Bold new beauty with an eager-to-go look.

Nearly 18 feet of muscle and magnificence — that's Pontiac Parisienne. Just the sight of it cruising down your street is bound to bring admiring glances. But what makes Pontiac stand out is more than mere size. It's the new, lean look of action in every line.

You see it first in that massive peripheral bumper, with broad centre bar, that surrounds an all-new grille up front. Very poised and purposeful. And this impression grows as your eye scans back over a long, low bonnet curving upwards as it meets the windshield. No protruding wipers to break this graceful line; they're tucked away in a hidden recess, ready to come out when it rains.

Continuing aft, a dramatic pillarless roofline sweeps down to a concave window and gently sloping boot lid at rear. Enhancing the side view are triple-band whitewall tyres and, if you so elect, a handsome vinyl-covered roof in black or parchment. Equally good-looking is Pontiac from the rear, with deep wrap-around bumpers and distinctive new L-shaped lamp clusters.

All this beauty is there to stay. Pontiac's "Magic-Mirror" acrylic finish, in glamorous new hues, will stay bright and gleaming, year after year, with minimum care. And thanks to "Rustgard" — a new and very thorough anticorrosion process — you can put the fear of rust right out of your mind.

Now we come to what's *inside* the new Pontiac. And what a story *that* is!



On the lookout for luxury? Please be seated.

Pontiac's open door welcomes you to an interior opulent enough for an emperor. Feast your eyes on the sample at left. Those Morrokide-and-woven-nylon seats look almost too sumptuous to sit on. But once you do, you'll almost feel you're floating on thick,

moulded foam latex cushioning—as restful after a long day's drive as it was at the beginning. Front and rear, a broad centre armrest swings down to turn a wide bench into two personal armchairs.

High-fashion materials literally surround you — across the roof, behind the front seats, on the heavily-padded armrests, and right up to rollover level on all four doors. And under your feet the kind of plushpile nylon-blend carpeting you'd be proud to have at home.

The sound-proofed perfection of a beautifully crafted Body by Fisher sees to it that road and engine noises never intrude. At any speed on any surface, the silence is almost eerie.


Getting down to details, it would almost be quicker to tell you what Pontiac doesn't have. But here are some of the ways it coddles you. There's a push-button, 11-transistor radio with rear seat speaker. A heater/demister built in to the engine compartment

for quieter operation. An electric clock to tell you the time of day. A tinted windshield to soften the view; electric

washers to keep it unobscured. A locking and lighted glove box. Even an anti-theft buzzer that warns you if you try to leave the car without taking your keys. All these are standard equipment, as are the many safety items (including energy-absorbing steering) we've listed on page 10.

And here's big news. Air-conditioning by Frigidaire can be yours if you say the word. It's installed under the instrument panel where you can control the temperature quickly and to your liking.

And the big capacity fan is extra quiet.



Here's where you vote yourself into power.

When you're ready to take off and enjoy the sheer fun of driving a great motor car, Pontiac is ready.

Your pleasure starts with the fact that the Astro-Flame V8 engine displaces 327 cubic inches, has a 4-barrel

carburettor and puts all of 250 horses under your personal command. This immense performance is coupled with Powerglide automatic transmission - so smooth that the power flow is virtually uninterrupted. You accelerate, pass and cruise with amazing ease and unbelievable quiet.

Pontiac is remarkably agile, despite its impressive size. You can handle it like a sports car and no wonder - you're riding on one of the most sure-footed suspension systems in the industry. There's a massive coil at every corner. With anti-dive and anti-squat control. Diagonally-mounted shock absorbers to resist sway. And precise power steering to further ease your command of the road.

Pontiac's ability to go is surpassed only by its ability to stop. Big 11 inch brake drums have dual circuits for safety and, with 198.4 square inches of bonded linings, they provide reassuring stopping power when you need

it. Power assistance does the work, not your leg muscles. And the brakes adjust themselves automatically whenever you reverse and stop.

> You can go a long way between stops with Pontiac's 20 gallon fuel tank. But never so far that there won't be a GMH Dealer close at hand. All ready to roll out the red carpet and give your Pontiac the efficient service it deserves (but seldom needs).

Your driving safety is Pontiac's driving ambition. So we start by giving you an extra-wide track (over 62 inches front and rear) for sure-footed stability on any surface. But Pontiac is more than just a safer car to drive. It's also a safer car to be riding in if an emergency should occur.

All the following safety features are standard equipment.

Energy-absorbing steering column. Developed by General Motors, it compresses as much as 8 inches under hard impact.

Dual-circuit braking. Front and rear brakes have separate hydraulic systems. If one loses pressure, you still have effective braking on the other two wheels. A tell-tale light on the dash panel also warns of any loss of pressure.

Safety padding at all possible danger spots — right across the dash panel, on both sunvisors, even around the door handles.

Safety-glass all round with "Modified Zone" for fail-proof visibility in front of driver.

Electric windshield washers for a clear view at all times.

Shatterproof inside rearview mirror "knocks out" under impact.

Glare reducing instrument panel, wiper blades and arms.

Lap-type front seat belts with anchor points at rear.

Childproof door locks and extra strong hinges.

Outside rearview mirror adjustable from driving seat.

Power steering and power brakes for easy control.

Self-adjusting brakes are always at peak efficiency.

Double-sided safety rims on all wheels.

Back-up lights go on automatically when you're in reverse.


Side marker lights at rear are part of the Pontiac crest.
