Advanced electronic suspension system

Suspension system

With the press of a button, select between firm (sports) mode and flexible (comfort) mode. In sport mode, agility and precision become the priority with nine separate settings from which the system will select – depending on your speed, the terrain, and your driving style. In comfort mode, damping settings will automatically adjust to provide you with the most comfortable ride across a variety of driving surfaces (including corrugated iron-like Australian outback terrain). At all times — in either mode — the system's electronic "brain" is gathering and analysing data from various critical areas of the car. It then compares its findings with the multiple selection parameters stored in its memory, and makes appropriate adjustments in the suspension settings — imperceptibly to those on board, and all within milliseconds.



Multifunction key

Security is integral to the 607. I he high frequency remote control keys control the locking and unlocking of each door, as well as the opening and closing of the boot. To maximise anti theft security, the 607 is also fitted with remotely activated deadlocks.

Electric windows

The electric front and rear windows can be centrally controlled and locked from the driver's position.

Electric sun blind

Now you're covered from every angle. With a touch of a switch on the centre console you can raise or lower the rear window sunblind to help reduce heat and UV penetration into the cabin.

Athermic (heat reflective) windscreen

To help keep things cool and comfortable in the cabin, the 607's athermic windscreen has a metallic oxide layer within the glass to reduce the transmission of heat, by filtering up to 25% of the sun's energy. This not only provides coolness, but also UV protection for your luxurious leather interior.

The boot mounted 6 disc CD auto-changer feeds through 12 JBL speakers, with speed related volume control and, to make your listening pleasure more accessible, a steering column remote control system.



Electric Front Seats and **Driving Position Memory**

Driving Position Memory


On the new 607, Peugeot promises you your own personalised driving setting, down to the millimetre. Every factor: the seat fore/aft position, the backrest angle, and the seat and headrest height are motor driven on the two front seats. Once you've found your optimum driving position using all of these parameters, the information can be stored and instantly retrieved for up to four different drivers using either the driver's door keypad, or your remote control multifunction key. Exterior mirror settings are also memorised as part of the programme.



Tiptronic automatic transmission

Responsiveness and silken smooth gear changes are the hallmarks of the Porsche Tiptronic system transmission. There are four conventional positions in the automatic mode. However, if you select the fifth 'sequential' position, you have a super responsive manual transmission on your hands. Change gears effortlessly by pushing forward to shift up and pull back to shift down.

In the conventional Drive position you can select a 'sport' mode for dynamic



Electric tilt/slide sunroof

Automatically controlled by the driver, the integrated sunroof effortlessly glides open and retracts into the roofline for a seamless closure. An optional feature at additional cost.



Once you have selected 'Automatic', when it starts to rain your windscreen wipers switch on and the speed varies according to the intensity. Also, for added safety, the 'Night strategy' sensors apply a faster wipe speed. Conversely, wiper speed automatically reduces if you slow down below 8 km/h.



Automatic headlight illumination system

Fading light, bad weather, tunnels...
the luminosity sensors (which double as a sunlight intensity sensor for the climate-control system) will switch on your headlights automatically. Definitely a 'stand out' safety feature on the 607.



To see you safely inside at night, the 607's lights remain on to serve as "guidance". The lights will then switch off once you lock the car via the remote control.









Active about safety



Airbags

Naturally a car of this calibre has front airbags and side chest airbags, but in the 607 you'll also find side 'curtain' airbags to protect the heads of both front and rear occupants.

Built into the roof, the side curtain airbag activates along the window should a side impact occur. In the event of a side impact collision, these airbags are triggered by a separate control unit situated within the central tunnel of the 607. This control unit communicates with two 'warning satellites' built into the side rails.

To complete the 607's comprehensive airbag safety system, the driver's side airbag features controlled release vents and a 60 litre capacity, which is 33% in excess of the European standard.



Side impact protection

Constructed to minimise the effect of side impacts, Peugeot safety engineers build in longitudinal reinforcing members which have been encased in a special double thickness, shock-absorbing material. Working in conjunction with the full-length curtain airbags, the 607 provides unprecedented levels of safety for all occupants.



Emergency Brake Assist (EBA)

Designed to detect an emergency braking situation, the EBA system steps in and helps by amplifying the braking pressure exerted by the driver. Delivering exceptional stopping power when you need it most.



Electronic Stability Programme (ESP) and Traction Control (ASR)

At the heart of the ESP system is a 'yaw rate sensor'. It is inside the passenger compartment, almost in the 607's centre of gravity. By reading information from the steering wheel sensor, it compares the vehicle's actual trajectory with the trajectory required by the driver. In case of under or oversteer, the system initiates a correcting response by braking one or more wheels, even modifying engine torque if necessary. The traction control system (ASR) utilises the ABS braking system to eliminate wheel spin in slippery conditions, or when excessive power is applied.



Automatic hazard warning lights

In what is a world's first, the automatic hazard warning lights activate to warn vehicles behind that the 607 driver is braking hard. It's all part of looking after the safety of you as well as others on the road.



Pyrotechnic front seatbelt pretensioning

In the event of an accident, a confined detonation drives a mechanism to tension the seatbelt spool. This tightens the belt across the lap and chest well before the wearer commences to move forward and milliseconds before the airbags deploy.



Tyre under-inflation detector

Best-case scenario, loss of tyre pressure can lead to excessive fuel consumption and deterioration of roadholding and braking. Worst case...an accident.

The 607 has a pressure sensor located in each tyre which will transmit a visual and audio warning to the dashboard to inform you of any tyre pressure loss.






Driving down the costs of servicing
