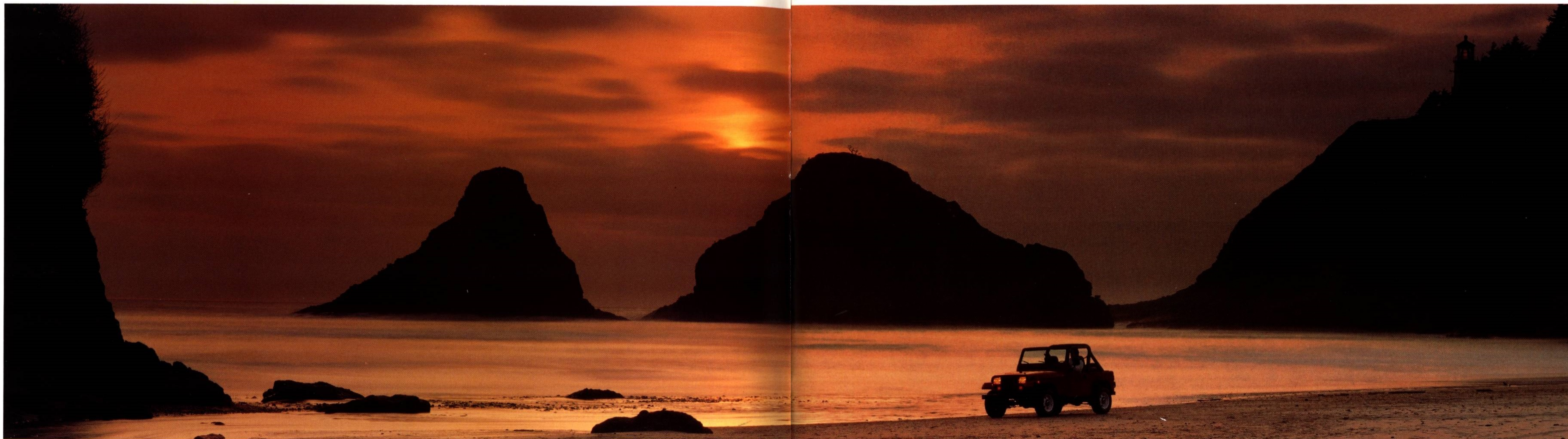

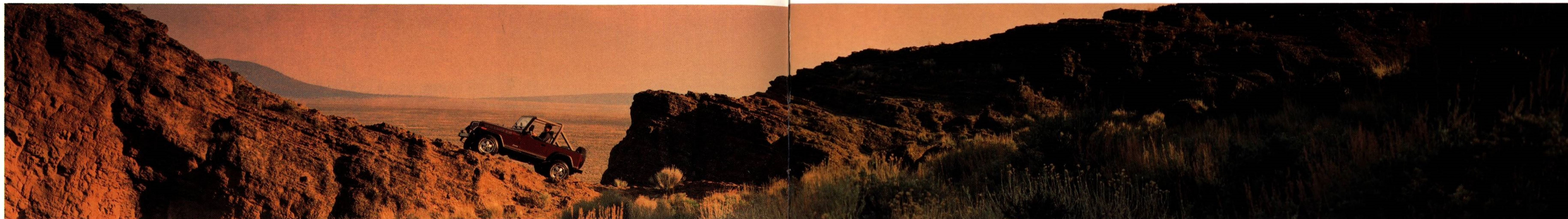

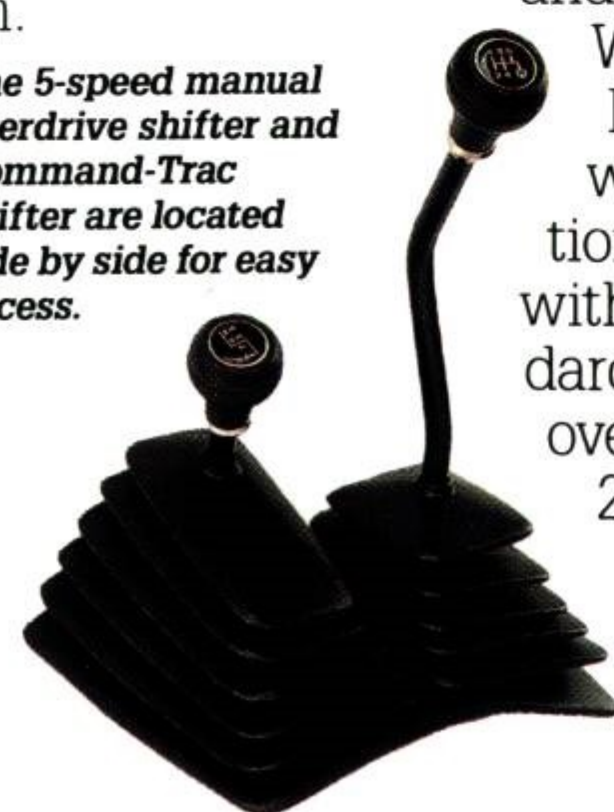


When the terrain requires increased traction and pulling power, simply shift Wrangler into "4 Lo."

### Nonstop Performance.

First to last, 4-wheeling should be fun. A chance to get away from restrictions, including the need to get out and unlock hubs or stop to shift into 4WD. That's why Wrangler is equipped with Jeep's Command-Trac® shift-on-the-fly four-wheel drive system. Simply move the floor shifter, and Wrangler's synchronized transfer case allows you to choose between 4WD and 2WD at any speed. A standard convenience that's exclusive in Wrangler's class.

