When 17 European countries all vote in unison, you know the jury has not been tampered with.

Fifty-seven respected auto writers from throughout Europe evaluated new cars on performance, technology, comfort, safety and value.

"Scoring the highest points total in the 25-year history of the competition, Peugeot's 405 sedan romped home with the European Car of the Year award," reported *Motor Trend*.

The 405 was awarded 464 points. "It garnered more points," continued *Autoweek*, "than any previous winner, 54 of the 57 jurors voting it first."

The Germans bestowed upon the 405 their most prestigious honor—the Golden Steering Wheel award.

In Denmark, the 405 was also voted car of the year.

"Peugeot obviously has a winner on its hands", predicted *Automobile Magazine*. We have just two words for all who sat in judgment: thank you.

Car and Driver noted, "The ride and handling, for what can be thought of as either a family or a sports sedan, are outstanding."

THE Mi 16. INTRICACIES OF POWER.

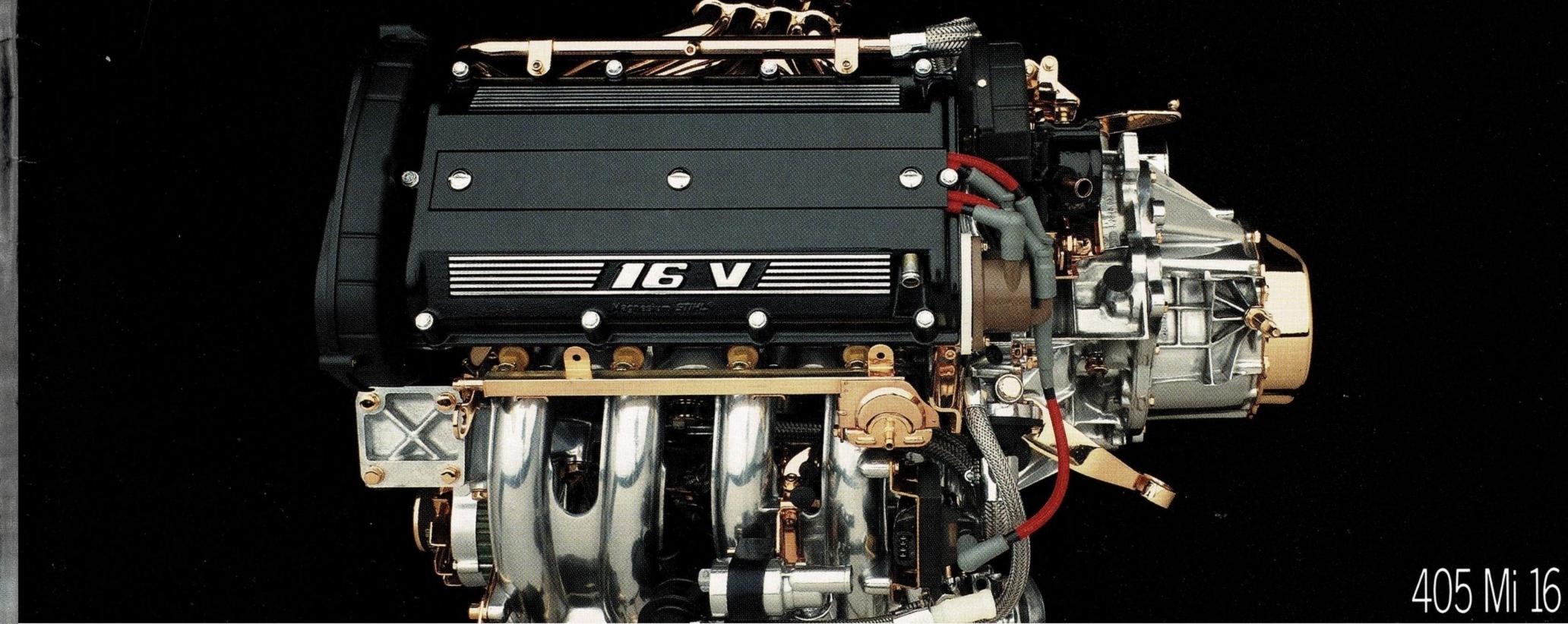
Representing the top-of-the-line, the 405 Mi 16 is Peugeot's first 16-valve, four-cylinder production car in America. Each cylinder has four valves, each with a hydraulic tappet for optimum smoothness. Its power rockets up to 150 horsepower at 6400 rpm.

