Thanks to the remarkable control of the Lincoln Navigator, you now have the luxury of taking plenty of time to enjoy that which you came for. The fresh air. The breath-taking views. The infinite peace of mind. And, of course, the gnawing desire to experience them once again on your way back home.

Standard **side-impact head/chest airbags**¹ add another level of safety and security. When used with properly worn safety belts, they provide the driver and front passenger with added protection in a side collision.

Standard on the 2001 Navigator console is the **auxiliary climate control**, which allows the rear-seat passengers to adjust temperature, fan speed and air distribution to their liking. Additionally, the front floor console has rear audio controls, which allow passengers in the second row to adjust the volume and station selection, as well as listen through their headphones.

Lincoln's optional Navigation System with the **Global Positioning System** calibrates where you are relative to your final destination and illuminates the results on a conveniently located, easy-to-see, five-inch color console display.




The available power **moonroof** on the 2001 Lincoln Navigator welcomes in the sun, moon and stars. Or, if you prefer, just a nice touch of breeze. Controls for the moonroof are located in a stylish, overhead mini console for easy access.



Navigator's two **exterior mirrors** can be programmed to accommodate driver preferences. Additionally, a prominent turn signal—visible to traffic behind—appears in the mirror's housing when the turn indicator is activated. The exterior mirrors will also heat up quickly to melt ice and snow, for enhanced clarity.



Because drivers come in varying sizes and stature, **power-adjustable brake and accelerator pedals** can travel up to three inches to assume the most comfortable driving positions. The driver's preferred pedal settings will be retained in the memory system.



The 2001 Navigator's optional **climate controlled seats** allow both the driver and front passenger to regulate the temperature of their seats—sending either cool or heated air up through the seat cushions, for additional comfort.



When backing up, the Navigator driver will benefit from the added convenience of Lincoln's optional **Reverse Sensing System**. A clearly audible warning signal that increases in intensity as an object is approached, alerting the driver to use extra caution.





The second-row **bucket seats** can be quickly folded down flat in four easy steps, further increasing Lincoln Navigator's cargo area. Clear instructions are provided.



In the second- and third-row seating areas, luxury extends beyond soft leather trim to the **climate control**. Through a clever use of duct passages, temperate air reaches every passenger, courtesy of the auxiliary climate control — keeping everyone comfortable.



Color-keyed bodyside cladding and wheel lip moldings not only add a nice grace note to Navigator's exterior, they also help protect it from damaging road debris and parking lot "accidents." This helps to keep it looking new long after it leaves the showroom.



The four-wheel drive Navigator uses the **Control Trac® 4WD system** to select one of three different modes to accommodate varying on-road conditions. A rotary switch that's within easy reach facilitates effortless selection. Additionally, the "Automatic" setting chooses between two- or four-wheel drive as various road conditions dictate.



Navigator's powerful and responsive 5.4L 32-valve **DOHC InTech™ V8 engine**¹ delivers a very impressive 300 horsepower along with 355 lb-ft of torque. In addition, your Lincoln Navigator is able to travel 100,000 miles without a scheduled tune-up.²

Electronic automatic temperature control automatically adjusts — and continually maintains — the interior temperature to your preferred level. Additionally, the blower will wait to switch itself on until the air to be distributed has reached the preset level.



In case of a complete coolant loss, the **fail-safe cooling system** goes from eight-cylinder operation to alternating banks of four cylinders — helping to lower engine temperature.



Navigator offers a standard four-wheel disc brake and **four-wheel Anti-lock Brake System** — both of which contribute to improved control by reducing wheel lockup during hard braking on most surfaces. More importantly, they help increase driver confidence.



HomeLink® allows the Lincoln Navigator driver to quickly and easily program the universal remote (engineered right into the Navigator's sun visor) to activate garage doors plus any two additional home-based devices, such as patio or driveway lights.

Power-flip rear quarter windows provide additional ventilation for third-row passengers. Furthermore, for added comfort and convenience, controls are conveniently located in the overhead console, easily accessible to both driver and front passenger.



The **SecuriLock™** passive anti-theft system uses an encoded key to help protect against theft. If a nonencoded key or ignition bypass is detected, the ignition disables itself.




The 2001 Lincoln Navigator's tip/fold/lock **third-row bench seating** is capable of being folded and locked to an upright position, or removed with equal ease — quickly accommodating extra passengers or extra cargo, depending on your individual needs.



Because Navigator's front **wipers** are speed-sensitive, they automatically adjust their speed in relation to the vehicle's road speed. This eliminates the need for constant, manual adjustments, while enhancing the driver's visibility under adverse conditions.



Gracing Lincoln Navigator's elegant **wood- and leather-trimmed steering wheel** are duplicate controls for cabin climate and audio, as well as speed control adjustments. This allows you to keep your hands on the wheel and your eyes on the road at all times.