Ride, too, must be stable and comfortable in four-wheel drive as well as two-wheel drive, so Wrangler is equipped with standard multi-leaf springs mounted to a solid axle to minimize vehicle pitch.

Front and rear track bars help ensure responsive road feel. And a front stabilizer bar provides smoother steering.

For stepping over rocks and ridges, Wrangler combines the effectiveness of new 15"x7"6-slot, white spoke wheels—widest standard wheels in its class—with the exceptional 9.7 inches of running ground clearance provided by an elevated differential and transfer case. And for real enthusiasts, Wrangler offers an optional Off-Road Package—another exclusive in its class.

### Wild Horses.

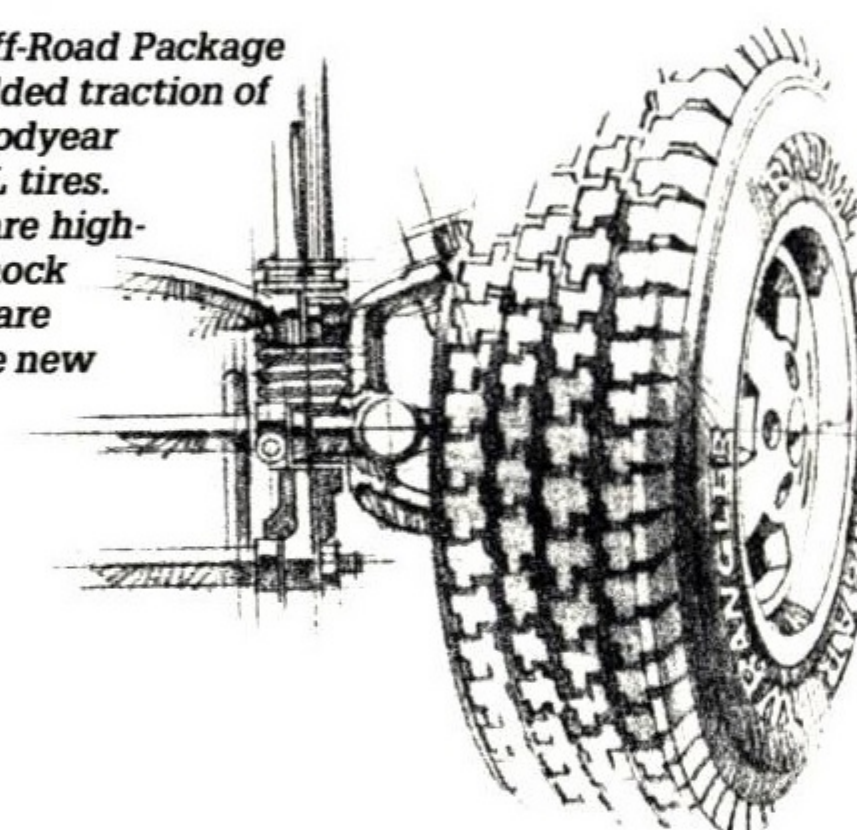
Off road you need power to get up and get over. On road you want responsive acceleration and smooth performance.

