



Everything is neat and tidy on your trip. This is assured by a well thought out storage compartment concept. A roomy drawer is to be found under the driver's seat. The centre console in the cab has a large storage compartment with lid, two cup holders at the front, and one at the rear. The side pockets in the front doors can hold a 1-litre bottle, and there is additional stowage space in the headlining above the windscreen. There are also large storage compartments in the sliding doors and in the footwell of the passenger compartment – so that everything is tidy and nothing is in the way.

New in the Caddy Life: EcoFuel, powered by natural gas.

The Caddy Life EcoFuel helps you to lower your fuel costs as it primarily uses natural gas which is more favourably priced than petrol or diesel. The innovative, 80 kW (109 bhp) 2.01 engine* has been optimised for operation with natural gas and it burns this type of fuel very efficiently and economically. The steel natural gas tanks in the Caddy Life EcoFuel have a capacity of 26 kg. In addition, the vehicle has a petrol reserve of 13 litres. If the supply of natural gas has been used up, the Caddy Life EcoFuel switches over to petrol automatically. The combined amount of natural gas and petrol is enough to cover a distance of some 570 km.

The Caddy Life EcoFuel is full of advantages for you - offers plenty of space, and fits in with all your plans.

Economy

The Caddy Life EcoFuel lowers fuel costs.

Natural gas is more favourably priced than petrol and diesel, and the engine burns this type of fuel more economically and efficiently. This makes the Caddy Life EcoFuel a very thrifty vehicle - changing over is worthwhile.

Performance

The Caddy Life EcoFuel has a powerful engine.

The "quasi-monovalent" 2.0 litre engine in the Caddy Life EcoFuel has an output of 80 kW (109 bhp)* and a top speed of 169 kph. "Quasi-monovalent" means that the engine has been optimised for operation with natural gas.

Range

The Caddy Life EcoFuel can cover long distances.

The natural gas tanks have a capacity of 26 kg. This is enough for a distance of approx. 440 km. The 13 litre reserve supply of petrol extends your radius of action to approx. 570 km – hardly any other natural gas vehicle can equal this. The engine switches over to petrol automatically when the supply of natural gas has been used up.



Safety

The Caddy Life EcoFuel is tremendously safe.

The steel natural gas tanks have electro-magnetic valves with triple protection to prevent uncontrolled escape of natural gas in the event of an accident. The tanks themselves are extremely heat-resistant. They have proved to be almost indestructible in the innumerable tests carried out. The natural gas pipes are of course outside the passenger compartment. Fuel is therefore stored safely and occupants have the best protection at all times during the journey.

Space

The Caddy Life EcoFuel offers plenty of space.

The space-saving underfloor natural gas tank system means that there is unrestricted room inside the vehicle. The 5-seater has a load compartment volume of up to 2,850 litres. Turning the Caddy Life EcoFuel into a 7-seater is child's play - a 2-seater bench can be supplied as a seating option for your children in the passenger compartment.

Heat-insulating windows and sliding window

Heat-insulating windows reduce heating up of the interior through sunlight. A sliding window is standard in the sliding door on the front passenger's side. An additional sliding window is available as an option in the sliding door on the driver's side.



Privacy windows

Windows with dark-tinted glass screen the interior from view.



Ventilation grille with mosquito net for window in sliding door

This practical grille is ideal for the Caddy Life Camper and is fitted in a matter of moments. It is secured and released on the inside via screw fasteners. The ventilation grille protects against mosquitoes and sunlight. It is only suitable for use when the vehicle is stationary and is stowed in a special case of its own during the journey.

Sliding doors to passenger compartment

The two sliding doors – one on the driver's and one on the front passenger's side – have an opening width of 70 cm.



Electric sunroof

The electric sunroof is fitted centrally above the passenger compartment and has a power limiter and sun blind. A sliding roof with additional controls is also available as an option for the cab.



"Exterior" appearance package

The bumpers, lateral door handles and door mirrors are colour-keyed.

Partial leather trim

The partial leather trim package includes a leather-covered steering wheel, gear lever knob, gear lever gaiter and handbrake lever.

"Interior" appearance package

Depending on the seat upholstery colour selected, the colour of the vents in the instrument panel, floor mat edging, interior door panel trim and centre console cloth trim is either blue or red.



Storage compartment on driver's and on front passenger's door

Both the driver's and the front passenger's door have a storage compartment designed to take a 1-litre bottle.



Drawer

There is a roomy drawer under the driver's seat.



There is a compartment with lid and document clip, and an open compartment on the instrument panel.



Roof storage space

A roomy storage tray extends across the entire width of the vehicle.



The centre console contains a storage compartment with lid and two cup holders at the front; and one cup holder, two vents and a 12 V socket at the rear.



Cup holders

Two front cup holders are integrated in the centre console for easy access, and a further cup holder at the end of the centre console in the passenger compartment.




Pockets in sliding doors

Pockets are also located in the sliding doors to the passenger compartment.



