

# There's one aim you should never lose sight of: agility

In the past it was all about arriving where you wanted to be. Today it's all about how you get there. And in the A-Class there's plenty to enjoy on the way. On board you'll find everything you need to make your journey more pleasant. Simply taking the standard multifunction steering wheel in your hands will bring a smile to your face. It can do much more than steer. You can use it to touch-control the standard on-board computer plus the optional CD player, the navigation system, the Harman Kardon® Logic 7<sup>®</sup> surround sound system and the telephone. The car's superb response on the road is aided by, among other things, the improved suspension, the wider track

and the extended wheelbase, while the selective damping system with the parabolic rear axle plus electronically controlled power steering add even further to your driving pleasure.

The fact that a job well done can be very satisfying is something that's amply demonstrated by the engines. There is a choice of four petrol and three diesel models. The infinitely variable AUTO-TRONIC automatic transmission (available as an option) allows the power of the engine to flow uninterrupted and entirely in keeping with your temperament: AUTO-TRONIC recognises your driving style – economical or sporty – and adapts to suit it.














#### Compact dimensions, impressive power

The engines have been specially attuned to the car's sandwich-style structure: despite their compact dimensions these engines are packed with power. The 142 kW (193 hp) top-of-the-line model, the A 200 TURBO, in particular is a force to be reckoned with. The petrol line-up also comprises the A 150 (70 kW/95 hp), the A 170 (85 kW/116 hp) and the A 200 (100 kW/136 hp). There are also three diesel models to choose from: the A 160 CDI (60 kW/82 hp), the A 180 CDI (80 kW/ 109 hp) and the A 200 CDI, whose commanding 103 kW (140 hp) and 300 Nm of torque produce a decidedly impressive power curve. Despite so much power, all the engines are models of modesty when it comes to fuel consumption. The A 150 achieves a combined consumption rate of between 6.2 and 6.7 litres per 100 kilometres<sup>1</sup>, while the A 200 CDI is also impressively economical with a combined rate of between 5.4 and 5.7 litres<sup>1</sup>. The secret is reduced friction losses in the engine, a high compression ratio and improved in-cylinder flow.

# Sometimes, a gentle approach can be the better option

Drivers' needs are often a matter of temperament. But whatever your driving style, whether sporty or relaxed, gear changes in the A-Class are always smooth and polished. The 5-speed manual transmission which is standard on the A 150, A 170, A 200 and A 160 CDI is closely matched to the engines. In the A 180 CDI, the A 200 CDI and the A 200 TURBO, the standardfitted 6-speed manual transmission provides agile driving pleasure across all rpm ranges.

The star in this range is the optional AUTOTRONIC continuously variable automatic transmission. A sure judge of character, in the Sport (S) mode it quickly adapts its shift strategy to your driving style – faster-revving for a sportier driving style, slower-revving for a more relaxed driving style. The continuously variable transmission ratio provides seamless acceleration. Power delivery is uninterrupted and at all times the engine therefore operates in the optimal rpm range. In the fully adaptive Sport (S) mode, AUTOTRONIC analyses your driving style and adopts the most appropriate shift strategy.

The A-Class can add a whole new dimension to a balmy summer's night. Press a button and the optional panoramic louvred sunroof purrs quietly open, allowing you to enjoy the beauty of the clear and starlit sky.

But that's not the only time the panoramic sunroof helps to make life on board more romantic. Even when closed, the sunroof is transparent so you can let in a lot more light and enjoy better views. Not to mention the fact that its surface is as tough and scratch-proof as the paintwork itself.

Any time you want, you can shut out the stars – or sun – with the manually operated twin roller blind, which also serves as a draught-stop when the panoramic sunroof is open.

# Light makes you feel good. Take as much as you like

The optionally available panoramic sunroof gives you the feeling that you're both inside and outside at the same time – while still being protected from wind and weather. It extends over virtually the whole area of the roof, so it lets in any amount of light. And whenever you prefer not to see the sky, the twin blind system acts as a sunscreen.

# Hugging the curves

Sit here and you won't be in any hurry to give up your seat to anyone else. Because the optional sports front seats are designed specifically to enhance driving pleasure. With their more pronounced side bolsters plus additional reinforcements in the seat cushions and backrests they provide optimum support even on fast bends. They look sporty, too: all seats are upholstered in ARTICO man-made leather/Zandvoort fabric.

#### The art of changing while staying true to yourself

We believe in the "rearrangement first" principle. That's why there's no longer any need in the A-Class to remove the seats when you want more space. All you have to do is place the back seat cushions in an upright position, fold the backrests forward and move the load floor to its upper position<sup>1</sup>. The result is a totally flat surface without a raised sill to hamper loading

If you want to make more space in the front too, it's simple to fold the front passenger seat forward or even remove it completely<sup>2</sup>.