Wrangler's standard 2.5 litre 4-cylinder engine with throttle-body injection delivers both. Teamed with a smooth-shifting standard 5-speed manual overdrive transmission, the 2.5 litre delivers the power you need along with the fuel economy you expect.\*

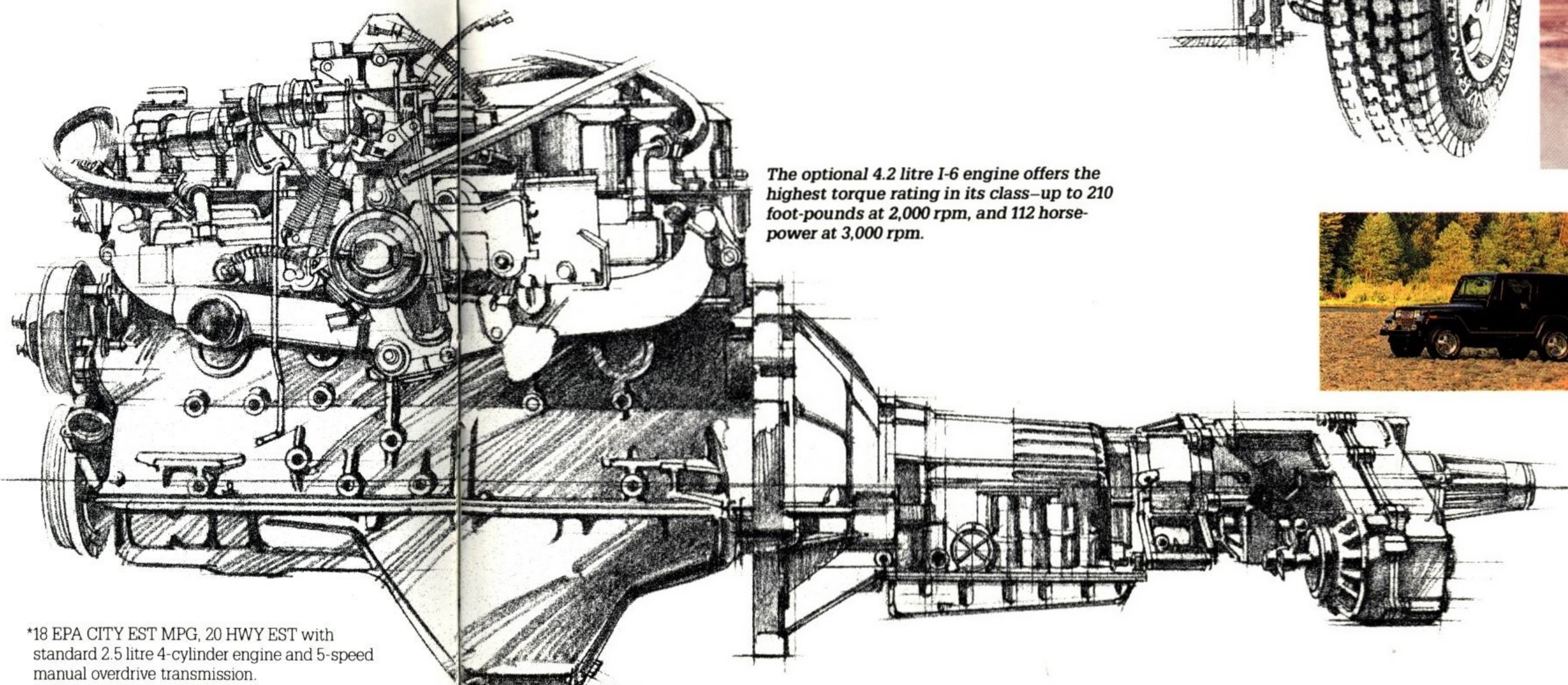
For those who really like to get it on, Wrangler offers an optional 4.2 litre I-6 engine that has the highest torque rating in its class. With this engine, you're free to choose either the standard 5-speed manual or an