Pockets in passenger compartment

Two additional storage compartments in the footwell of the first row of seats in the passenger compartment complete the storage compartment system. If the vehicle is equipped with a detachable tow bar as an option, the detachable ball head is stowed in one of the compartments.



Net pockets

Two practical net pockets on the left and right of the passenger compartment provide convenient stowage space for small items. If a net partition for the luggage compartment is supplied as an optional extra, the attachment points are next to the net pockets.

Pockets in load compartment

Additional pockets are located on both sides of the load compartment. A 12 V socket is fitted on the left-hand side.



Driver's seat

The driver's seat is height-adjustable.



Stowage bags in load compartment

The practical stowage bags in the load compartment can be hung up and taken down again as required. They provide plenty of stowage space for items needed during the journey. In addition, they darken the interior and therefore also offer protection from the sun.

3-seater bench seat in passenger compartment

The 3-seater bench seat is in the first row of the seats in the passenger compartment.



Variable passenger compartment (1)

The 3-seater bench seat can be folded down 2/3 and 1/3.



Variable passenger compartment (2)

The 3-seater bench seat can also be double folded 2/3 and 1/3. This means that when the seats have been folded together, they can again be folded forwards.



Second row of seats in passenger compartment

There is room for an additional 2-seater bench seat in the second row of seats providing comfortable seating for seven.



Double-folding 2-seater bench seat

When folded down, the 2-seater bench seat can again be folded forwards to increase the luggage compartment capacity in a matter of moments.

Luggage compartment

The load compartment capacity on the 5-seater is 750 litres and can be extended to 2,850 litres. Depending on the engine version and number of seats, the payload can be a maximum of 640 kg.

Safety equipment.



Fog lights

The fog lights are integrated in the bumper.



The door mirrors are heated and electrically adjustable. The size and shape of the mirror on the driver's side differs from that on the front passenger's side.



Parking distance warning

Four sensors in the rear bumper and an acoustic warning buzzer give help when reversing into a parking space.

Airbags

The airbag system includes airbags for the driver and front passenger and side airbags at the front as standard. The deactivator for the front passenger's airbag is in the open glove compartment.



ESP

The electronic stabilisation programme ESP+ with brake assist system and trailer stabilisation is available as an optional extra.



Control unit for door mirrors

The control unit is located on the driver's door.



ISOFIX child's seat mounting points

The ISOFIX child's seat mounting points are under a zip on the outer seats of the 3-seater bench seat. They enable child's seats to be firmly secured to the vehicle structure.



Lashing eyes

There are four lashing eyes to secure the load in the load compartment.

Light + Sight package

The rear view mirror recognises via a photocell when headlights are too bright and dims automatically. A rain sensor registers the amount of rain on the windscreen and regulates the windscreen wipers. A light sensor switches the vehicle's lights on automatically when it gets dark (twilight, tunnels etc.).



Multi-function steering wheel

The 3-spoke steering wheel enables the radio, telephone and navigation system to be operated without taking your hands from the wheel. It is offered in conjunction with the DSG shift function on the steering wheel.



Mobile phone fixture/provision for mobile phone with Bluetooth

A mobile phone fixture incl. a "Nokia 6021" can be ordered as an option (see illustration). Provision for a mobile phone (incl. hands-free facility) can be ordered without a mobile phone. Please contact your local Volkswagen Dealer or refer to www.zubehoer-service.de for details of the current range of adapter cradles suitable for various types of mobile phones.

R 110 radio

The R 110 radio in the Caddy Life has four loudspeakers, each with an output of 20 watts. The name of the station is displayed via RDS. Traffic information via traffic programmes is switched on automatically.



RCD 300 radio

As for R 110 radio. In addition: a diversity aerial for better reception, and an MP3 compatible CD drive. The radio is available with an external CD changer as an option.



RCD 500 radio

As for RCD 300 radio. In addition: an integral MP3 compatible 6-disc CD changer. An external CD changer and six loudspeakers are also available as optional extras.



RNS 300 Radio Navigation System

The RNS 300 Radio Navigation System with arrow navigation and text display. This system is MP3 compatible and enables audio CD and navigation functions to be used simultaneously. An external CD changer and six loudspeakers are also available as optional extras.



RNS 500 Radio Navigation System

The navigation system with colour display and voice directions uses data from a navigation DVD which includes map material for most countries in Europe. The drive can also play audio CDs. On request, two additional loudspeakers can be supplied – on the left and right at the rear of the passenger compartment. An external CD changer is also available as an optional extra.

CD changer

The CD changer available as an option is operated via the radio and fitted under the cover in the centre console.



AUX-In

As an option, an AUX-In connection is available for the open glove compartment. This enables equipment such as an MP3 player or portable CD player to be connected to a car radio with changer control. Sound reproduction for portable equipment connected to the RCD 300 and RCD 500 radios or the two Radio Navigation Systems is via the speakers of the built-in radios.