This transverse-mounted, light-alloy engine block

is the same one used in the two-time world-champion Peugeot Turbo 16 rally car.

A Bosch Motronic digital computer of the type used on Formula One racing cars, manages fuel injection and ignition, creating more efficient engine performance.





CROSS YOUR LEGS IN THE BACK SEAT.

"What is attracting families to the 405 is its roomy interior. The rear passenger compartment is cavernous," noted *Autoweek*. "Behind the rear seats, too, is a luggage compartment large enough for four people's luggage."

The leather seats will justifiably remind you of the finest soft leather gloves. Even the backs of the seats are

leather. Infinitely adjustable, electrically heated in front, these seats are standard on the Mi 16 and also available on the 405 S, with the "Luxury Touring Package".

In the 405, the space will do more than accommodate you.

There is one thing you will not be accused of being when driving a 405 S on the streets of competition: a clone.

The intercooled 505 Turbo relentlessly digs deeper than the BMW 325is and the Mercedes-Benz 300E.

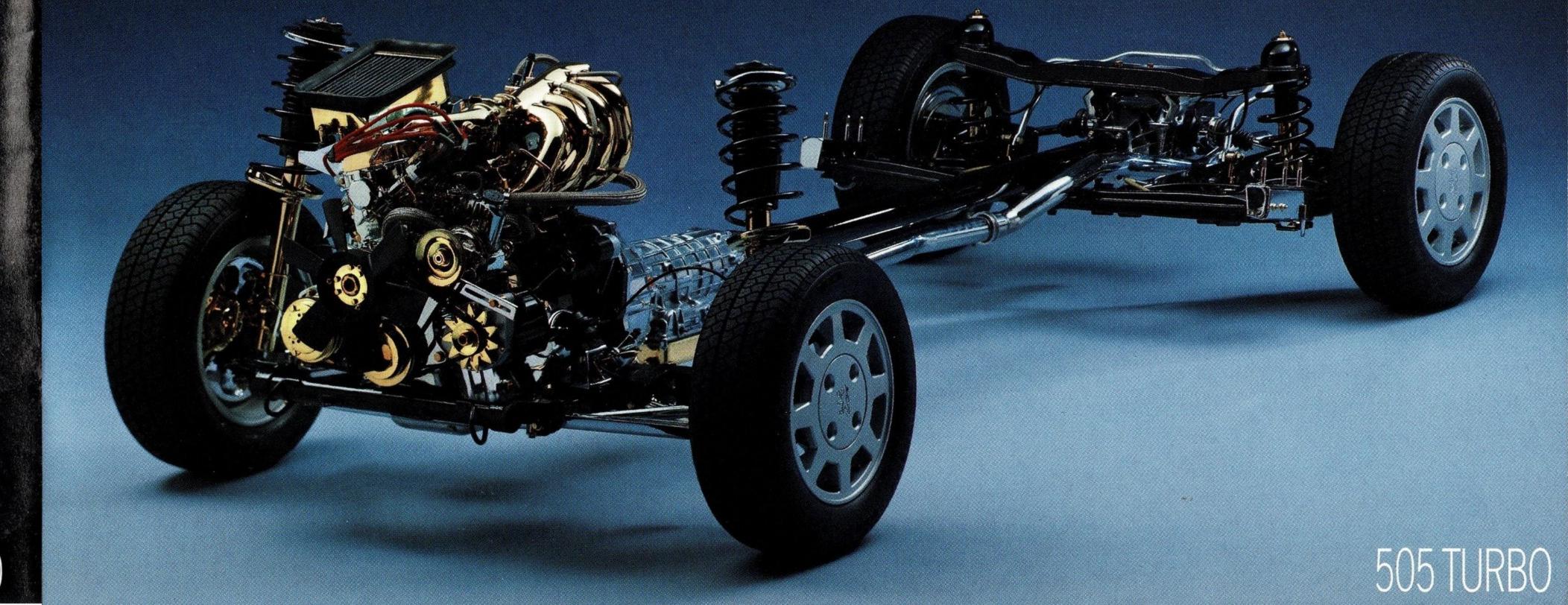

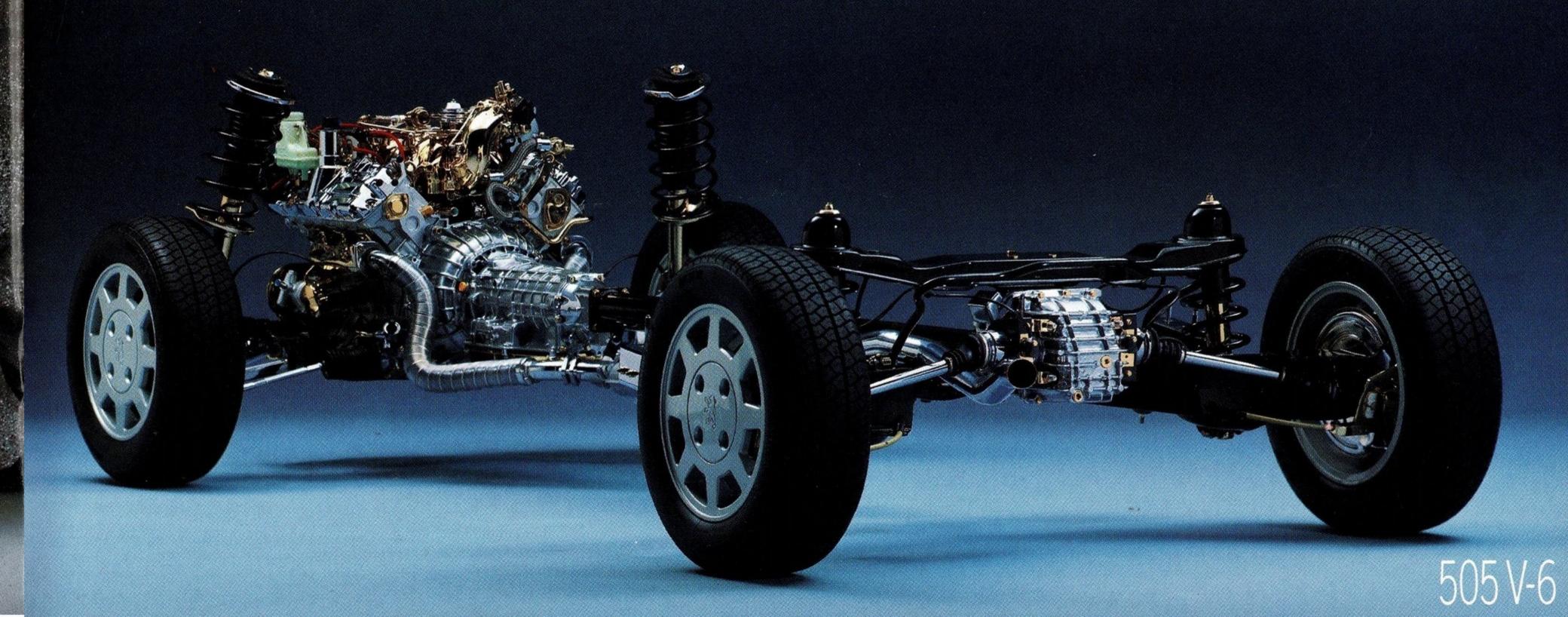

"Most of the time, and especially when the Turbo is surging toward its 6,000-rpm redline, your face will be set in a grin," concluded *Automobile Magazine*.