> Need more luggage space in the rear? All you have to do is fold the seats forward. This produces a completely flat surface with the load floor in its upper position<sup>1</sup>. If you need even more space, you can remove the rear seats altogether<sup>2</sup>.

The height-adjustable load floor<sup>1</sup> offers the utmost in versatility, providing either a flat loading surface, uninterrupted by a loading sill (with a large stowage space underneath), or maximum load compartment capacity with the rear seats occupied or removed<sup>2</sup>.

The backrests and cushions are split 1:2, which means that you can fold down or remove<sup>1</sup> just the right-hand section, for instance, to create more luggage space and still take one rear passenger with you at the same time.

AVANTGARDE line

The AVANTGARDE line is the A-Class at its most athletic: the highgloss black radiator grille, refined chrome trim, dark-tinted tail lights and an interior which features stylish aluminium make this a car that can't help but turn heads

ELEGANCE line The appropriately named ELEGANCE line displays a subtle nobility of style: silver and chrome trim features on the door handles, radiator grille louvres and bumpers. And the style continues inside, where the fine wood and elegant fabrics ensure an exclusive feel

#### **CLASSIC** line

In CLASSIC guise, the A-Class is a comfortable Mercedes-Benz which is always ready for anything you have in mind. The matt black exterior features create a refined look while, inside, the upholstery designs and high-sheen trim exude a sense of style and class

#### CLASSIC line

The exterior of the A-Class CLASSIC: with pale tail lights, a round exhaust tailpipe in steel and body-coloured bumpers. The headlamps feature clear-lens reflectors and the radiator grille is painted in matt black. The CLASSIC line also features 10-hole steel wheels, measuring 15 or 16 inches, depending on the engine model

#### ELEGANCE line

The A-Class ELEGANCE features fog lamps, pale tail lights, an oval exhaust tailpipe in steel and body-coloured bumpers and door handles, highlighted with chrome. The rub strips at the sides are painted in body colour with chrome highlights. Alongside the headlamps, with their clear-lens reflectors, the radiator grille gleams in silver with chrome trim strips. 9-hole light-alloy wheels, measuring 15 or 16 inches, reinforce the overall look

### AVANTGARDE line

In the AVANTGARDE line, which features fog lamps and projection-beam headlamps, the tail lights are dark-tinted. The oval exhaust is trimmed with a polished stainless steel tailpipe. The bumpers and the side rub strips are painted in body colour with chrome highlights, while the radiator grille is in high-gloss black and features chrome trim strips. 16-inch, 5-hole light-alloy wheels round off the AVANTGARDE A-Class

### **CLASSIC** line

The seats can be upholstered in Luxembourg or Eindhoven fabric, which forms an attractive contrast with the high-gloss black plastic trim on the dashboard console. The CLASSIC line features power-operated windows with one-touch down control in the front – press the button briefly and the windows automatically open to their fullest extent

#### ELEGANCE line

In the ELEGANCE line, the seats are upholstered in Antwerp fabric, with myrtle wood trim on the centre console, transmission tunnel and doors. The steering wheel, handbrake lever and shift lever are leather-trimmed. The line also features a luggage cover, an armrest with an internal compartment and poweroperated windows with convenience control (one-touch up/down control, "summer opening" function and convenience closing feature)

### AVANTGARDE line

The seats are upholstered in a combination of Maastricht fabric and black ARTICO Leather<sup>1</sup>. The trim strips are in matt aluminium and the steering wheel, handbrake lever and shift lever are leather-trimmed. A luggage cover also forms part of the AVANTGARDE equipment. The power-operated windows (front) feature automatic one-touch down control

# An athletic build

With the optional sports package you can put your A-Class on track for a more sporty career. The sports package includes all you need for a dynamic presence. It can be distinguished by the perforated radiator grille painted in matt silver, by its powerful 7-spoke, 17-inch light-alloy wheels, by the sports suspension which enables the A-Class to take bends even more dynamically – and by the fact that it seems never to want to stand still.





# A smart approach

The sports package helps give you the edge when it comes to styling, adding yet more class to the interior:

The sports steering wheel is covered in perforated leather and offers excellent grip.

The instrument cluster, with its white dials, contrasts elegantly with the silver-coloured instrument backplate.

The gearshift lever is trimmed in leather and chrome, for that more sporty feel when changing gear.

Studded stainless steel pedals sparkle in the footwell.

And the rear end is rounded off by an oval stainless steel exhaust tailpipe.



# Get in, and you're already heading the right way

You don't have to know everything. You just have to know where to look to find the information you want. The COMAND APS control and display system (optional extra) is where all of the key news and information on board the A-Class converges. The navigation tool decides the route for you, and at the touch of a button you can receive SMS messages. But COMAND APS and Audio 50 APS deal with more than just the factual side of things. Thanks to the integral radio and CD player, they also provide on-board entertainment. And to make telephoning even easier you can opt for pre-installation for a mobile phone including a universal interface and Bluetooth accessories.

