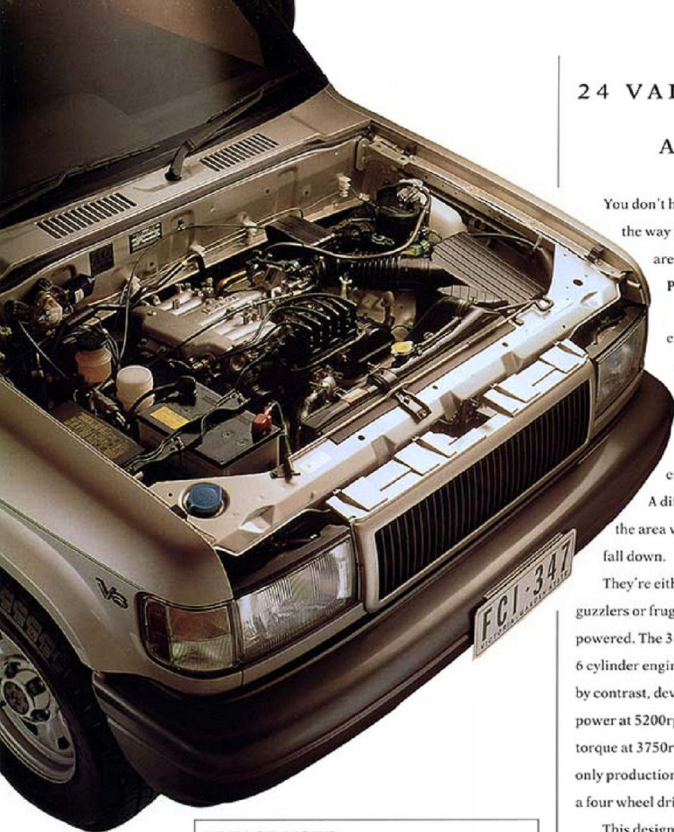
Inside, it boasts cavernous dimensions with seating for seven*, a commanding driving position and a prestigious level of comfort features. Yet it's devoid of the usual exterior mammoth proportions of other 4WD wagons.

Once on the road, you'll discover unparalleled ride and handling thanks to its unique 4 link rear coil suspension. Meticulously adapted for Australia's diverse road conditions after more than 18 months of gruelling testing.

All in all, it's a remarkably quiet, graceful and intelligent design that's bound to have you rethinking the whole notion of a 4x4.

JACKAROO'S RESPONSIVE 24 VALVE, MULTIPOINT FUEL INJECTED, 3.2 LITRE V6 ENGINE. A NEW DIMENSION IN POWER.

You don't have to look far to see that V6 is the way most leading manufacturers are going. Honda, Audi, Saab and Peugeot. And for good reason too. Superior performance, efficiency and durability. The Jackaroo's V6 is the new breed of technology which offers you the perfect combination of responsiveness, power, low emissions and fuel efficiency.

A difficult balance to achieve and the area where most other 4WDs fall down.

They're either powerful fuel guzzlers or frugal and under-powered. The 3.2 litre 24 valve 6 cylinder engine in the Jackaroo, by contrast, develops 130kW of power at 5200rpm, 260Nm of torque at 3750rpm and is the only production 75 degree V6 in a four wheel drive.

This design allows the engine to fit snugly between the suspension towers, optimising weight distribution, an important consideration in four wheel drive operation.

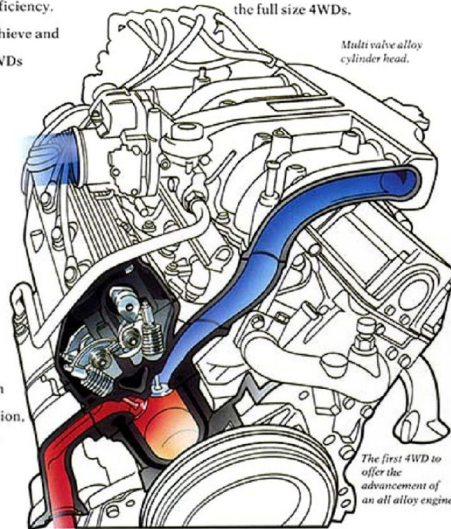
State-of-the-art design is also

evident in the aluminium alloy block and single overhead camshaft per bank of cylinders.