optional 3-speed automatic transmission. And to help keep all this power under control—standard power brakes, of course.

The optional Off-Road Package provides the added traction of P225/75R15 Goodyear Wrangler® OWL tires. Also included are high-pressure gas shock absorbers that are standard on the new Sahara model.



The optional 4.2 litre I-6 engine offers the highest torque rating in its class—up to 210 foot-pounds at 2,000 rpm, and 112 horsepower at 3,000 rpm.



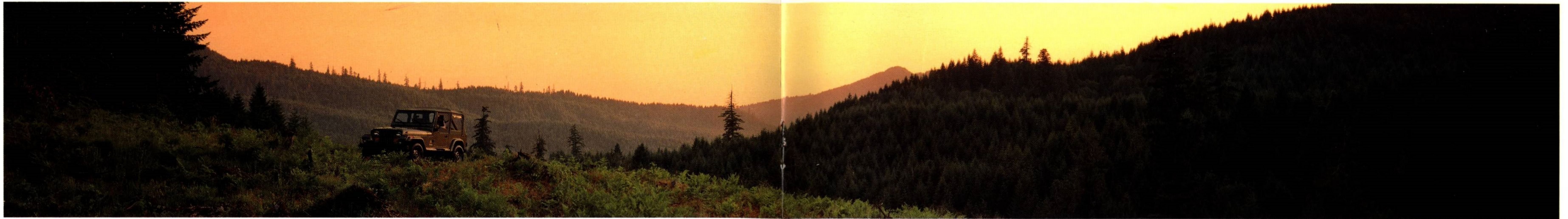

### Durable Goods.

Endurance. The ability to withstand year after year of hard use and rough weather is built right into Wrangler. Its

durability begins with a rectangular-shaped tubular frame design that is lightweight for agility and efficiency, yet able to distribute stress more uni-

formly than the three-sided "C" channels used by Ford and Chevy on their smaller pickups. To further ensure Wrangler's off-road ruggedness, Jeep includes reinforced body mounts, an integral front bumper, and protective skid plates for both the transfer case and fuel tank—all standard.

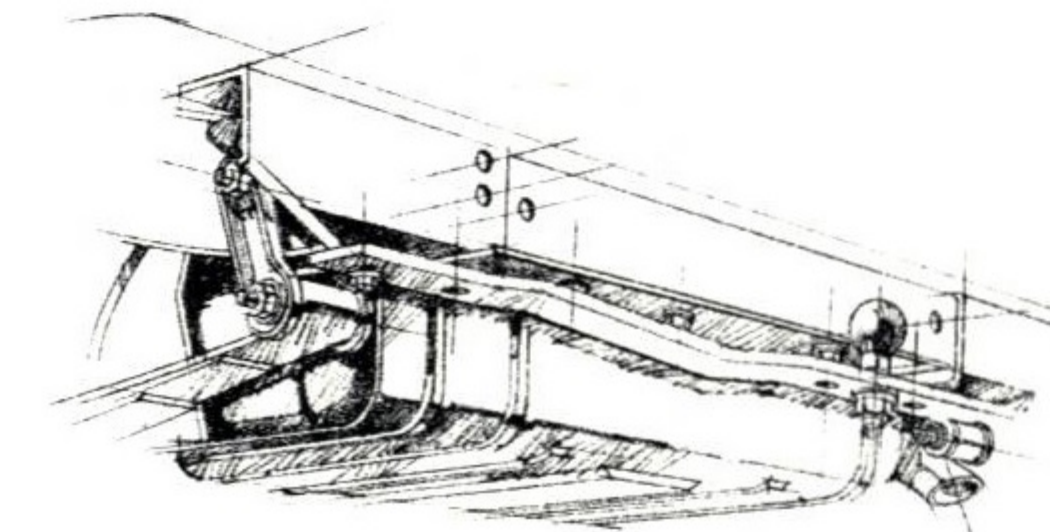
Corrosion protection is another Wrangler strong point. Two-sided galvanized steel is used extensively on exterior panels throughout the vehicle. All body surfaces are cleaned in a phosphate bath, primed, and sealed prior to paint application. All parts such as windshield frame, hood, front fenders, doors, and tailgate are immersed in a solution that electro-

