Within the all-new Mazda MX-6 production facility, advanced technology has been focused on a very special objective: to create a unique harmony of mankind and *machinery* in order to produce a new harmony between driver and *road machine*. Sophisticated robotics, computerized processes and new manufacturing techniques enable highly skilled workers to achieve optimum quality in each step of production. Thus, every MX-6 produced there is a state-of-the-art driving machine in its construction as well as its design.

## HEART OF THE MX-6: POWER

It's an advanced-design 2.2-litre engine, seen at right in its turbo configuration. Its basic design provides three valves per cylinder for enhanced breathing and power output. A Mazda-developed induction system achieves special supercharging effects—without a supercharger—to create optimum power and torque throughout the rpm range. Multi-port fuel injection constantly fine-tunes performance to the needs of the moment.

All of which translates into extraordinary driving fun with a crisp

five-speed overdrive transaxle unless you prefer the option of an advanced four-speed overdrive automatic transaxle, electronically controlled with three driving modes. The shift points adjust for "Power" or "Economy;" and "Hold" aids driving in lower gears on slip-

Pery roads or hills.

Twin Trapezoidal Linkage rear sus-

pension had been refined significantly—it now neutralizes kinetic driving forces which cause toe-out

of the rear wheels during acceleration, braking and turning, and keeps them in their most effective alignment for improved road control.

Up front, a special center bearing creates, in effect, equal-length drive shafts to the front wheels to dampen torque steer. And long-travel struts all around enable you to master bumps and ruts. Power-assisted rack-and-pinion steering provides just the aid you want in whatever maneuver, yet preserves a crisp, linear feel of the road at speed. And power-assisted brakes, with vented discs up front, give you plenty of stopping power for the kind of eager driving you will find yourself doing.

