, rain-soaked dirt tracks or vast golden beaches - Sorento handles them all.

# Find your freedom

The two engines in the Sorento range are more than a match for any conditions you might encounter when roaming on or off road. With huge reserves of torque on tap at almost any engine speed, you can pull a massive 2,800kg with ease - that's more than enough towing ability for a ski or fishing boat and easily the best in the class\*. The standard limited slip differential on LX models and Traction Control on EX and EX Limited ensure that all this pulling power gets to the ground without drama, whether it's on a slippery launching ramp or a muddy trail.









#### Globe trotting on all fours

Rid yourself of your suit and tie and explore the wilderness. The Sorento is a TRUE off-roader at heart. Change into the 4X4 mode on the fly. Christer Gerlach, the record-breaking Swedish driver and adventurer, successfully completed a solo 27,000 km around-the-world expedition trouble free in a stock Sorento.




# Engineered for strength and safety

When you have a car with power and performance you'll want to stick to the road like glue. Kia offers the technology that will give you complete confidence on the road, and ensure you'll see and be seen.

The Kia Sorento was designed from the ground up for strength and durability. The starting point is a separate ladder-frame chassis, which provides its considerable backbone for towing and flex-free off-road performance. Above this sits a body incorporating a rigid passenger safety cell and deformable crumple zones. Prior to the multiple paint layers, the whole chassis/body structure – which utilises galvanised steel in vulnerable areas – is carefully prepared and primed to fend off corrosion. After painting, body cavities are treated to resist moisture and the entire underbody is sealed to prevent damage and to enhance ride quietness.

Sorento's inherent structural integrity is complemented by ABS anti-lock brakes to help maintain total steering control during an emergency stop. EX and EX Limited models feature the advanced safety technology of Electronic Stability Program (ESP), which senses when the vehicle is on a trajectory not intended by the driver and then automatically – and instantly uses the brakes and throttle to bring it back onto the correct path. The front seatbelts in all versions are fitted with pre-tensioners, which tighten the belts around the wearers in the event of a collision milliseconds before the dual front SRS airbags deploy.



All models benefit from active headrests on the front seats, which move forwards to cradle the head in a rear impact and thus help to avoid whiplash injuries; and the rear seat central passenger has the advantage of a lap-sash 3-point seatbelt for optimal restraint.

Whether you're negotiating mountain trails or dropping your children off at school you'll appreciate the confidence that new Sorento's safety features inspire.



#### ▼ Active headrest

The active headrests help to reduce neck and spinal injuries from the forces of a collision. By moving forwards and up within milliseconds of the moment of impact, the exact response will cushion the head and can prevent whiplash, one of the biggest injury risks.



#### ◀ Ventilated front disc brakes

Sorento is equipped with ventilated front disc brakes which help to dissipate heat and improve the reliability of the car's stopping ability, in addition to its ABS and EBD capabilities.



#### **▶** Suspension

A smooth ride and durability is achieved through independent double wishbone front suspension and five-link rear suspension with stabilizer bars.




#### ▲ Dual front, curtain airbags

The airbags inside the Sorento have been designed and uprated to provide maximum protection to all occupants, both in the front and rear. The dual front airbags activate during a collision to protect the front passengers, and the full-length curtain airbags add protection to both seat rows\*.

\* Curtain airbags are standard on EX-L versions.





# From A to Z in detail



**Dual separate climate control:** Fully automatic temperature controlled air conditioning will ensure you're perfectly comfortable inside the cabin whatever the weather outside. Set the controls to your preferred temperature and the cabin climate will adjust automatically (EX-L only).



**Power & tilt steering wheel:** The power steering function of the Sorento's steering wheel aids easier handling, and the tilt steering function that adjusts vertically creates a more convenient driving position.



Power sunroof: Sorento has a light and airy cabin, but with the power tilt and slide sunroof option you can enjoy more light and fresh air. For safety the sliding sunroof will automatically retract when it hits an obstruction, and the manual shade is ideal when the sun is directly overhead (EX-L only).



Power window console: From the driving seat you can open and close all four windows as well as making adjustments to the wing mirrors at the touch of a button, all from the convenience of the door-located arm rest.