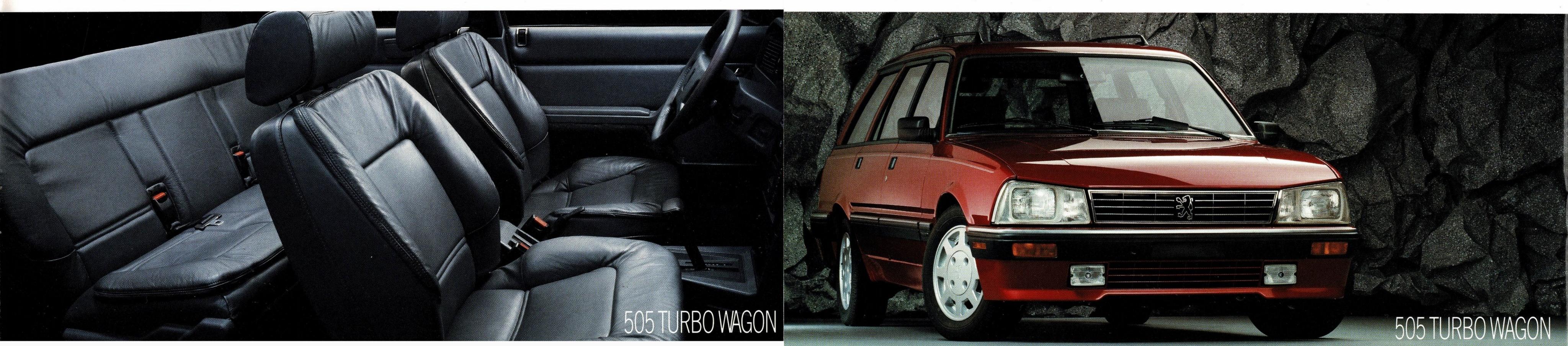

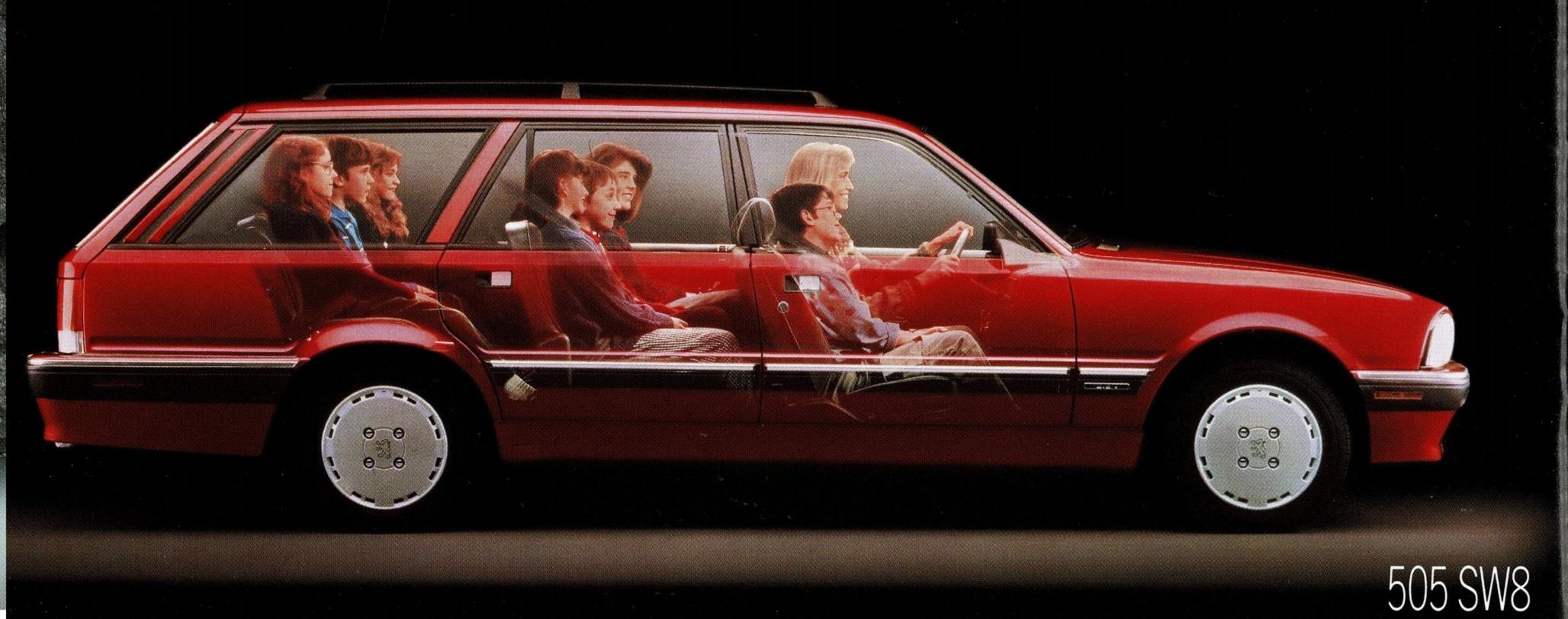