The sophistication of the design is such that the reciprocating mass (pistons, conrods, etc) is so light that the normal means of balancing the engine, through contra-rotating balance shafts, is unnecessary.

But what makes this engine's job somewhat easier is the Jackaroo's excellent power to weight ratio. In fact, it's one of the best amongst

the full size 4WDs.

HIGHLY ADVANCED SOHC 24 VALVE SYSTEM.

The benefit of Jackaroo's multi valve all alloy engine is that each cylinder has four valves instead of the more common two. This gives each cylinder the advantage of two inlet valves and two exhaust valves.

As a result the engine simply breathes easier, which accounts for its exceptional efficiency and responsiveness.

Around town, or on a freeway, the Jackaroo engine delivers superb all round performance for a relaxed, easy drive. But it's also a quiet unit, almost imperceptible at idle, spinning smoothly like a turbine to 6750rpm.

This highly advanced engine also incorporates compact hydraulic valve activators with the overhead camshaft design.

Their presence obviates the need for manual adjustment and reduces long term

servicing costs. They also contribute to the low noise and vibration levels of this engine.

Testament to the quality engineering of this engine is the vehicle's scheduled first service at 5000km, compared to the more common 1000 or 1500km.

A 3.1 LITRE TURBO CHARGED ENGINE WITH INTERCOOLER.

For applications requiring diesel power, the Jackaroo 4 cylinder 3.1 litre engine is designed to be an economical, powerful, reliable and durable unit.

It offers impressive power and torque figures with 84kW of power at 3600rpm and 260Nm of torque at 2000rpm. A turbocharger provides that extra dimension of responsiveness at the higher end of the rev band.

While the intercooler ensures air is kept at the best possible temperature for maximum

combustibility, further improving performance and fuel efficiency. An obvious advantage in Australia.

Recently, the diesel engine proved its toughness, powering a LWB vehicle which recorded an impressive 3rd in the 1993 Australian Safari.

Built with Isuzu's truck engineering expertise, the 3.1 litre diesel is a direct development of the well proven 2.8 litre turbo diesel found in the 4x4 Holden Rodeo one tonne pickup.

This indirect injection engine is a quiet unit, more suited to passenger use. And like the 3.2 litre petrol engine, its emission levels place it well within foreseeable future regulations.

THE CHOICE OF MANUAL OR AUTOMATIC TRANSMISSIONS.

The five speed manual transmission delivers smooth, effortless shifting.

Importantly, it's a short throw type unlike some more unwieldy 4WDs.

Its effortless action is due to a three cone type synchro on first and second with synchro-mesh on reverse. The clutch itself is light, thus helping reduce fatigue on long trips.

The automatic transmission makes the Jackaroo even more of a pleasure to drive in town. It's a four speed Turbo Hydramatic unit with torque converter lock-up clutch on third and overdrive.

It also features power, economy and winter modes for varying weather and road conditions.

ALL THE COMFORT, STYLING AND ERGONOMICS TO MAKE YOU FEEL AT HOME, WHEREVER YOU GO.

Within the Jackaroo are a wealth of well thought out comfort features and brilliant ergonomics.

Sit back in the plush velour fabric trimmed, body contoured captain's seat on SE and XS models and enjoy the distinct European styling which pervades the interior. But with the mark of Japanese superlative quality, fit and finish.

The commanding driving position instantly engenders confidence. Thanks to a mixture of seat height, a raked windscreen and sloping bonnet.

Close the door and experience the superb solid feel and quality sound.

Cut pile carpet, velour headlining, heavily padded headrests, central locking, power windows, noise deadening insulation and the velour door inserts on SE and XS models combine to create an aura of distinction.

CONTROL AT YOUR FINGERTIPS.

As you grip the soft feel steering wheel with its 'sports' diameter and three spokes, you'll notice an array of features all in close proximity.

Power steering is standard, as is the tilt adjustable steering column, which allows the perfect driving position for a variety of different sized drivers.

XS and SE models also feature a driver's seat height adjuster.

Left and right hand oversize mirrors also provide excellent rear and side visibility.