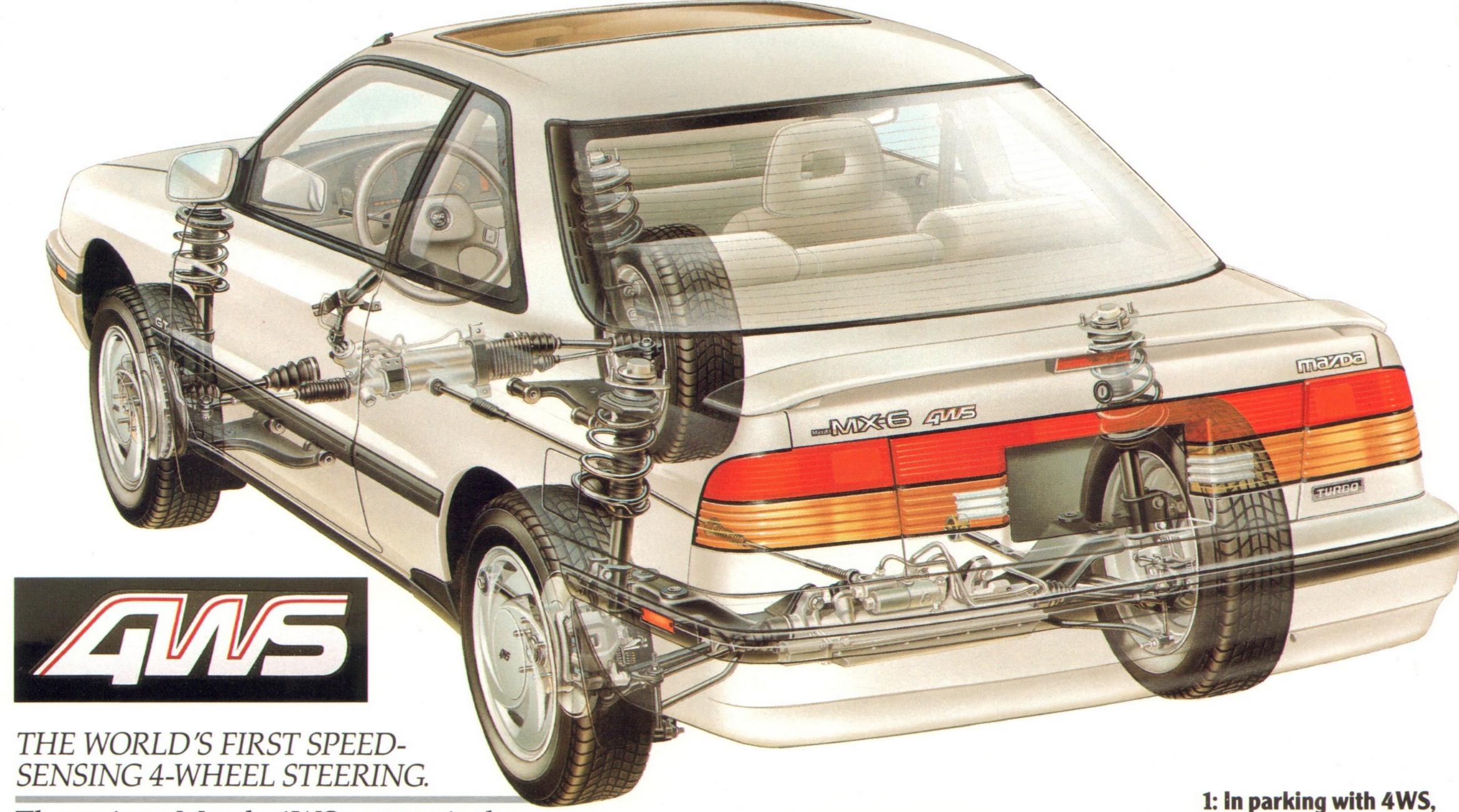

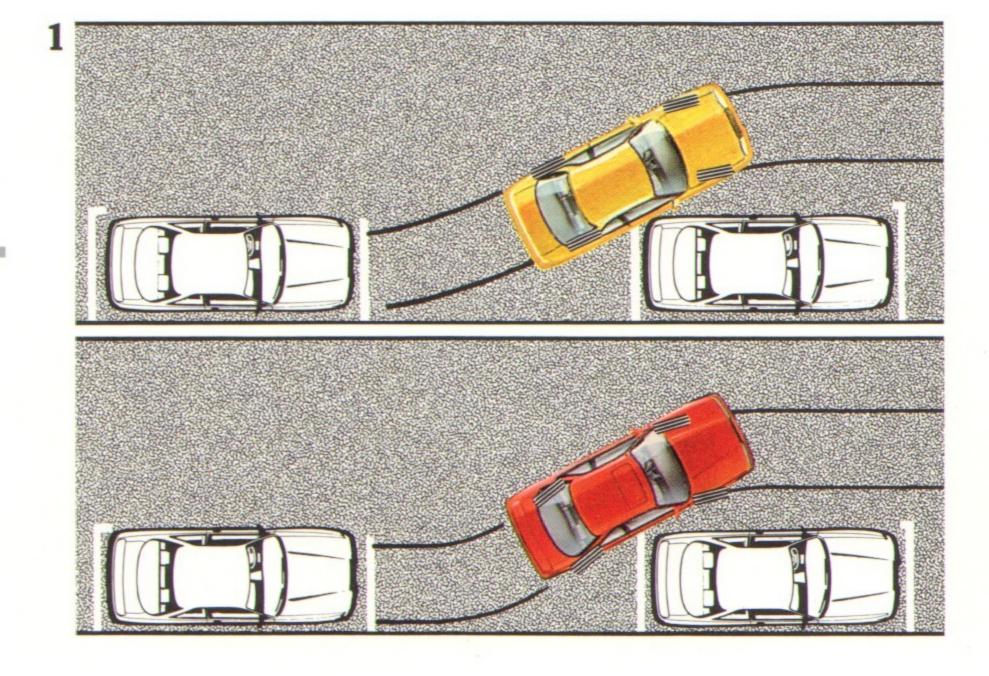

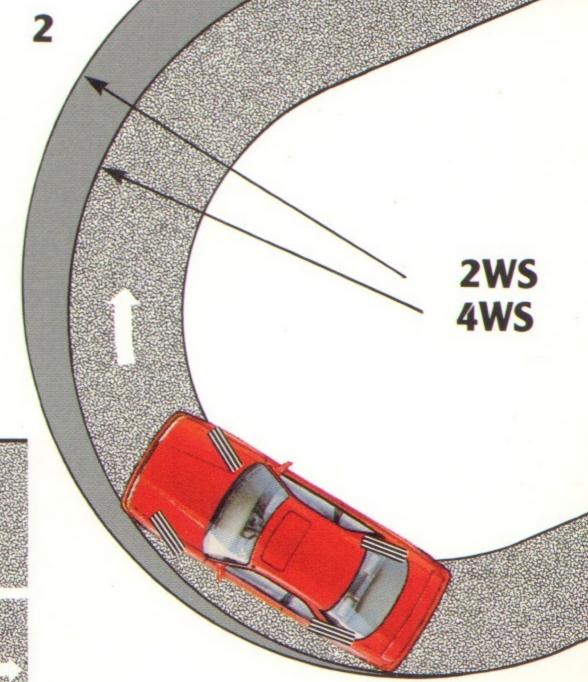

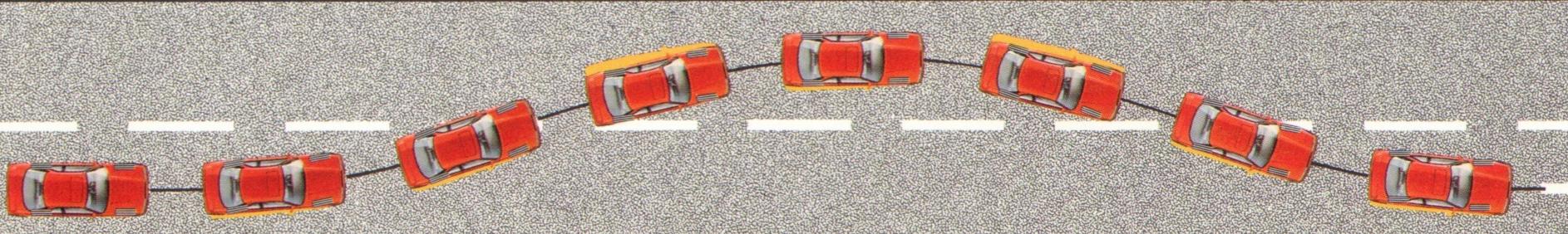

Our most potent form of pure sports coupe performance and luxury: MX-6 GT, seen here and on the covers.

The performance part begins with a special turbocharged and intercooled edition

of the MX-6 2.2-litre, 12-valve engine. It generates 145 hp at 4300 rpm, 190 lb.-ft. of torque at 3500 rpm—numbers which considerably understate the dramatic impact its virtually lag-free response has upon your driving.

Zero to 60 is a glorious rush of 7.4 seconds—quicker than quoted for many more expensive sports coupes.



As Road & Track noted, MX-6 GT "gives you a good swift kick in the back, delivering more pleasure than any mere numbers on a stopwatch."

## OTHER DIMENSIONS.

Turbo power alone does not make a spectacular sports coupe; what MX-6 creates in its GT does. Among other things, the GT gives you a sophisticated

sports-car-caliber variable-assist power steering system. Electronically controlled and microprocessor-managed, its special sensors monitor both vehicle speed and the

steering angle of the front wheels to provide incredibly precise assistance for every driving situation—from finger-tip-easy turning into a parking spot, to a firm, linear feeling of command at speed.

GT's vaunted performance credentials continue, with high-performance radials upon 15"x 6" aluminum alloy wheels, front/rear stabilizer bars, and rear spoiler—all standard. MX-6 GT delivers stopping

power to match its go, with powerassist four-wheel disc brakes, the front ones ventilated to further resist fade in hard use.

Finally, MX-6 GT gives you a special three-mode Automatic Adjusting Suspension (AAS). It instantly adapts the ride and handling for any situation, minimizing squat, dive and roll. And GT offers the option of an Anti-lock Brake System (ABS)