statically

bonds the primer coat to the sheet metal. Following assembly, the full underbody is sprayed with an additional layer of protection. Finally, a color coat of enamel provides Wrangler a rich yet rugged finish.

So thoroughly is Wrangler protected against corrosion that water-resistant plastic liners are used for the rear wheelhousings, high-grade finishes cover all fasteners and latches, and anti-corrosive paint protects bumpers and exposed brackets.

Significant protection is also supplied for major systems such as suspension, steering, and brakes—even more reason why Jeep is the toughest four-letter word on wheels.



A steel skid plate covers Wrangler's standard 15-gallon fuel tank. An optional 20-gallon tank provides a 400-mile range.\*

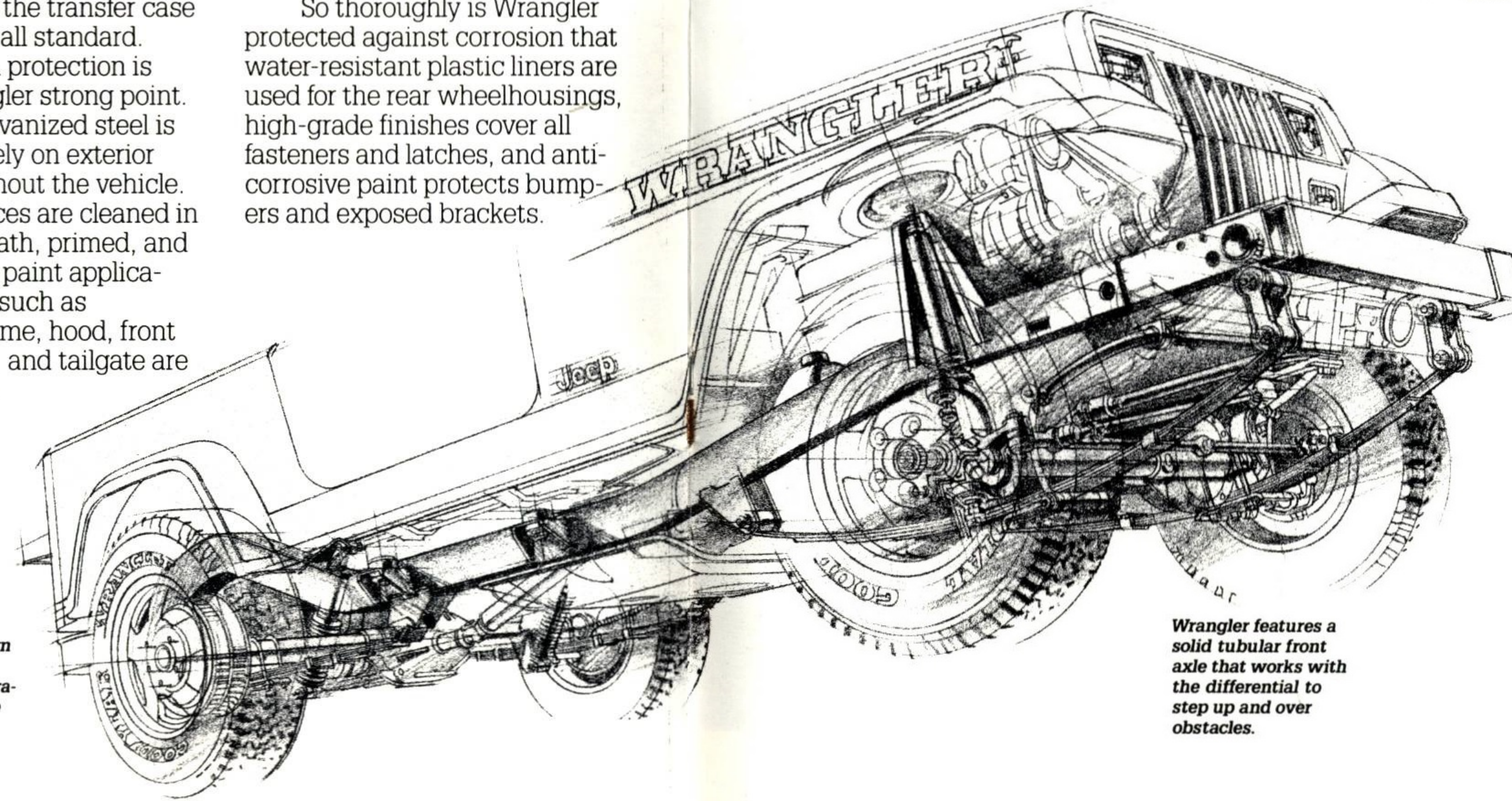
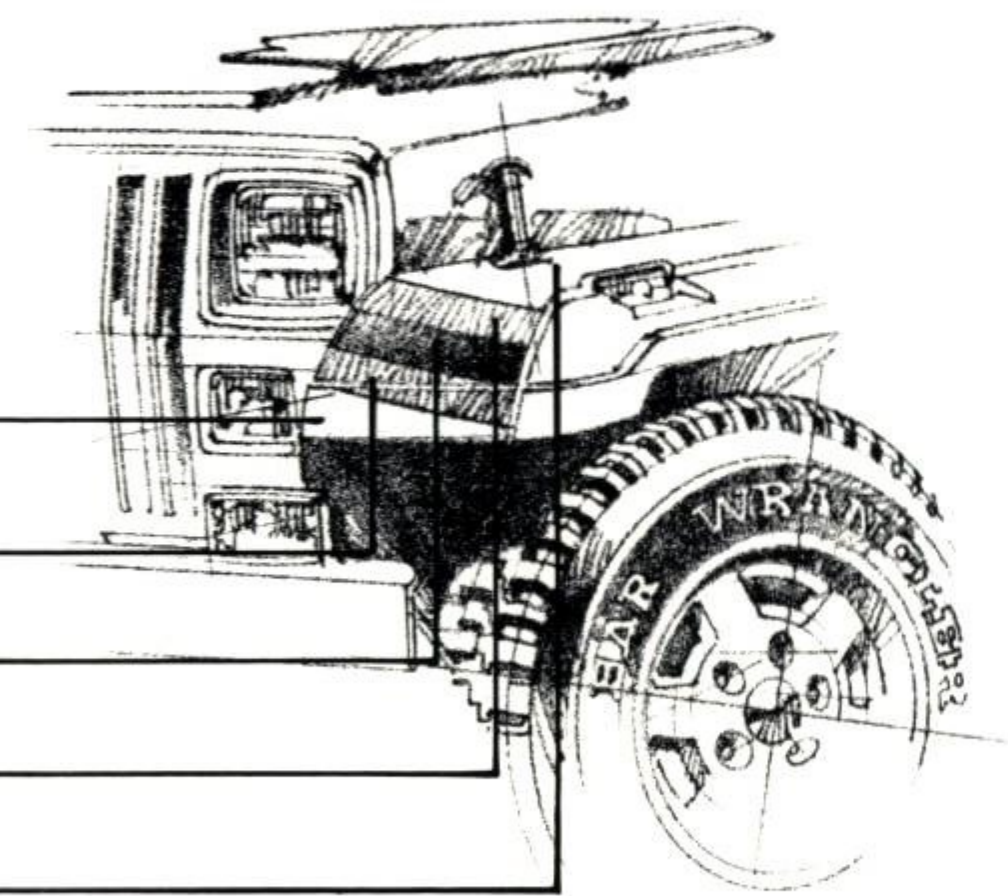