A six speaker AM/FM stereo cassette player with quartz digital display is standard on LWB models. A system designed acoustically to reach all passengers.

Directly above are dual cabin overhead lights on SE and XS models for both the driver and front passenger, making map reading easy at night. While courtesy lamps can be found dotted throughout.

Instrumentation consists of a speedometer and tachometer as well as an oil pressure gauge, battery charge indicator, temperature gauge, fuel gauge and a matrix of warning lights, all detailing critical information for on and off road.

The dashboard is backlit with a dimmer for glare-free night driving. In between the two front seats is a convenient storage console.

The windscreen is laminated for extra protection and affords excellent visibility.

While the external mirrors are electrically heated to keep them free of moisture, and fold inwards at the flick of a switch should you need extra room either side (SE and XS models only).

Also within your reach is a remote fuel filler door release and rear window demister control.

As well as 4-speed fan boosted heating and ventilation network with five face level vents.



The Jackaroo offers superior visibility over normal passenger vehicles, which translates into extra reaction time for avoiding potential dangers. Not to mention being in a better position to spot a car parking space. Jackaroo XS featured (pictured with optional alloy wheels fitted).

THE RIGHT DIMENSIONS INSIDE AND OUT.

A major design objective of the Jackaroo was to create a new dimension in space. Outside and inside.

The result externally is evidenced by its sophisticated aerodynamic looks, modest waist and distinctively sleek, carlike lines. A truly efficient use of space.

Inside, the same principle has created a voluminous, intelligent domain. With superior head, shoulder and leg room.

But importantly this balance, 'right size', and overall dimensions have been achieved with infinitely more than comfort, aesthetics or ergonomics, in mind. It is an integral part of the Jackaroo's stability, handling, ride, power to weight ratio and thus, ultimately, performance.

On and off road, it's a size people feel more at home in and get more out of.

THE SMART OVERALL SIZE.

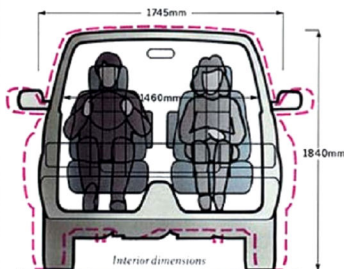
Much of the Jackaroo's internal superiority can be traced to the long wheelbase, which is longer than Pajero.



Underneath the rear seat is a unique secret storage compartment for valuables. (LWB models only.)

But consistent with its efficient design it is considerably shorter in overall length than all the other big 4WDs, resulting in excellent manoeuvrability. While shorter front and rear overhangs enhance the Jackaroo's approach and departure angles.

Yet inside, the relatively narrow width delivers the first of several superior interior dimensions.



While the interior width is only around 50mm short of Landcruiser, the Jackaroo is 155mm narrower in overall width as is clearly shown by the illustrated outline of Landcruiser. (GLX LWB Series 80 model.)

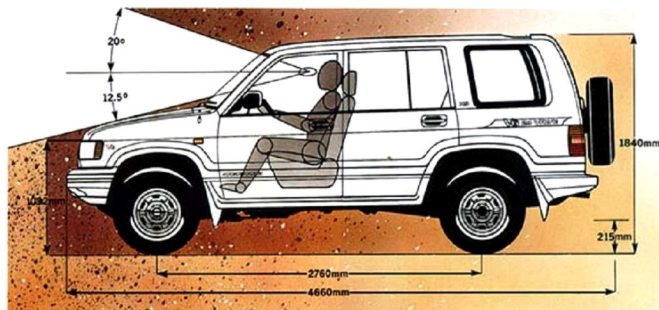
NO MORE IMPINGING ON PERSONAL SPACE.

When you're trying to explore our great open spaces, the last thing you want to discover is constricted space.

In contrast to its efficient external dimensions, the Jackaroo offers better shoulder room than Pajero, with realistic room for three adults in the back seat.

Excellent seat depth and Jackaroo's wheelbase length have created the best rear leg room of any Japanese 4WD including Toyota's Landcruiser.

Front leg room and cavity space for the driver also compare favourably with the competition. Which can make all the difference on long trips, or even running around town.

Head room and shoulder room are also better than Patrol or Pajero.

A definite plus when straddling rough terrain or simply transporting towering teenagers.

