
Our Mercury reputation for building fine riding cars is a hard-earned one. In test after test we've set out to demonstrate this dramatically on TV. Like the time we split a diamond now worth \$125,000 in the back seat of a traveling Marquis Brougham.

In other tests Marquis models were rated superior to a succession of expensive luxury sedans and limousines by panels of professional chaufeurs and airline pilots asked to judge them on riding or driving comfort. And those tests in which panels of competitive owners rated a personal size Montego superior in riding comfort to three leading competitors in the same size and

price class, and to our competition's best-selling full-size model in yet another test.

After we had demonstrated the outstanding ride of these Mercurys, we decided to show how well Mercury's great ride could stand up. So we put 40,000 highway miles on a Marquis Brougham, driving it day and night and pausing only for routine maintenance and less than \$47.00 in repairs. Then still with its original steel-belted radials, it was matched against a \$28,000 European luxury sedan with less than 600 miles on the odometer. Professional chauffeurs, asked to compare riding comfort, picked the Marquis by better than three to one as superior in riding comfort.

The remarkable riding stability of a 1974 Mercury Montego









was demonstrated recently on TV. The technical director of National Astro Laboratories assembled a tiny $1\frac{1}{2}$ -inch television set while riding in the rear seat at speeds of 20 to 60 mph. Performing 204 hand operations, he put the 146 components together in just over 16 hours and had it working on a closed circuit signal. It took skill and concentration plus the smooth ride and steady "work surface" provided by the Mercury Montego.

In still another commercial, a ride demonstration, we invited actress-model Jennifer O'Neill to apply her makeup while riding in a 1974 Mercury Marquis Brougham at speeds of 20 to 45 mph over a variety

of road surfaces. Jennifer took 8 minutes and 48 seconds to complete her makeup and because of the Marquis' smooth ride she had no problems.

For 1974 we've polished Mercury's ride by computerized selection of springs on all models from the Marquis Brougham to the Mercury Comet. And because, today, you also need a car you can afford to operate, we have dealt with this problem. Our 1974 Mercurys are designed to save you from 19% to 26% in estimated average maintenance costs for 50,000 miles of normal driving compared to similar costs in 1973. And our 1974 Mercury models use regular gas.