Wrangler Laredo features a standard hard top, full doors, side and rear deep-tinted glass windows, tinted glass liftgate, swing-away tailgate, dual outside mirrors, side step/full-length mud guards, chrome rear bumperettes, chrome grille overlay and bumper, 15"x7" aluminum sport wheels, and Goodyear Wrangler® all-terrain, steel-belted radial tires with out-line white letters (and matching full-size spare).



The standard Sahara interior features new attractive and durable Trailcloth seat fabric in khaki with tan accents, khaki-colored carpeting, leather-wrapped steering wheel, and AM/FM electronically tuned stereo radio.

## Capacity for Enjoyment

Whatever outdoor enjoyment you seek, Wrangler has the capacity to help you get up and go after it. Need more room for gear, you say. Simply remove Wrangler's rear fold-and-tumble seat, and you have 53.4 cubic feet of cargo space\* at your command.

Leave the rear seat folded in place, and Wrangler's vertically hinged tailgate swings wide to provide easy access to 43.2 cubic feet of cargo capacity\*. So well designed is Wrangler that the spare tire carrier is mounted outside the tailgate to preserve cargo area, and the tailgate itself offers an integrated "hold-open" feature to facilitate loading and unloading, even on grades. A locking latch on the tailgate helps secure your possessions, while

a spare wheel lock provides additional protection (standard on Laredo). And should you ever need it, Wrangler's bottle-style jack is located under the front hood, easy to reach but out of the way of people and cargo.

Standard on Laredo and optional on Base and Sahara



models is an attractive, durable hard top. It features large side and rear windows with flush-fitting tinted glass. Dual outside mirrors are standard, and styled side vents provide plenty of airflow. Open the precisely fit full side door, and you will find convenient side steps. Fully integrated with the front fender flares, these steps function as mud guards and, along with rear fender flares, protect against flying road debris.

## Riding High.

Underneath Wrangler's rugged exterior lies an oasis of refined comfort and convenience. Standard high-back front bucket seats are designed for optimum support, with a new fore and aft adjustment that adds flexibility to the passenger's seat. A fold-and-tumble rear seat provides more rear headroom and legroom than either Mitsubishi Montero or Toyota 4-Runner. And new water-repellent Trailcloth upholstery sets off both Laredo and Sahara.

True to its freedom-loving nature, Wrangler Base and new Wrangler Sahara both feature a standard, easy-to-remove and install soft top. Adjustable snaps fit snugly around side rails and soft upper/hard lower half-doors. Side and rear windows zip out easily and can be placed in standard vinyl storage bags to protect against scratches.

Sahara's standard hard half-doors feature convenient map pouches and a removable soft upper half that installs easily to protect against wind and rain.

When reinstalled, windows fit tightly to help seal out dust, wind, and road noise.

In addition to its many standard features, Wrangler's list of optional amenities reads amazingly like that of a luxury car. Optional items on Wrangler (standard on Sahara and Laredo) include leather-wrapped steering wheel, front and rear carpeting, center console, and Convenience Group.

Other Wrangler options consist of dual outside mirrors, Extra-Quiet Insulation (with hard top), and a new AM/FM stereo radio, all standard on Laredo models, plus a 3-speed automatic transmission, power steering, tilt steering wheel, cruise control, and rear defroster (with hard top).