## THE ULTIMATE SPORTS COUPE.

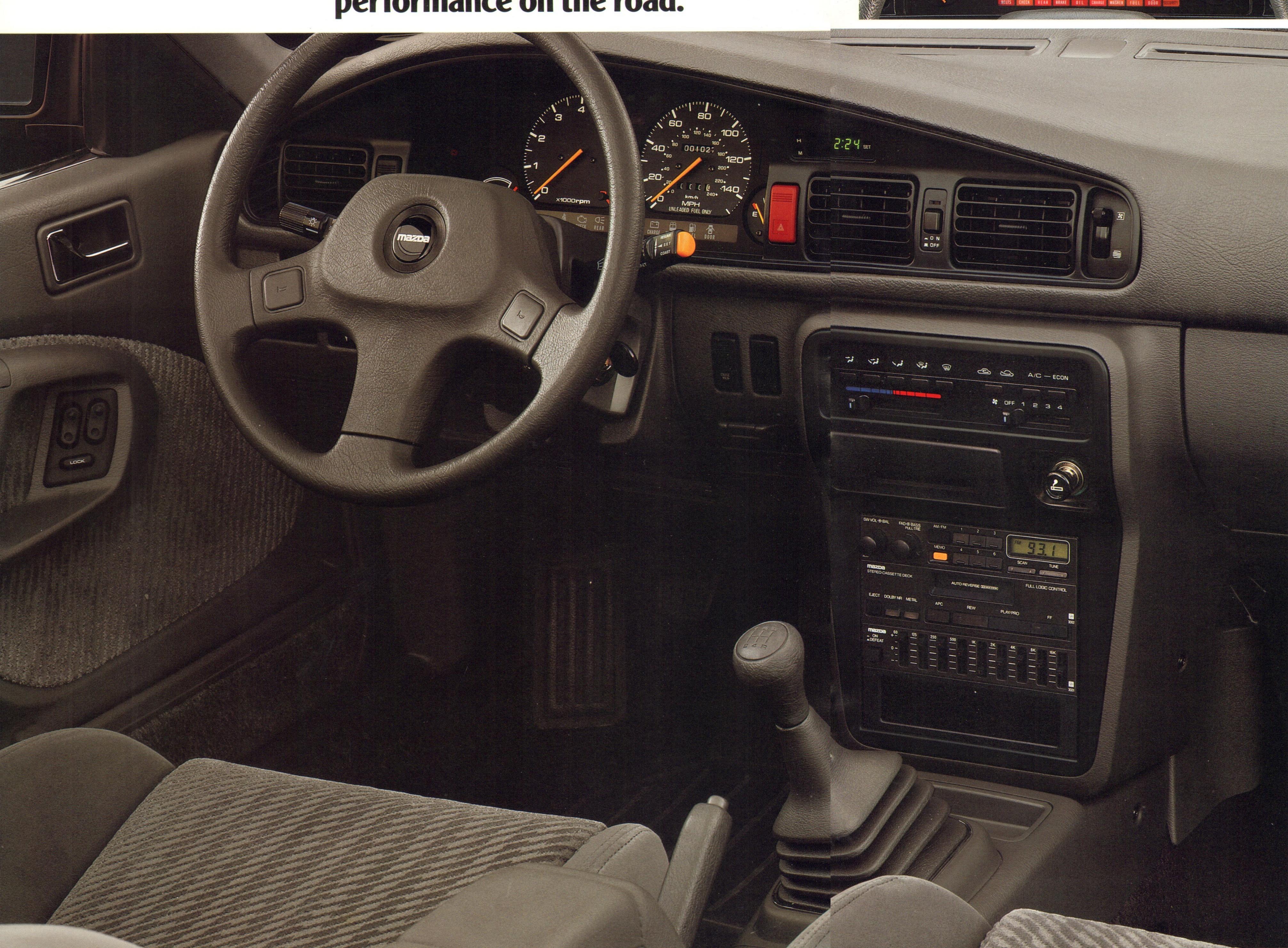

Nevertheless, the advantages here aren't mechanical alone, as you will see on the following pages. In bountiful space, creature comforts and sheer liveability—as well as performance—MX-6 GT is intended to provide the ultimate—for that, too, is The Mazda Way.



# Extraordinary ergonomics, luxury and space need not detract from exhilarating performance on the road.





Too often in the past, sports coupes were to be enjoyed in spite of their accommodations, not because of them. That, however, is not The Mazda Way. In this, our third-generation sports coupe, the harmony between driver and machine has reached heights perhaps never before realized in this class of car.

The bigger you are, the more likely it is you will appreciate the extra room you have for your height, hips, shoulders and knees that is often missing in the others.

Front bucket seats are contoured and accommodating: In 4WS, GT and LX, the driver's seat adjusts seven ways, including upper side bolsters, which can be dialed in to hold you in place during serious driving, or dialed out for leisurely comfort. A tilt-adjustable steering wheel is standard.