**Supervision cluster gauge:** Hi-tech design offers sharpened visibility with less strain on the eyes. A trip computer conveniently built into the cluster gauge provides accurate digital information to better plan and record your trips.



Rheostat: It's important that you can clearly see the instrument panel, and the handy dash-mounted rheostat enables you to adjust the illumination when the headlamps are activated, to suit night or low-light driving conditions.

#### Remote keyless entry system

It's simple... lock, unlock and open your boot as you approach your Sorento with the remote keyless entry fob.



Illuminated keyhole: Kia takes care of the simple practicalities that a driver will easily take for granted. This includes the keyhole, which is illuminated in a subtle light to make it easier to insert your key, especially when it is dark.



Auto cruise control: Auto cruise control is a welcome convenience on those long, cross-country drives. A click of the steering-column mounted button activates cruise control to maintain a constant speed on the road, which is disengaged safely when you put pressure on the brake (EX and EX-L only).



**4WD mode switch:** Sorento puts you in control of the manual 4WD system, which gives the vehicle maximum grip and reassurance over loose ground, wet and snow. In 2WD as standard you can select the shift control and turn to 4WD supported by an electric shift transfer.



**Door courtesy lamp:** The door-mounted courtesy lamps are activated when either of the front doors are opened, providing ample light for driver and passenger to safely and comfortably enter or exit their Sorento.



**High mounted stoplamp:** Ensure you're seen by other road users with the high mounted stop lamp. Located behind the rear windscreen, it ensures that your brake lights aren't hindered by road spray or mud and combine for better safety with standard brake lights.



**Power window:** The power windows are a convenient feature enabling you to smoothly open, close and adjust the windows for ventilation. The controls are mounted on the driver and passenger side door armrests.



Sunglasses storage: Mounted at arm's length in the roofspace above the windscreen is a convenient covered compartment to store sunglasses safely, alongside the lighting control for the dual map lights. With a light push, the compartment opens, and clicks shut just as simply.



**Dual front cupholder:** Sorento provides two handy cup holders in front of the handbrake between the front seats for placing soft drinks close at hand and minimising the risk of sticky spills.



Centre armrest with bi-level storage bins: The centre console is a valuable storage area, with twin layers. The armrest opens to reveal the power outlet and storage area, but beneath is a deep pocket that's ideal for storing and retaining loose items.



**Lockable glove box:** The glove box is a sensible storage area with a sizeable compartment for storing documents and other items. It folds down neatly from the dash and it is lockable for optimum security.



Central storage tray: The dash-mounted console houses much more than the sound system and ventilation controls. It features a convenient drawer-type storage tray that is ideal for storing small items or things you want to keep close at hand.



**Backrest pocket:** Every effort has been made to generate practical storage, and the rear of the front seats is no exception. Each has a handy pocket that is perfect for storing maps and documents neatly and securely.



Luggage net: The rear luggage area has a capacious amount of space for storing luggage and other items. But where these are moveable the luggage net provides a safe and secure way to restrain them from moving around the floor and causing damage.



Flip-up tailgate glass: Sorento has a fantastic timesaving device at the rear. Rather than opening the full tailgate you can open just the top flip-up glass door, and stow or access smaller items in just a few seconds.

Fitted with an all-disc Anti-lock Braking System (ABS) with Electronic Brakeforce Distribution (EBD), the Kia Sorento now provides even better braking performance with Electronic Stability Program (ESP), fitted to EX and EX-L versions.

#### PERFORMANCE

Customers can choose from a 2.5-litre CRDi diesel engine with Variable Geometric Turbocharger (VGT) or a 3.3-litre V6 gasoline engine. A 5-speed manual gearbox now offers even better performance for the diesel engine, while the 5-speed sports mode automatic transmissions are an option on the LX diesel and standard for all other variants. The Sorento's engines are designed to deliver a quieter and smoother driving experience.


**REFINEMENT** Four nitrogen gas-filled shock absorbers are standard for both the front and the rear suspension system. A double wishbone suspension up front and a 5-link setup in the rear maintain a level, stable ride through tight corners and on off-road excursions.