The unit has an integral DVD drive: it allows DVD map navigation and can be combined with the Harman Kardon<sup>®</sup> Logic 7<sup>®</sup> surround sound system - for that liveconcert atmosphere.

The colour display shows you just how big a 6.5-inch image can be. This is where it all happens: navigation, the DVD function and control of all other functions.



Everything seems easier with musical accompaniment: COMAND APS plays audio CDs and has a radio receiver.

The inner beauty of COMAND APS includes a large memory capacity: after the route has been calculated, your route is saved, leaving the CD/DVD drive free for your entertainment.




## Some things are too important for you to cope with all on your own

Our engineers never tire of finding new ways to make Mercedes-Benz cars even safer. So like all its stablemates, the A-Class was also subjected to our rigorous safety tests. And passed them with flying colours. Because it is packed with features designed to prevent accidents. On every trip, intelligent active safety systems – like the Electronic Stability Program ESP<sup>®</sup> and the Brake Assist system BAS – help the driver to master critical driving situations.


But even if a collision cannot be prevented, the A-Class is well prepared. The sandwich design plus an intelligent variation on the crumple zone makes the A-Class a very safe place to be. This was confirmed by the official Euro NCAP crash test, in which the A-Class achieved the highest possible rating of five stars.

The A-Class also offers very good protection in the event of a rear-end collision – thanks to the high seat strength and active head restraints, which can protect the head and neck from whiplash. In car seat and head restraint tests run in 2005 by the ADAC, the German automobile association, the A-Class saw off competition from eight small to mid-range cars to come out on top.

In the event of a serious frontal collision, the engine block, which is tilted forwards, is deflected downwards and slides away along the angled pedal floor. This reduces the risk of the drive components penetrating the occupant zone You can tell from its shape that the A-Class is unlike any other car. It is based on a unique principle, the sandwich design. An intelligent form of crumple zone, this principle also has benefits in a side impact, since the seating position is somewhat higher than in a conventional saloon




# Supplied as standard: a sixth sense for danger


The airbags in the A-Class are triggered selectively, in line with the type and severity of the impact. In a frontal impact, either one or both stages of the two-stage front airbags may be deployed, as required. By adapting their degree of inflation in this way, the airbags provide the driver and front passenger with the most appropriate level of protection.

The front head/thorax sidebags provide additional protection in the head and chest areas in a lateral impact. Further protection for the front passengers is provided by active head restraints which automatically move forwards in the event of a rear-end collision. If the impact exceeds a specific threshold, the belt tensioners on the front and outer rear seats are deployed, instantly pulling the belts taut around the occupants' bodies. At the front, belt force limiters raise safety in a frontal impact a further notch. When the force exerted by the tensioned belt exceeds a pre-determined level, a controlled amount of give is introduced into the belt. In a side impact, meanwhile, the optional windowbags inflate like a curtain between the A and C-pillars and, in conjunction with the optional rear sidebags, provide outstanding protection for the rear-seat passengers.

The most important restraint system is the seat belt. Airbags can provide additional protection, but are only activated if certain complex deployment criteria are met. ### ABS/BAS

The anti-lock braking system (ABS) prevents the wheels from locking. This means that the brakes can get a better grip, and the vehicle remains steerable, even on ice or in the wet. Brake Assist (BAS) mean-while helps you when you need to stop the vehicle as quickly as possible. The system is able to detect an emergency braking situation by monitoring the speed at which the brake pedal is depressed. It then quickly applies maximum braking force.

### ESP<sup>®</sup>/ASR

The Electronic Stability Program ESP® helps to stabilise the vehicle in critical situations by precisely controlled braking at one or more wheels. Sensors continuously measure speed, lateral acceleration and yaw (rotation of the vehicle about its vertical axis). Comparing this data with the input from the driver (steering wheel position, accelerator pedal, brakes, transmission), the system then assesses whether any intervention is necessary to stabilise the vehicle. Acceleration skid control (ASR) prevents wheelspin when driving off and accelerating.

### **Bi-xenon headlamps**

The optionally available bi-xenon headlamps include a cornering light function which is activated automatically in response to direction indicator operation or steering wheel angle (up to 40 km/h).

The designo styling team have come up with four high-quality leather/Alcantara upholstery options for the seats. Included in the specification is designo anthracite poplar wood trim with a luxurious piano lacquer finish. And to round off your personalised interior, the designo specification includes a designo wood/leather gearshift lever.





### Disarming appeal

The closer you look, the more the sensual appeal and comfort of the designo interior works its magic. The special designo seat design, and the combination of finest-quality black designo leather and soft Alcantara for example in designo java – lends your A-Class a touch of luxury. A front armrest trimmed in black designo leather and luxurious velour floor mats, edged in black designo leather, complete the picture

Application of the corrosion protection is followed by two water-based coats, then by a virtually solvent-free powder slurry clearcoat. Altogether, paint consumption is cut by about 20 %, and solvent emissions are reduced to a minimum.