Loudspeakers

Four standard loudspeakers in the cab deliver good sound. The RCD 300 and RCD 500 radios available as options can, on request, be fitted with two additional loudspeakers at the rear of the passenger compartment, on the left and right.



Climatic and heated seats

The semi-automatic air conditioner has infinite temperature control. Heating is available for the driver's and for the front passenger's seat as an optional extra; the temperature settings can be adjusted separately for the two front seats.



Multi-function display

This shows the driver data for driving time, average speed, average consumption, current consumption, range and distance covered. It can be accessed via the operating lever for the windscreen wipers. An outside temperature display is also included. At low temperatures, it gives an acoustic and visual ice warning.

Cruise control

As of a speed of approx. 30 kph, the speed required can be set and is kept at a constant level automatically.





Double clutch gearbox (DSG)

The innovative 6-speed double clutch gearbox (DSG) available for the TDI (77 kW) assures seamless acceleration: engine power continues to be transmitted to the gearbox without interruption between gear-changes. This results in significantly better driving dynamics. Manual or automatic gear-change can be selected.

Vents

Two vents on the centre console ensure good ventilation in the passenger compartment.



Electric front windows

With power limiter and convenience circuit. This enables both front windows to be opened and closed simultaneously via radio wave remote control.



Anti-theft warning system with interior monitoring

The anti-theft warning system with back-up horn is activated via a door contact or movement sensor in the interior; the tow-away warning via a tilt sensor.



Side vent windows

A pair of manual vent windows is offered as an option for the rear of the passenger compartment.



Luggage compartment cover and net partition

The folding luggage compartment cover screens the luggage area from view and can be ordered as an option for the 7-seater. A net partition available as an optional extra keeps the load under control even during sudden braking manoeuvres. The net partition can be rolled together when not required.



12 V socket

There is a 12 V socket in the passenger compartment, on the centre console. A second socket is located on the left-hand side of the load compartment.

Extendible loading surface

The extendible loading surface makes for extremely easy loading and unloading. When extended, the outer edge of the surface has a maximum load capacity of approx. 80 kg.



Tailgate

With heated rear window and wiper.



Rear wing doors

The roof-high rear wing doors with windows are divided 2/3 to 1/3.



Roof flan

The practical roof flap enables bulky luggage to be carried with ease. The flap has two gas-filled struts for easy opening and closing, and also provides more light and better ventilation.



Tow bar

Depending on the engine version the trailer load varies from 1,035 kg to a maximum of 1,500 kg. A fixed tow bar is available, also a detachable and a lockable tow bar.

The detachable tow bar is not available for the Caddy Life EcoFuel.

Special model Caddy Life Camper.



Caddy Life Camper

Up to five persons can go on spur-of-the-moment trips in the Caddy Life Camper camping vehicle: a package with an awning and electric sliding roof can be ordered as an option. A removable cool box (volume of 7 litres) is available – also a folding table plus two folding chairs and a stowage bag.



Sleeping area – Caddy Life Camper

A sleeping surface measuring 1.10 m x 2.0 m can be set up in the sleeping area and, when not in use, stowed in the luggage compartment. The interior can be darkened using a combined system of stowage bags and fabric curtains.

"DVD Voyager 4" multimedia kit

Experience a drive-in cinema in your own vehicle: the DVD tablet player integrated in the 7" TFT display plays DVDs, CDs and MP3s. The system can easily be secured to the head restraints. The "DVD Voyager 4" is also suitable for use as a DVD player outside the vehicle and can be connected to a television – during trips, in hotels, or at home.




Basic carrier with surfboard holder

For the convenient transport of up to two surfboards. Includes two mast holders and two tensioning straps, and can be fitted easily and quickly on the basic carrier.



Basic carrier with ski and snowboard holder

For the safe transport of up to six pairs of skis or up to four snowboards. The holder is lockable and has a practical pull-out function for ease of loading and unloading.



Cycle carrier for the tailgate

Can transport a maximum of three bicycles. Made of anodised aluminium profile bars, with fasteners. Pre-assembled and therefore very easy to fit. Does not impair tailgate opening function. Net weight 13 kg. Carrying capacity 45 kg.



Interior cycle carrier

The modular interior cycle carrier for two bicycles is fitted quickly and easily to the lashing eyes in the luggage compartment. To use the carrier, the bench seat has to be double folded forwards. The interior cycle carrier consists of a basic carrier, plus one short and one long holder.

This prevents light loads and luggage from slipping in the load compartment. Securing hooks on the net enable it to be fastened to the standard lashing eyes.



Luggage compartment insert

This flexible, made to measure insert has an approximately 5 cm high rim to protect the load compartment from moisture and dirt. When not in use, the insert can be rolled up to save space.



Bobsy G0 child's seat plus ISOFIX

This child's seat has a 5-point harness and locks securely into special mountings. It assures a high level of comfort and safety for infants up to 15 months of age or weighing up to 13 kg.


Caddy Life 5-seater/Caddy Life EcoFuel 5-seater