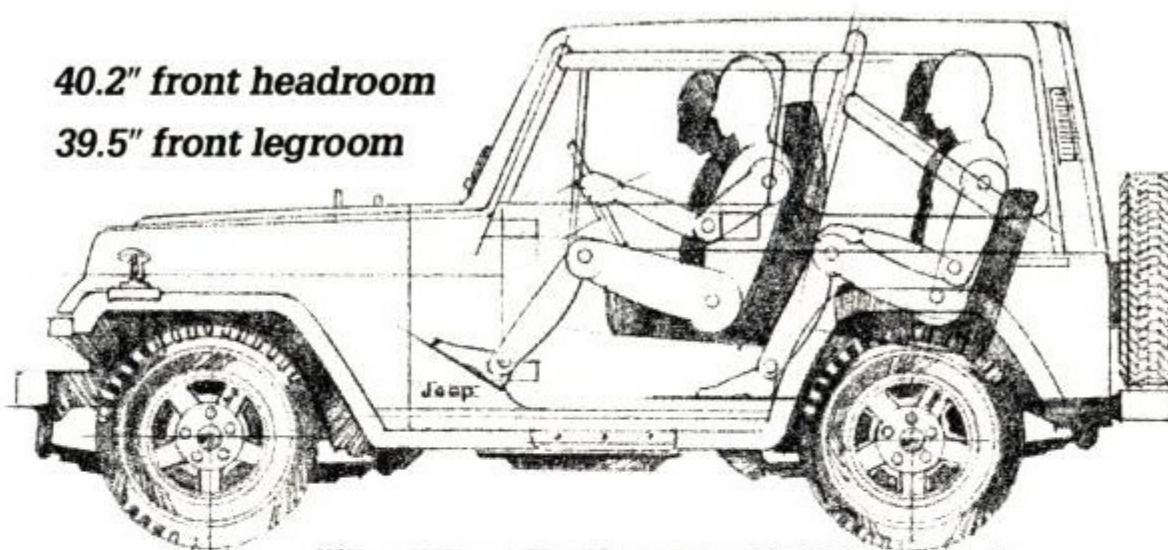

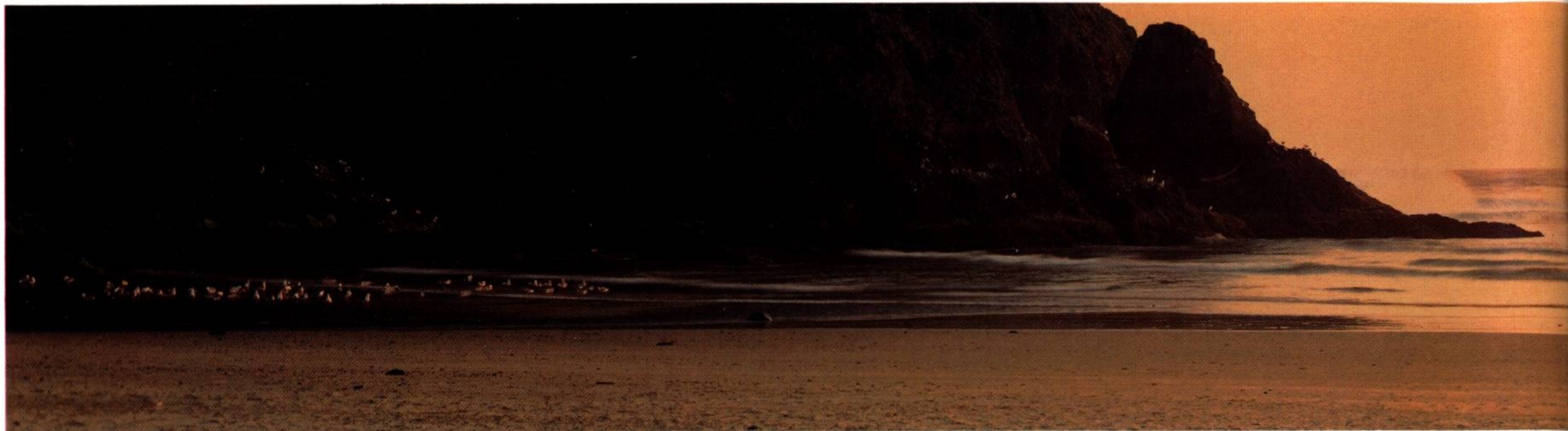

The Powertrain Coverage, under the New Vehicle Limited Warranty, requires the owner to pay the first \$100 per repair visit for the repair or replacement of any covered items.
