Underneath its ingenious folding steel roof and flowing lines lies a luxury car that accommodates four adults in supreme comfort, creating a unique blend of style and practicality. The 307 CC takes Peugeot's legendary steering, handling and ride qualities to the highest levels. Harnessed to either a spirited 103 kW 2.0 litre 16-valve or a high-performance 130 kW 2.0 litre 16-valve engine, the result is a genuine wind-in-the-hair sports tourer.

And a little rain won't spoil the fun. Simply press a button and in seconds the 307 CC becomes a spacious, luxurious steel roofed coupé. Chrome-rimmed instruments, drilled aluminium pedals and a leather sports steering wheel complete the visual treat.

The front windscreen wipers activate when they detect the first drops of rain and adapt their speed if it gets heavier, letting you focus on the road.



Dual zone climate-control air conditioning lets you set your ideal temperature and air-flow independently to your front seat passenger:



Cruise control and speed limiter, intuitively accessed from a stalk on the steering column, take the work out of long drives or staying within the limits around town.

Freedom

The 307 CC is a genuine four-seat coupé cabriolet, allowing four adults to travel in complete comfort and elegant luxury with the roof up or down. Once you sit inside the 307 CC, you'll understand why it's in a class of its own for style, functionality and flair.

The 307 CC's beautifully contoured seats are finished in a high quality "Andorra" cloth finish while the 307 CC Sport's interior is trimmed in a dynamic combination of leather and cloth. A variety of leather interiors are available as an option on both versions, allowing you to tailor your 307 CC to your own unique sense of style.

A leather steering wheel with metallic inserts and white instrument dials trimmed with chrome complement the "low" sports car driving position. The ambience of sporting luxury is further enhanced by aluminium pedals, foot rest and gear knob, monogrammed metal door sill plates and chromed air vent controls.

An aerodynamically raked windscreen minimises wind noise and buffeting when the roof is lowered. Programmable climate-control air conditioning, cruise control, six speaker CD/Radio, fingertip-controlled power windows and mirrors, automatic illuminating headlights and rain-sensing wipers are all standard features on both versions of this anything-but-standard vehicle.



Performance

The 307 CC range includes two exceptional engines offering the driver both power and finesse.

307 CC

At the heart of the 307 CC is a spirited twin overhead cam, 16-valve 2.0 litre engine. Featuring a cross-flow aluminium head and hydraulic tappets it revs effortlessly, delivering 103 kW of power at 6,000 rpm and 200 Nm of torque at 4,000 rpm.

307 CC Sport

Powering the high performance 307 CC Sport is a mechanical tour de force: the 2.0 litre 16-valve engine with variable valve timing, dual mode intake and four-way aluminium manifold. This extraordinary unit offers a serious sports car experience, with 130 kW of power at 7,000 rpm and 202 Nm of torque at 4,750 rpm.

Handling

Peugeot's designers have taken that special "top down" feeling to new levels of safety and sophistication. Even with the roof stowed, the 307 CC remains taut, responsive and nimble, its body shell engineered to avoid the flexing that so often plagues other open top cars. This rigid platform is complemented by Peugeot's renowned ride and handling, featuring a sophisticated Macpherson-type independent front suspension, progressive rack and pinion power steering and Electronic Stability Program (ESP). Together with ABS brakes, traction control and Emergency Brake Assist (EBA) the 307 CC driver enjoys a feeling of complete confidence, to go with the feeling of absolute freedom.




Advanced Safety

Active safety underpins Peugeot's fundamental safety promise. That's why we're renowned for cars with crisp precise handling, excellent progressive brakes, and high levels of roadholding and grip. In short, the 307 CC is equipped to help avoid an accident. And should the worst occur, the passive safety features of the 307 CC are similarly state-of-the-art.

Naturally, front and side airbags come standard. The 307 CC is designed around a safety cell that protects driver and passengers with strong side-intrusion bars and controlled-collapse zones. Seatbelts have pretensioners and force limiters and the seats incorporate an anti-submarining feature.

To provide enhanced occupant protection (and add to torsional rigidity) the front windscreen pillars, the sills, and the body's cross-members are reinforced. The entire windscreen structure is designed to act like a roll-over bar and can withstand extraordinary stresses and loads. Optimising roll-over protection are the two self deploying bars mounted behind each of the two rear head restraints.



Active Safety System

The 307 CC has a sophisticated handling and braking system on board, comprising of:

ABS

Four wheel disc brakes and the latest multi-sensor Bosch ABS braking system ensure that the 307 CC can be brought to an extremely rapid but controlled halt should the need arise.

EBFD

Electronic Brake Force Distribution (EBFD) is a high-technology system designed to enhance the dynamic performance of the 4-sensor ABS brakes. Sensors continually monitor the loading and speed of each road wheel and act to maintain the right balance of front and rear braking effort in an emergency stop.

EBA

The Emergency Brake Assist (EBA) system automatically increases the braking effort in a sudden stop situation, and activates the hazard lights to warn following drivers.

ESP

Electronic Stability Program (ESP) maintains your car's balance and control in all situations. By automatically reducing the engine's power output and applying brakes to individual wheels, it returns your vehicle to its trajectory if any understeer or oversteer is detected, helping to keep you and your 307 CC pointing in the right direction at all times.

Traction Contol

The traction control system utilises the ABS braking system to eliminate wheel spin in slippery conditions, or when excessive power is applied.



Passive Safety System

Airbags

The 307 CC is fitted with four airbags – driver and passenger front airbags, and a side airbag mounted into the frames of each of the two front seats. In the event of a side impact, the latter optimise head and chest protection of driver and passenger.

Active roll-over bars

Complementing the reinforced windscreen structure, two steel roll-over bars are concealed behind the rear head restraints. Should the car roll, sensors fire pyrotechnic charges which immediately deploy both bars up and into position – ensuring optimum protection for passengers in the rear seats.


Pyrotechnic seatbelts


Controlled by a specific ECU, in an accident a confined detonation drives a mechanism to tension the seatbelt spool, thereby producing a tractive force along the length of the seatbelt. This tightens the belt along lap and chest well before the wearer commences to move forward against it, milliseconds prior to the deployment of the airbags.
