



A solid foundation for Ford quality. Double-ribbed floor with five sturdy cross members for underbody strength, rigidity. COUNTRY SEDAN POPULAR OPTIONS

Country Sedan owners who show a preference for V-8 "punch", can have the standard Thunderbird 352 Special V-8 or high-stepping Thunderbird 390 Special V-8. Cruise-O-Matic, with its 2-drive-range versatility, is a fine choice in "automatics". Power Steering and Power Brakes will find favour with many owners, while the Push-Button or Manual Radio is a near "must". For added safety and comfort, Ford's Padded Dash, Seat Belts and Tinted Windshield are well worth considering.







9-PASSENGER SEAT FOLD-DOWN

To convert Ford 9-passenger wagons (1) rotate seat cushion forward and lower support legs to rest squarely on floor. (2) Release safety latches behind second seat and flip down seat back. (Second seat is divided so one-third may be lowered to provide a "walk-through" to the rear and still leave two-thirds up for passengers.) With second seat down, (3) simply slip out third seat from cushions and flip down seat back. Loadspace provided totals 931/2 cu. ft.—over 10 feet to end of open tailgate (over 8 feet with tailgate closed)!

Internally mounted shock absorbers.

Foot-operated parking brake with pull-out release knob on instrument panel. Optional Swift Sure power brakes have special low pedal and power reservoir tank.

TIRES: 4-ply, black, tubless with Tyrex rayon cord and Soft-Tread design. Safety-type rims. Wagons— 8.00×14 on 6% rims. Other models —7.50 \times 14 on 5%" rims. White narrow band sidewall tires optional. For wagons optional 8.00×14 6-ply tires recommended with heavy-duty suspension and axle options for greater cargo-carrying capacity.