The rear cargo area in the Jackaroo is also a tangible example of a design that makes sense.

The 60/40 split rear seat creates a range of seating and storage configurations (SE and XS models only).

Unlike other more complicated designs, it folds forward with a spring mechanism in a single easy movement.

In terms of height, the Jackaroo has a ground clearance high enough to easily glide

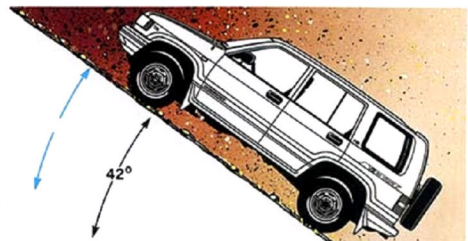
over the most rugged terrain. But low enough so that loading and unloading is minus the usual back-snapping lean.

While a rear bumper step makes packing and unpacking equally effortless.

To ensure luggage safety inside the rear cargo area, tie down hooks have also been fitted to protect people and valuable weighty items.



Its intelligent dimensions are best exemplified by its impressive long wheelbase yet relatively short overall length, accounting for the Jackaroo's excellent manoeuvrability. The Jackaroo's approach angle is a stunning 40 degrees with a departure angle of 31 degrees due to its efficient dimensions. The ramp over angle is 21 degrees for the LWB and 24 degrees for the SWB model.



While gradeability is 42 degrees for both models.

70/30 rear doors open to the left unlike all other 4WDs. So you're not opening a heavy door onto a road when parked. And with Australia's road crown it makes it even less of an effort. The rear door also has a lock to ensure it won't slam shut unexpectedly.



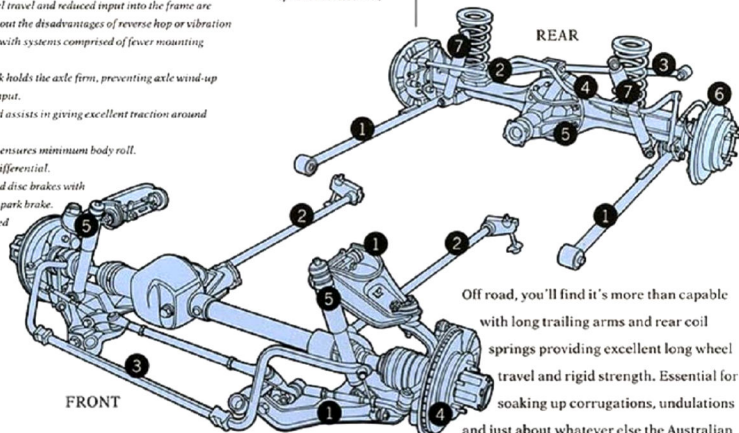

The Jackaroo LWB has a towing capacity of 2250kg, both on and off road. (Featured is the S LWB diesel model.) With their exceptional torque and excellent traction, diesel 4WDs are traditionally popular for towing. (Towbar, bullbar, side step and weathershield are optional accessories.)



A 4WD BUILT FOR WHATEVER TRACK, ROAD, FREEWAY OR HIGHWAY YOU'RE HEADING DOWN.

It's a delicate balance to create a 4WD which rides and handles beautifully on and off road.

But this is precisely what the new Jackaroo achieves with its innovative 4 link rear coil suspension and independent front suspension with adjustable torsion bar springs, stabiliser bar and gas pressurised shock absorbers.

On bitumen, Jackaroo sets a new standard of ride and handling and has been acclaimed for its superb comfortable ride, responsive handling and effortless cruising.

While 4 wheel disc brakes ensure the Jackaroo also has superior stopping power.

Off road, you'll find it's more than capable with long trailing arms and rear coil springs providing excellent long wheel travel and rigid strength. Essential for soaking up corrugations, undulations and just about whatever else the Australian

landscape can dish out. In fact, the Jackaroo underwent 18 months of rigorous testing to ensure it was right for Australia's diverse and unique conditions.

And part of its testing since 1991 has been its participation in the Australian Safari, a gruelling event run over some 6000kms.



Each year it has come through with flying colours and in 1993, Jackaroo entries achieved three class wins, and the two Isuzu factory entries finished with an impressive second and third outright. A great result indeed.