Sports-carlike controls are easy to find and natural to use. The instruments are large and easy to read; they include a tachometer and analog gauges on all models.

The cockpit in all three models is replete with cruise control, power windows and door locks, dual map lights overhead and a driver's left footrest underfoot—all standard to help effect that harmony. What helps also is a premium-quality AM/FM/cassette sound system with 125-watt amplifier and a center-channel bass subwoofer; plus a 9-band graphic equalizer in 4WS and GT, optional in LX.

This is where harmony of driver and machine is meaningful, indeed.

Both present the cleanly sculptured look so finely honed it carries a drag coefficient of just 0.32—which is not only lower than some sports cars we could mention, but contributes to fuel efficiency, handling ease and quiet. Both feel tight

For performance, both benefit from a fuel-injected 12-valve 2.2-litre engine with 110 horsepower that feels like more. Power-assisted steering and brakes. A crisp-shifting 5-speed overdrive. And a sporty suspension that's patented and



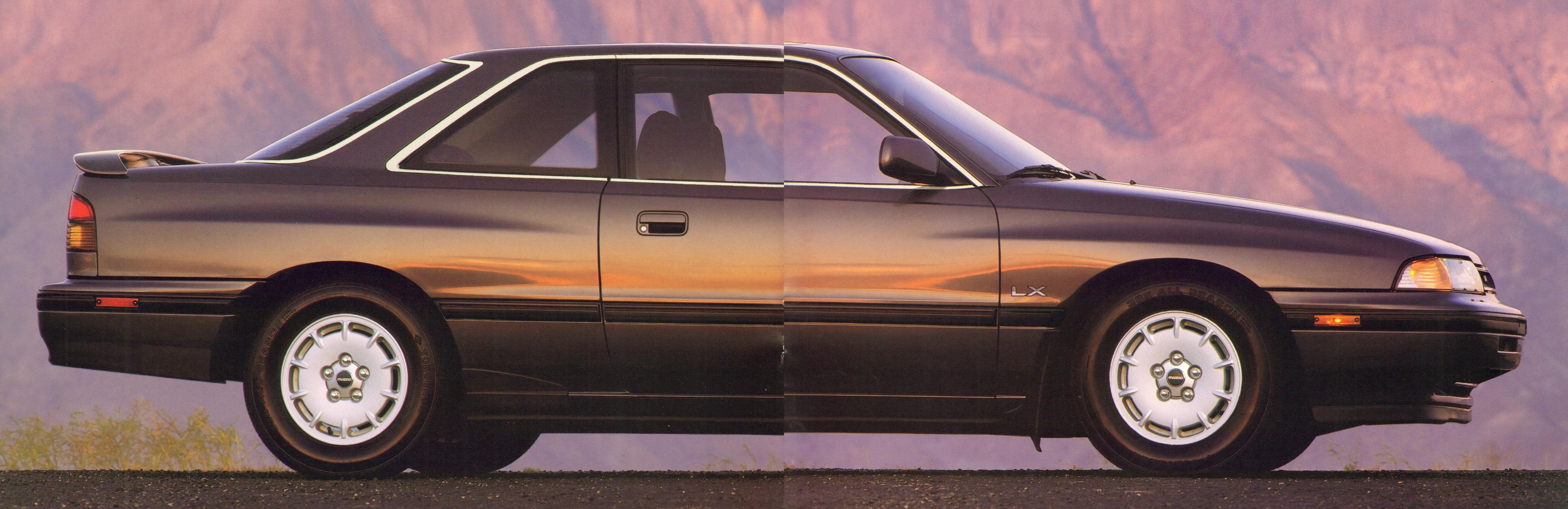

Inevitably, the choice comes down to your tolerance for luxury. The LX standard equipment includes an incredible number of items, from power windows and door locks to a premium-quality sound system to cruise control-and offers such options as a sliding steel sunroof, rear wing spoiler and CD player.

So measure your tolerance for luxury, and choose accordingly.

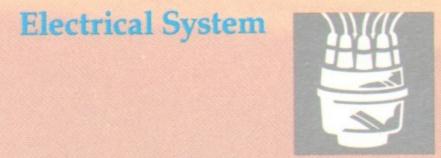