When it comes to towing, Jackaroo's longer wheelbase (2760mm) and wider track (1455mm front, 1460mm rear) combine to provide a stable and stress free performance.

While its towing capacity of 2250kg (LWB) enables the Jackaroo to handle a double horse float.*

*Subject to State regulations.

THE ISUZU CREDENTIALS.

But Jackaroo's amazing off road ability and ruggedness are hardly surprising when you consider its Isuzu heritage. The Jackaroo is manufactured in Japan by Isuzu Motors Ltd.

An affiliate of the GM Corporation. And for over 50 years. Isuzu has been at the forefront of truck technology and particularly diesel engine design and manufacturing.

In Australia, Isuzu has earned an enviable reputation for reliability and durability. In fact, you don't have to look far to see an Isuzu truck on the road. Since 1989, Isuzu and General Motors Corporation have been operating a joint venture company for rebadging Holden Light Commercial vehicles.

And like all Isuzu vehicles, the Jackaroo boasts a high standard of design excellence.

The shape of the Jackaroo is the result of



combining functionality, dimensions and ultimately, aerodynamics.

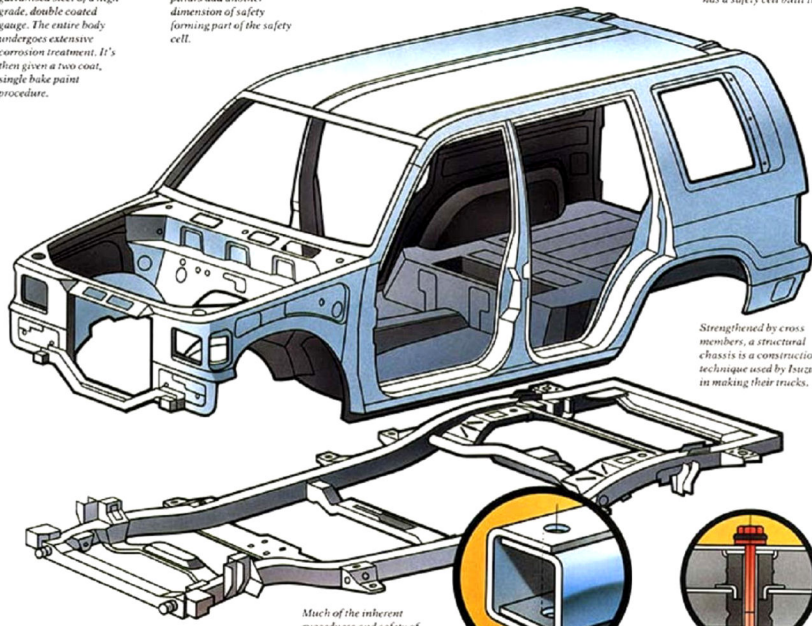
Cruise along a freeway and you'll discover its uncanny quietness.

Low profile tyres, slippery shape, flush door seals and uniquely slim waistline all contribute to achieve remarkably low interior noise.

None of which is surprising when you consider it has been driven over 80,000km on German autobahns in its testing phase.

All body panels are galvanised steel of a high grade, double coated gauge. The entire body undergoes extensive corrosion treatment. It's then given a two coat, single bake paint procedure.

Totally enclosed section pillars add another dimension of safety forming part of the safety cell.



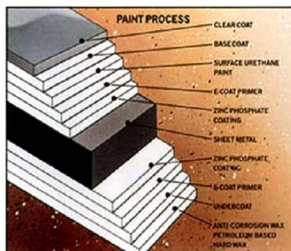
The Jackaroo body shell has a safety cell built in.

Strengthened by cross members, a structural chassis is a construction technique used by Isuzu in making their trucks.

Much of the inherent ruggedness and safety of the Jackaroo is attributable to its rigid box section steel chassis.

Everything from the rigidity of the frame to the body mounts have been designed and tested on Australian corrugated roads and trucks.

Thick rubber dampening mounts between chassis and body minimise vibration transfer.



A urethane paint is used to protect against stone chipping. This process is intensified through a chip resistant coating on the bottom sill.

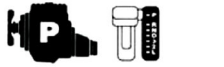
